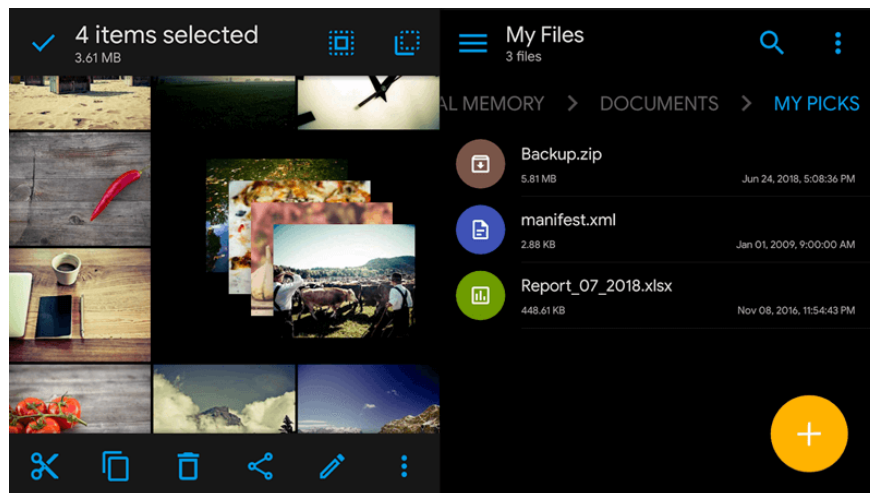

1. Solid Explorer

1. Download Solid Explorer for Android

Solid Explorer is one of the most functional and beautiful Android file management applications not only for phones but also for Android TV.

Solid Explorer has tons of features such as dual control support, drag and drop, root access, cloud management, batch renaming, etc. If necessary, you can install additional plugins to enable these Features like SFTP and FTP. If you like, you can customize its theme and icon.

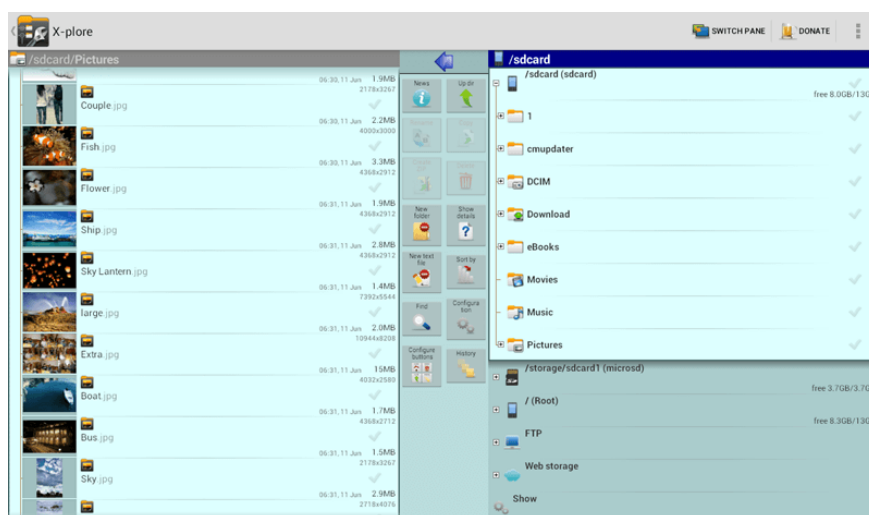


The downside is that the application is less updated, but it still works stably. Solid Explorer is a premium application that costs about 70 thousand VND. You can try it out for 14 days to check it out before you buy.

2. X-plore file manager

1. Download X-plore file manager for Android

X-plore file manager is also one of the powerful and feature-rich file management applications for Android TV. One of the interesting features of X-plore file manager is that you can configure it to automatically open the file management window when plugging in the USB. This feature is very handy because users often plug in USB to Android TV.



It has other features like unlimited FTP support, cloud storage management, application management, media player, zip file support, batch renaming, file encryption, etc.

X-plore file manager has similar features with Solid Explorer. However, X-plore's user interface is somewhat outdated. If you ignore the user interface, X-plore file manager is one of the file management applications worth considering for Android TV.

The basic version of X-plore is free, but if you want to use advanced features like support for FTP and encryption, you need to pay an extra fee.

3. AnExplorer

1. Download AnExplorer for Android

Like Solid Explorer, AnExplorer is designed to work on almost all Android devices including Android TV and Wear. Of course, it has most of the features you need from a file manager. Some features include zip file support, SD card management, application management, document organization, FTP and LAN support, cloud storage management, storage analysis and hotspot file sharing.

It's amazing to own so many features, but AnExplorer is completely free, so if you're looking for a free, feature-rich file manager for Android TV, you can't ignore AnExplorer.

Although there are very few file management options for Android TV, these applications are capable of doing most of your data management tasks without any problems. If you're willing to pay for advanced features and a nice interface, choose Solid Explorer. If you don't use the file manager application regularly or don't want to pay for it, you should choose between X-plore file manager and AnExplorer.
