3. Airfoil

Airfoil and Audio Hijack are equalizer tools that have the same origin. Airfoil, however, was created as a free audio tuning application for wireless devices. Although it is free, Airfoil gives users an EQ table with ten simple options, which can be applied to any sound source on the computer, so you can apply the equalizer for free. This is for any audio source on macOS from a separate application or across the system.



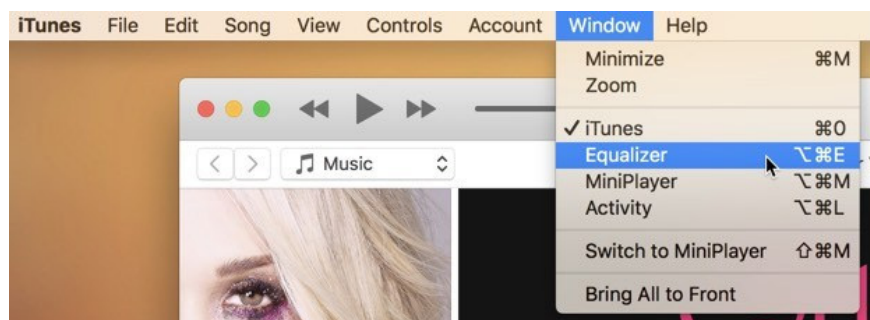
Airfoil's interface is extremely simple, so it's easy to use. Only a handful of buttons adjust in the entire interface of the application. You just need to select the sound source at the top, then adjust the EQ set as desired, that's it.

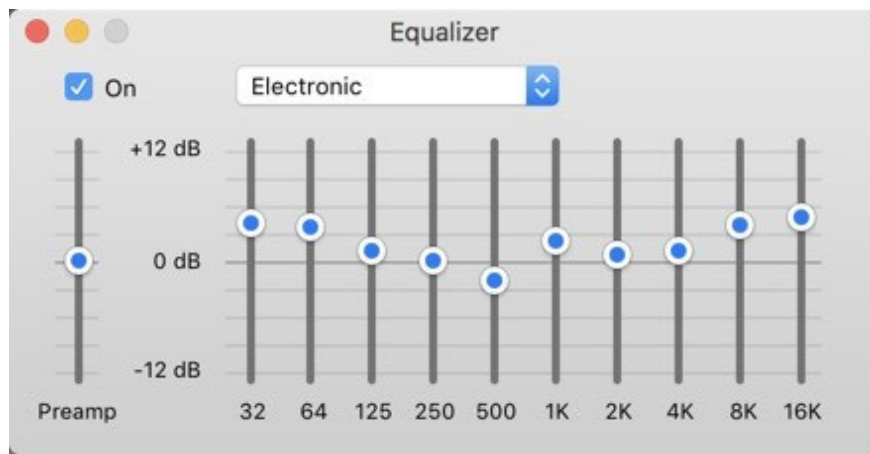
4. iTunes Equalizer

If you listen to music or any sound right from the iTunes app, you can use iTunes' built-in equalizer to adjust the output sound quality.

1. Select the Equalizer option from the Window menu in iTunes.



2. Adjust the equalizer accordingly. After the adjustment is complete, make sure to switch the checkbox next to ON mode so that the equalizer is valid.



After that, the options in the equalizer will be applied to any sound emitted from iTunes. Unfortunately, iTunes's Equalizer cannot be applied to any other application on your Mac.
