1. Disable JavaScript

JavaScript is an interpreted programming language developed from prototype concepts. It is used extensively in programming web pages.

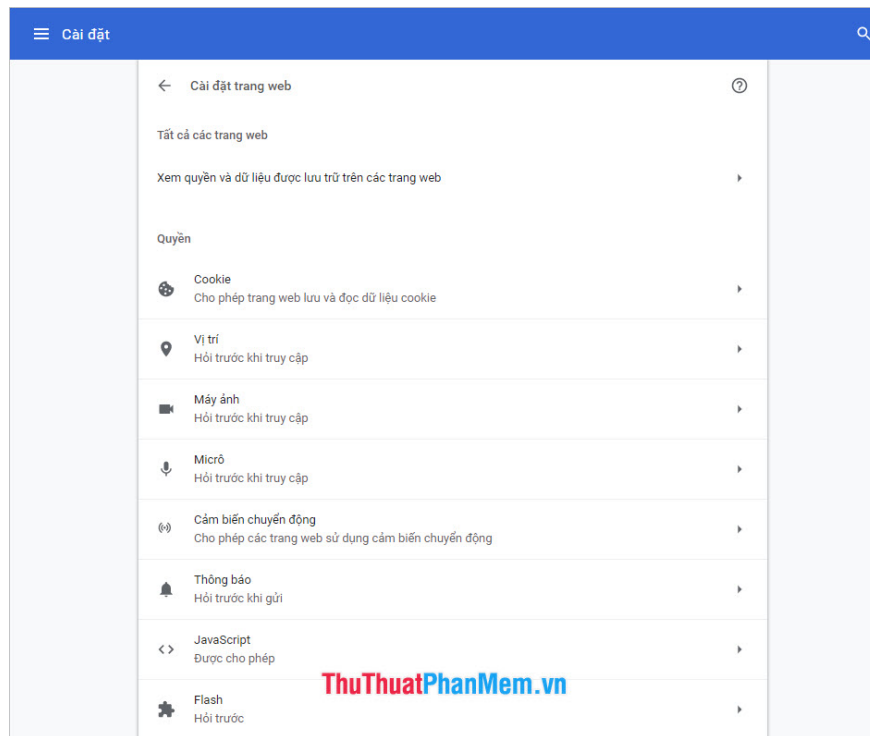
Some websites use JavaScript to program copy protection so to copy data on the condition we simply need to disable JavaScript.

1.1. Disable JavaScript on Chrome

To disable JavaScript on Chrome, you can access the link provided below:

chrome://settings/content

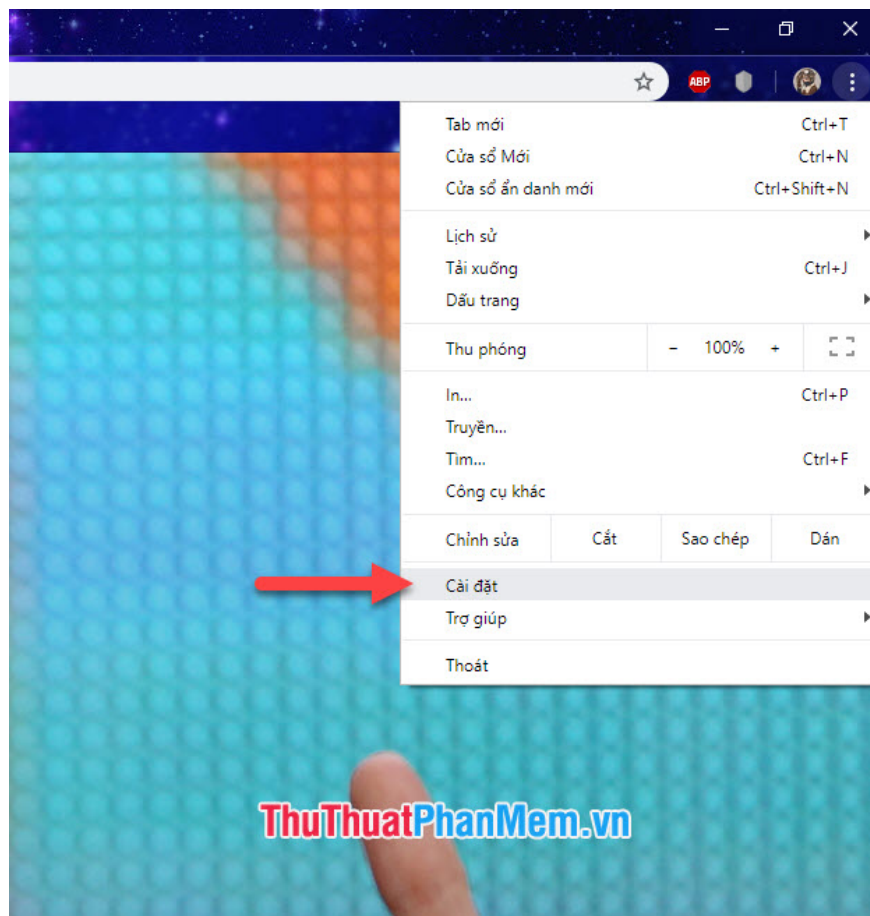
When you access that link, you can access the browser website settings.



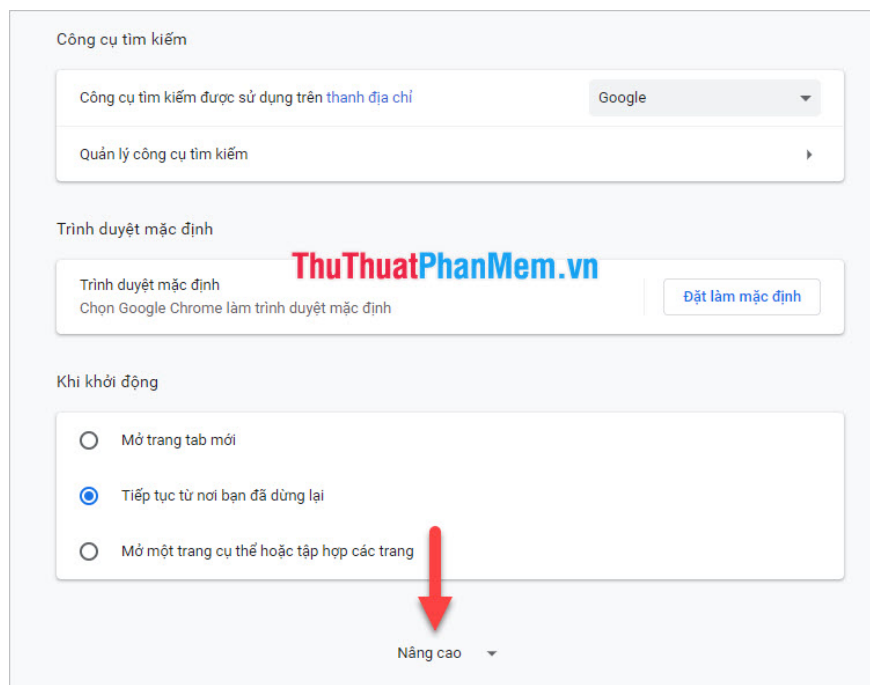
Or if you do not remember the link, you can follow the steps below to get to the web settings page.

You click on the **Settings** icon with three dots in the right corner of the browser interface.

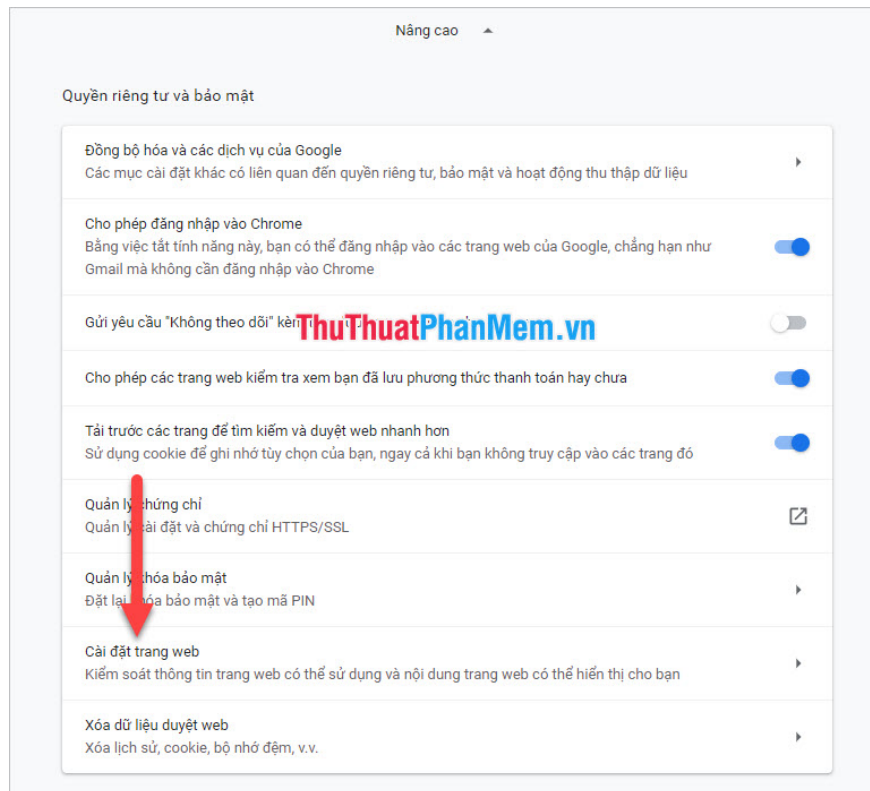
Then select **Settings** in the list of options shown.



You will be redirected to the browser settings page, you will see the first basic settings but what you need is advanced settings so you need to scroll down to the bottom and click on the **Advanced** word .

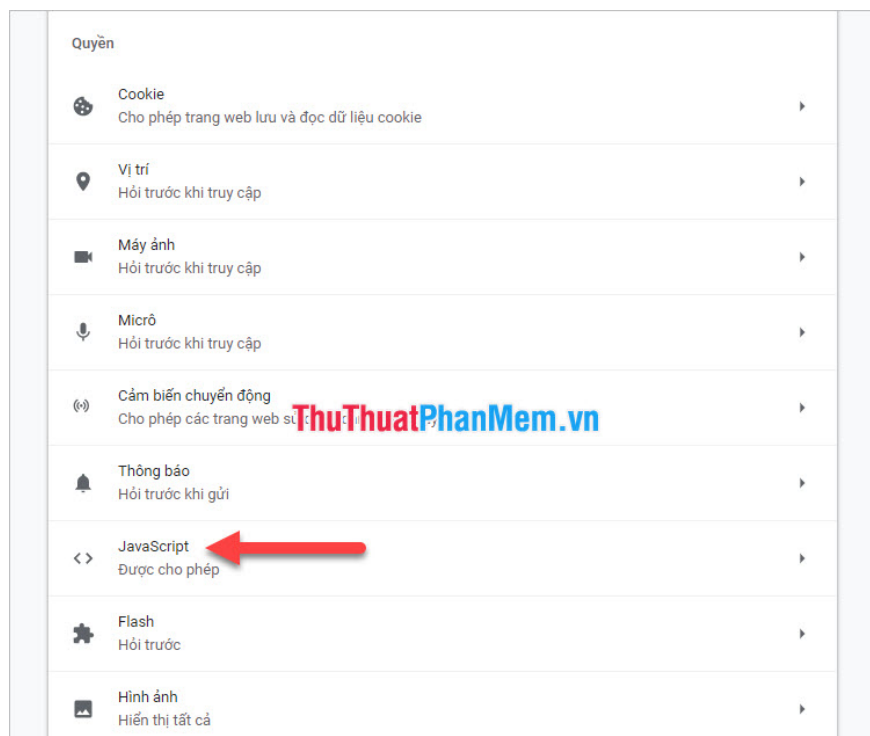


The advanced settings section is opened, click on the **Website settings** in the **Privacy and security** section .

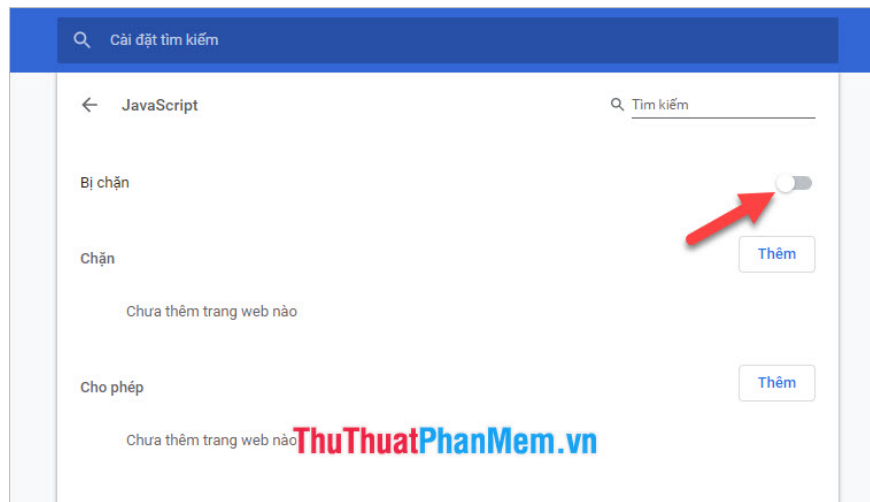


Now you get to the position like using the link mentioned above. Here you can see the **Permissions** you set for your web pages.

Find the **JavaScript** line and click on it.

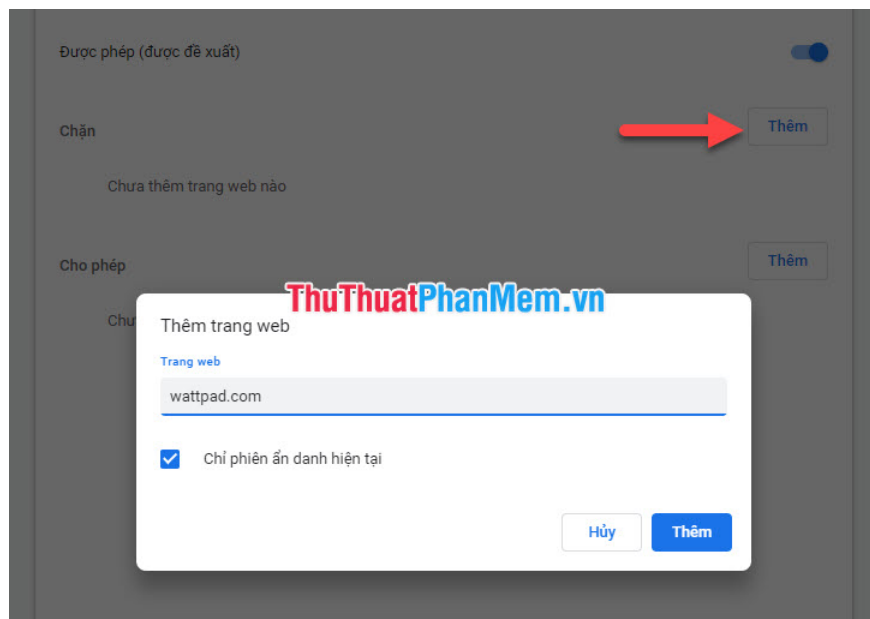


Then turn off the **JavaScript** feature by clicking the blue switch button so it turns gray. This means that you have disabled **JavaScript** for all web pages accessed by this browser.



But if you only want to copy data on websites that do not allow copying, then you only need to add it to the list of blocked JavaScript and not need to turn off this function on all pages. other.

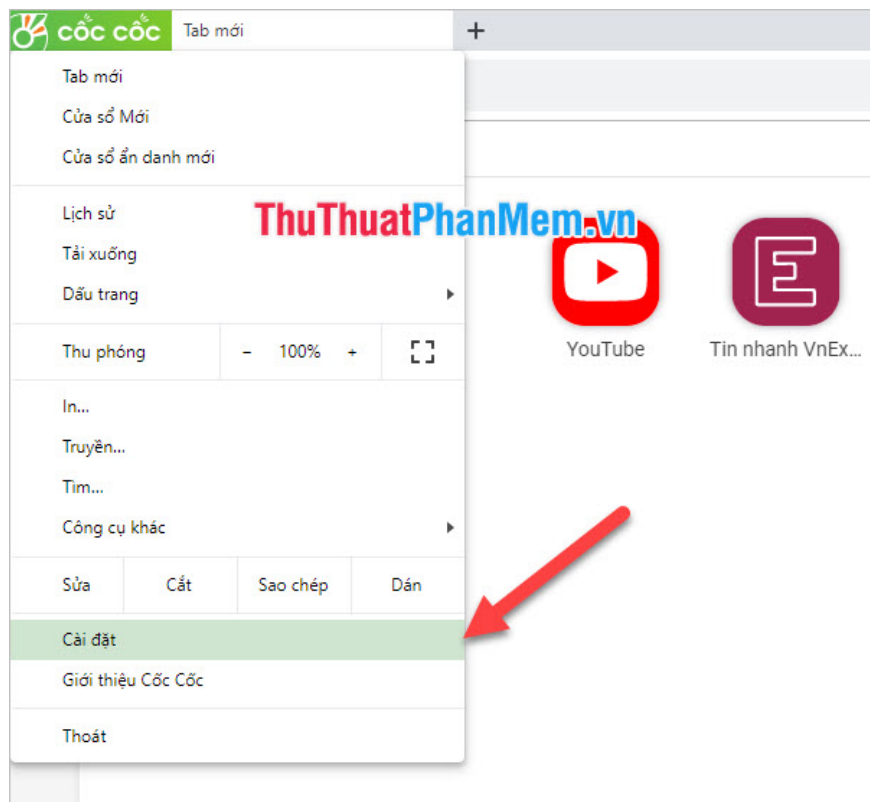
Click **Add** in the **Block** section . Then enter the name of the site to block and click **Add** .



1.2. Disable JavaScript on Coc Coc

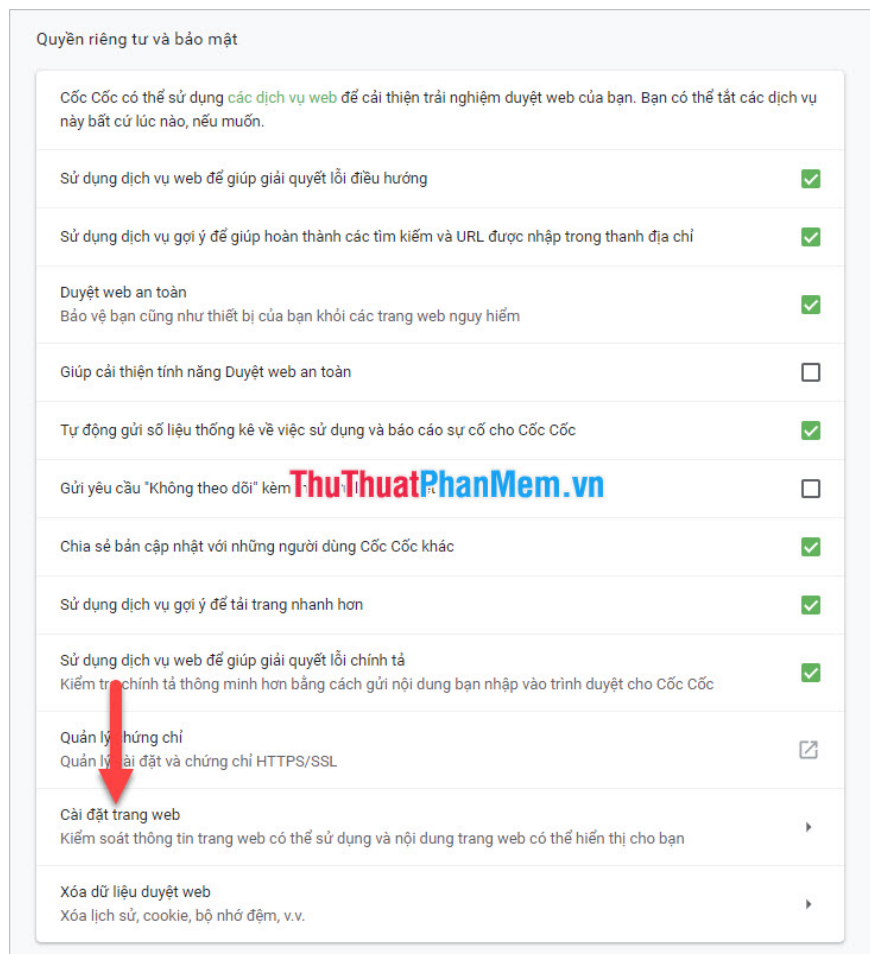
Almost like with Chrome browser, because using the same Chromium source, how to disable Coc Coc JavaScript is similar to how to disable JavaScript on Chrome.

You click on the Coc Coc icon in the left corner of the website interface to display the settings menu of Coc Coc. Then you click on the **Install** line in that list.



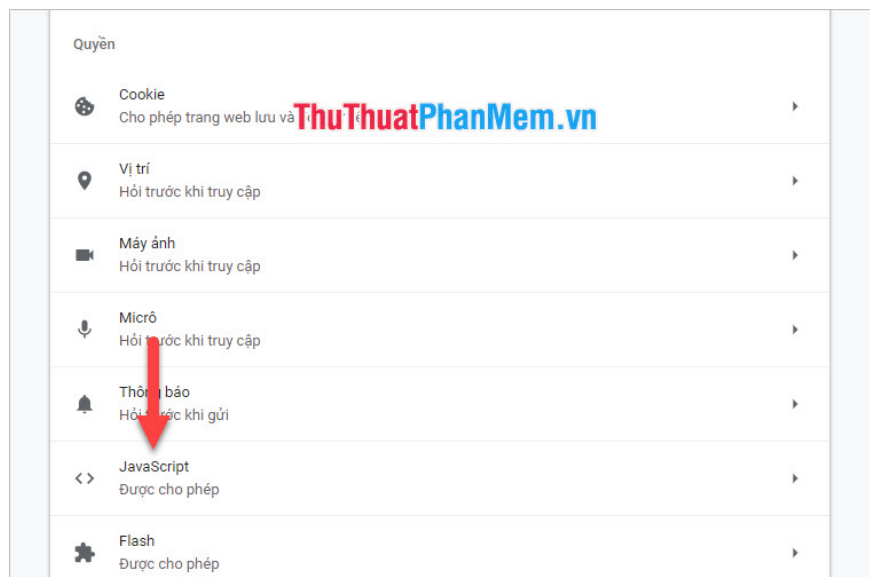
Next Coc Coc interface will switch to the settings for this web browser. Coc Coc does not have a clear divide between basic settings and advanced settings like Chrome so you just need to scroll down and find **Privacy and security** .

In this section, you will find the **Website Settings** line you need to access.



When the interface switches to **Website settings**, you will see permissions settings related to the Web browser.

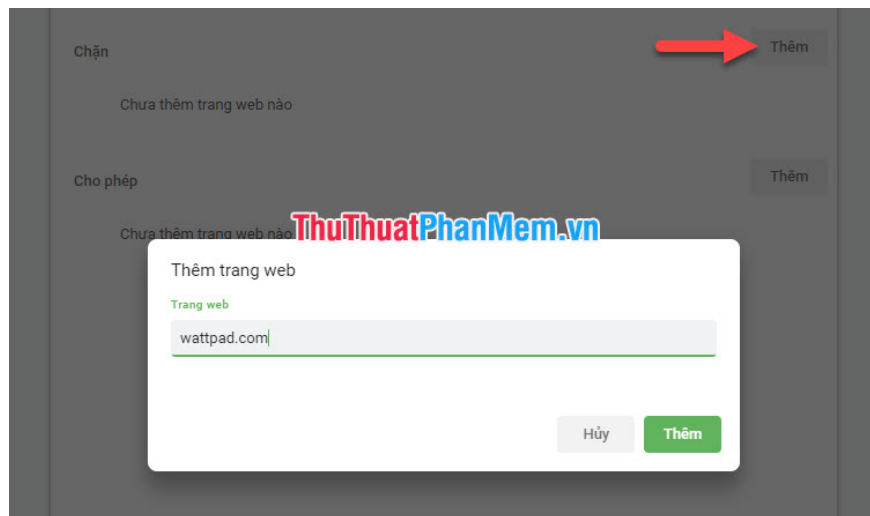
Click on **JavaScript** to open the settings in more detail with it.



You leave the blue checkmark in the same line as the word **Allow** to turn it into **Blocked** text . You will block JavaScript of all websites when using Coc Coc browser.



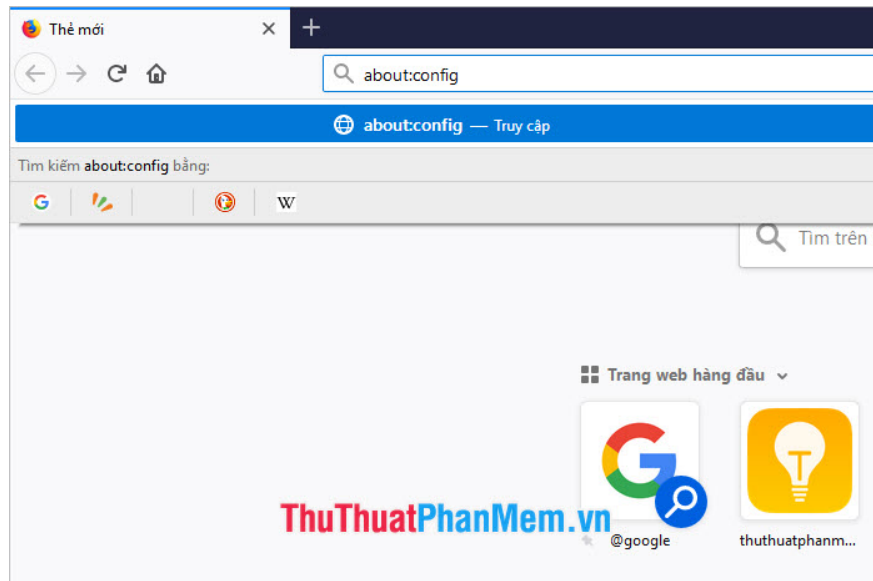
But if you want to block JavaScript only a few websites, you can add web addresses in the **Block** section .



1.3. Disable JavaScript on Firefox

To disable JavaScript in Firefox, copy the following line into the address bar of Firefox and press Enter to go to:

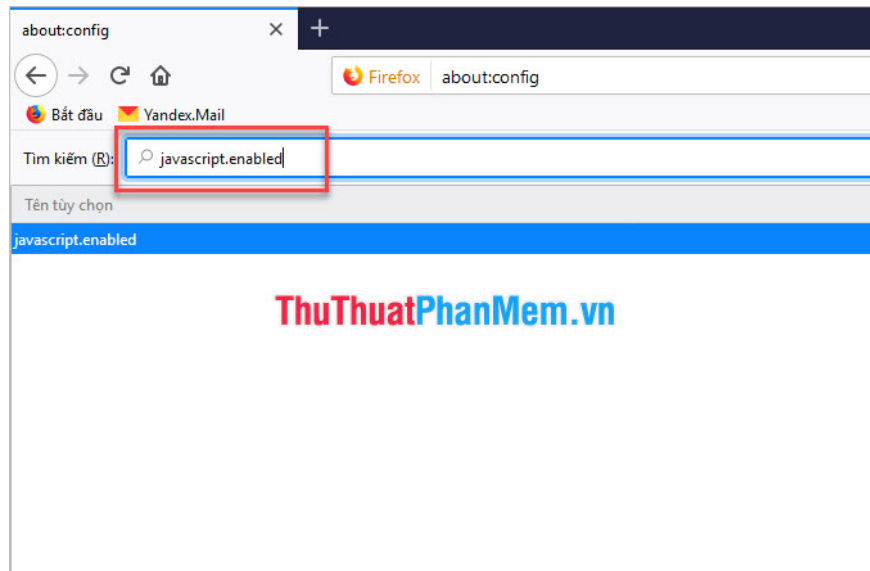
about: config



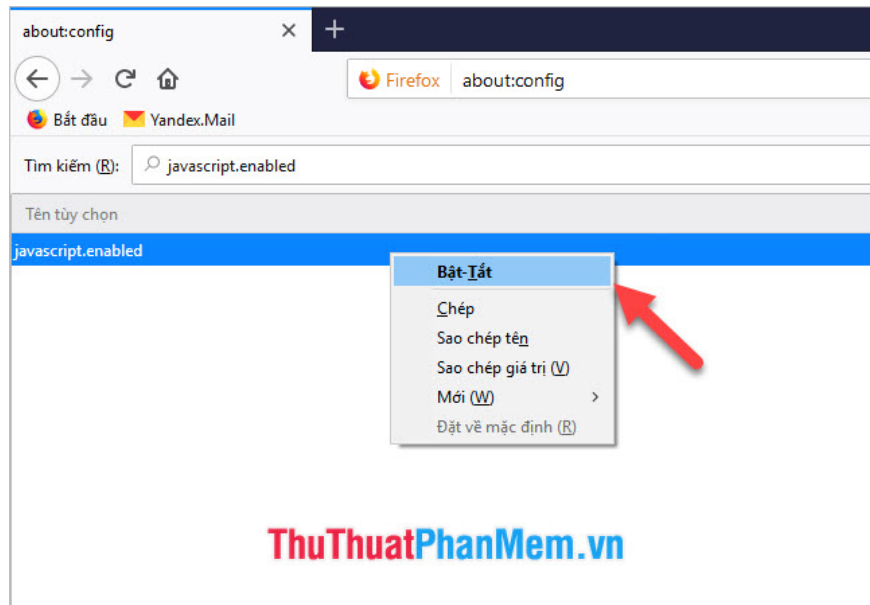
You will receive a notification from Firefox because the settings in the JavaScript settings may be related to the security of the computer. You just click **I accept the risk** is okay.



After switching to the **about: config** new page , you will see a very long list of related Firefox settings, to save time searching, click the Search box and type: **javascript** or type **javascript.enabled** .



You will see one remaining line is **javascript.enabled** . Right-click on that line and select **Enable-Disable** to disable Firefox's JavaScript.



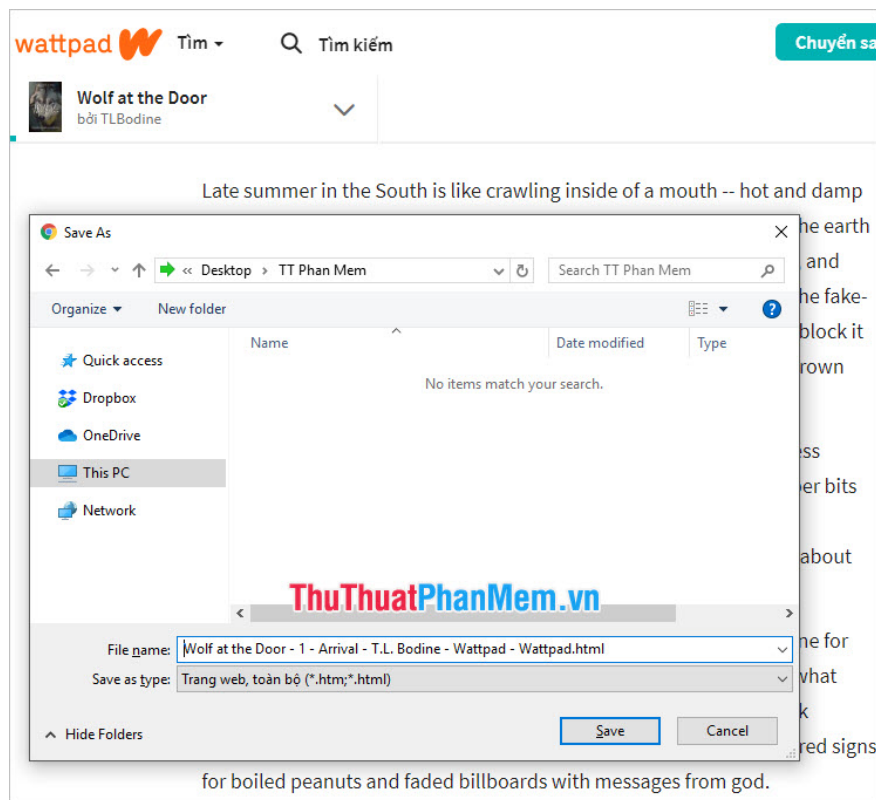
2. Download the website to be copied

It is another method for you to copy content on a website that does not allow copying.

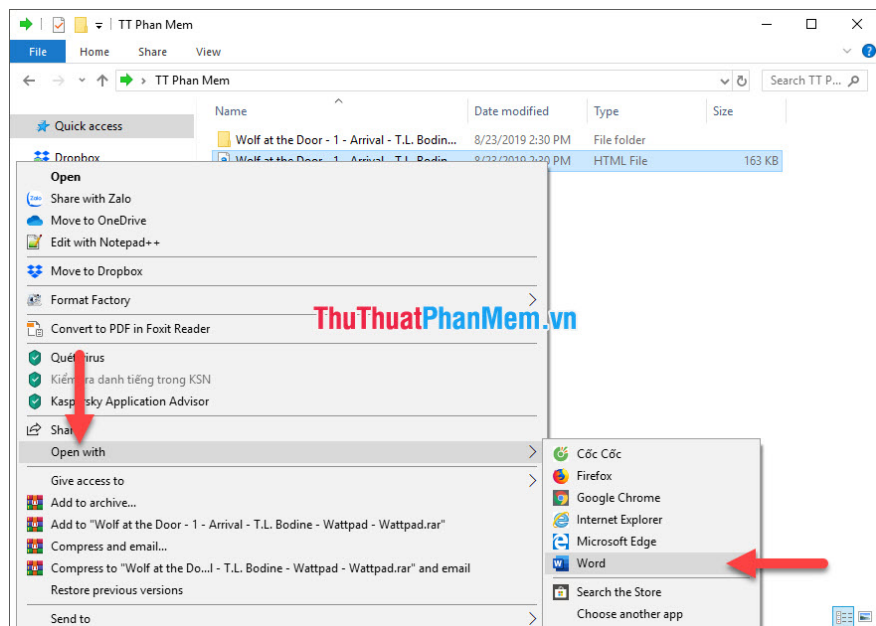
This method is quite simple, first you open the site does not allow copying that up. Then you use the keys on the keyboard **Ctrl + S** . This is a holy combination to help you save files on Windows operating systems.

In this case, **Ctrl + S** will allow you to save the current web page as a **.html** file .

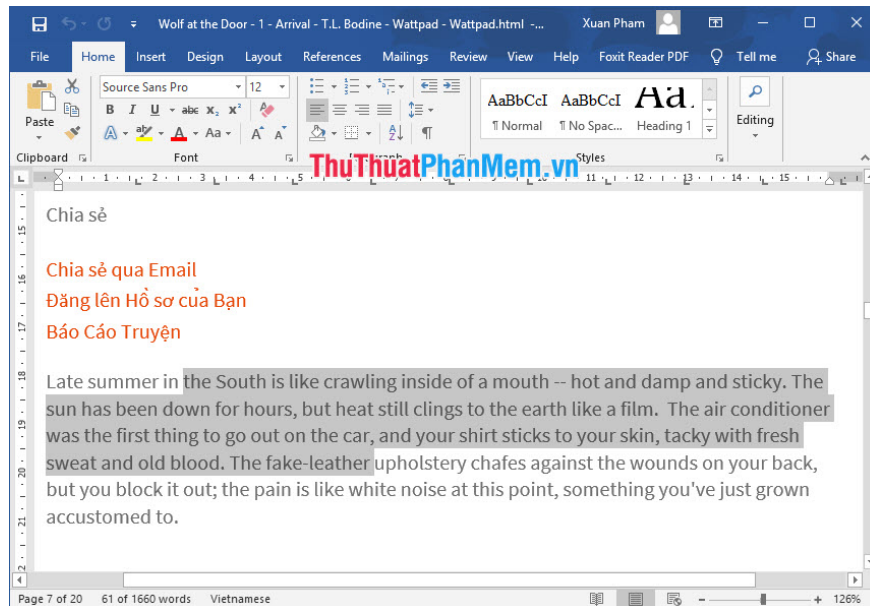
You save this file in a certain folder on your computer, convenient for searching later to open.



Because the file you saved is html, so when you open it, it will open by default. You need to right-click on the file and then click **Open with** and select the app to open as Word. If you do not see Word in the quick list, then you need to click on **Choose another app** to find Word.



So you can open that html file as a Word document. Now you can copy the content of that webpage straight into Word.

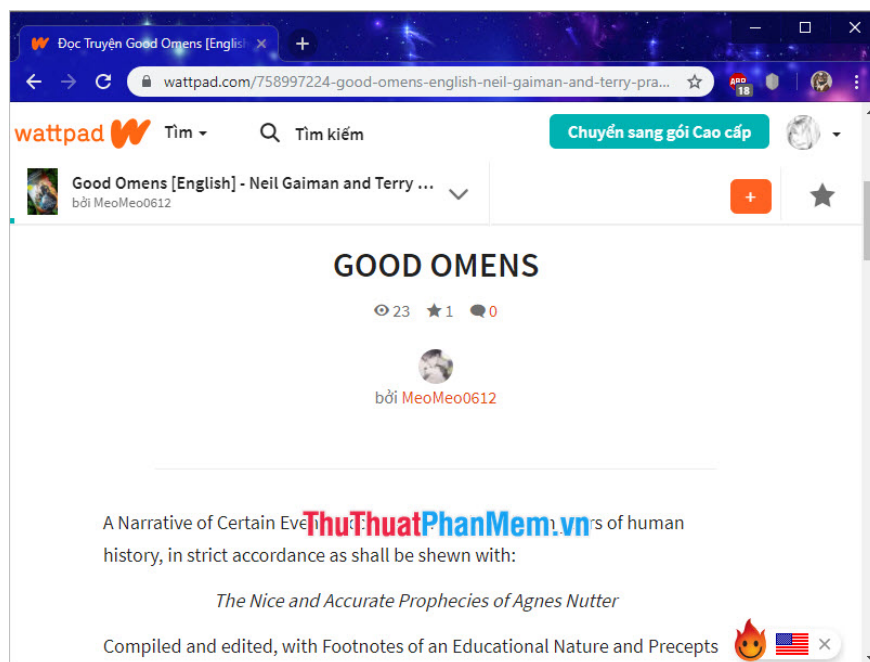


This method can be used in any browser and they are the same just by using **Ctrl + S** key combination .

3. Copy the web page through the page source

Let's take an example with the image below. This site does not allow you to copy its content onto your computer.

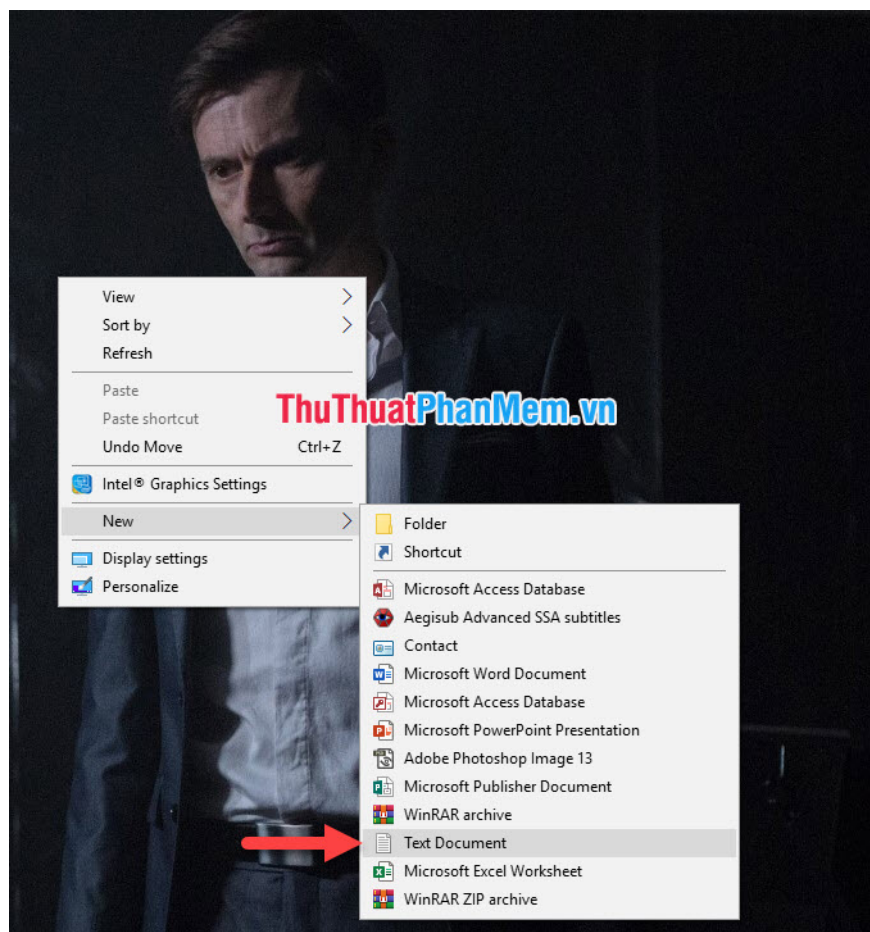
We can use the method of copying information in the page source to be able to copy its contents to the machine. You use the key combination **Ctrl + U** to open the page source for the site.



A new tab will be opened, which is the page source that TipsMake has mentioned above. You copy all the confusing code on this page again using **Ctrl + A** to highlight all and then use **Ctrl + C** to copy it to Clipboard clipboard.

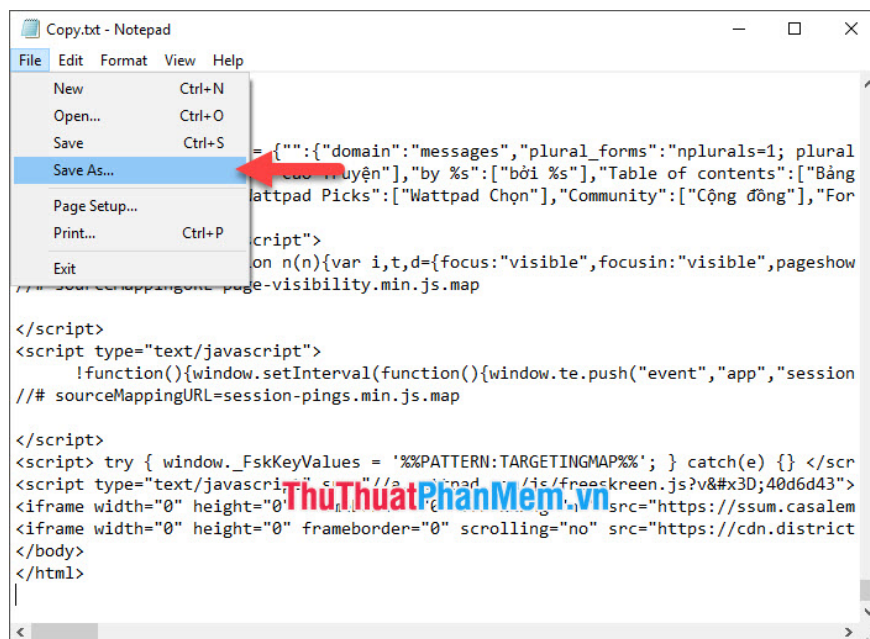
Then you create a **Text Document** file , just right-click on the screen, select **New** and choose **Text Document** .



Now open the newly created Text file.



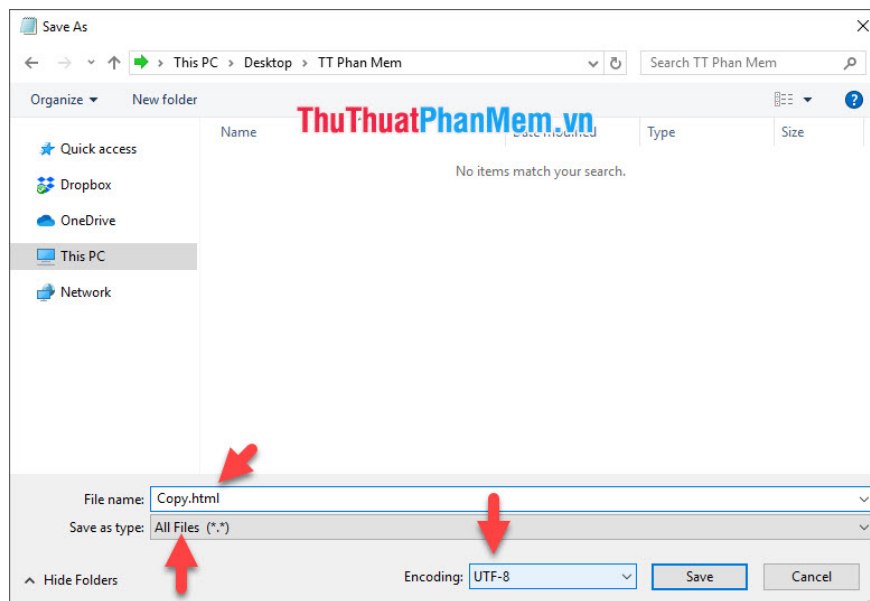
Paste all the content you just copied into this Text file, then click **File** on the toolbar and choose **Save As** .



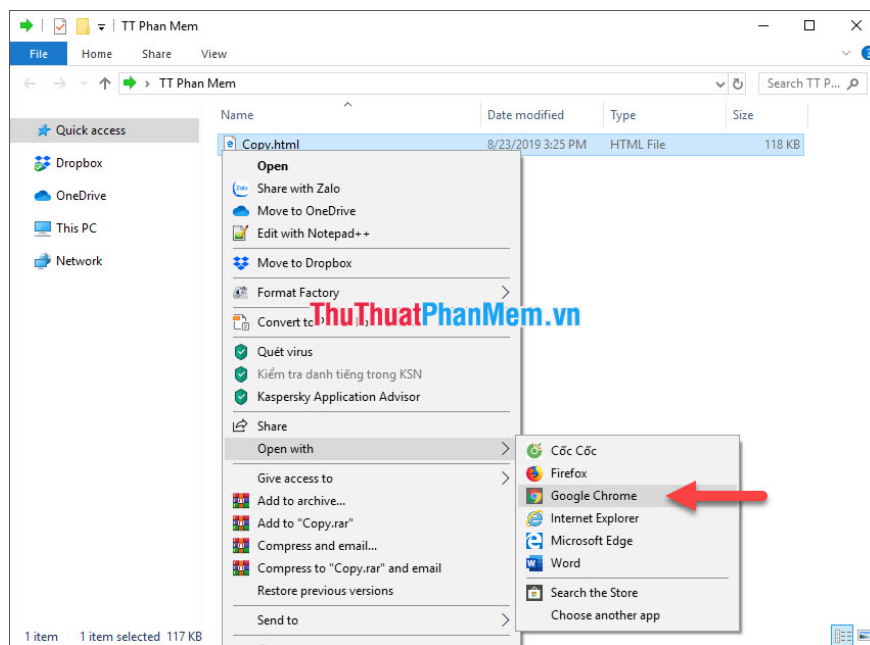
You convert Save as type to **All Files** , then name the **Text** file with the extension **.html** at the end.

Remember to convert **Encoding** to **UTF-8** to avoid possible font errors when saving the file.

Finally click **Save** to save the file.



Then open the file you just saved with your web browser. You can open it with Chrome, Coc Coc, Firefox or whatever web browser you are using.



After the file is opened, you can copy the text contents of the opened html file.
