Turn off the TV by unplugging the power cord

Add a seemingly harmless habit that many people still do is turn off the television continuously. Many people believe that this will help save electricity and often turn it on and off for a short time. However, in fact this thought is completely wrong. Turning on and off the TV continuously will consume power, even when turning off the TV like that, every time a television light bulb is heated unexpectedly, increasing the aging of the cathode, affecting the electric reflectivity and slowly reduce the life of the television.

2. How to turn off the television properly?

The best way to turn off the TV is to use the remote to turn off then press the power button to stop the TV from working properly. In rainy and stormy days, after turning off, you can unplug the power cord from the socket to make it safer.
