

3 simple ways to download pronunciation files on Google Translate

You often hear English (or other languages) through Google Translate and want to download its audio file but don't know how? It's easy to do that with 3 ways outlined in this article.

Google Translate or Google Translate, is a famous online translation service from Google. It helps users to translate text back and forth between many languages, supporting both Vietnamese and less popular languages ??than English and Chinese. Google Translate can also translate text on images, translate the content of an entire website into the preferred language. In particular, this service also provides the standard voice reading feature of local people, a great utility for those who need to forge the foreign language speaking skills they are learning.

If you also regularly use this feature, you want to download audio files to your computer, phone to listen whenever you need it, please refer to 3 simple ways below.

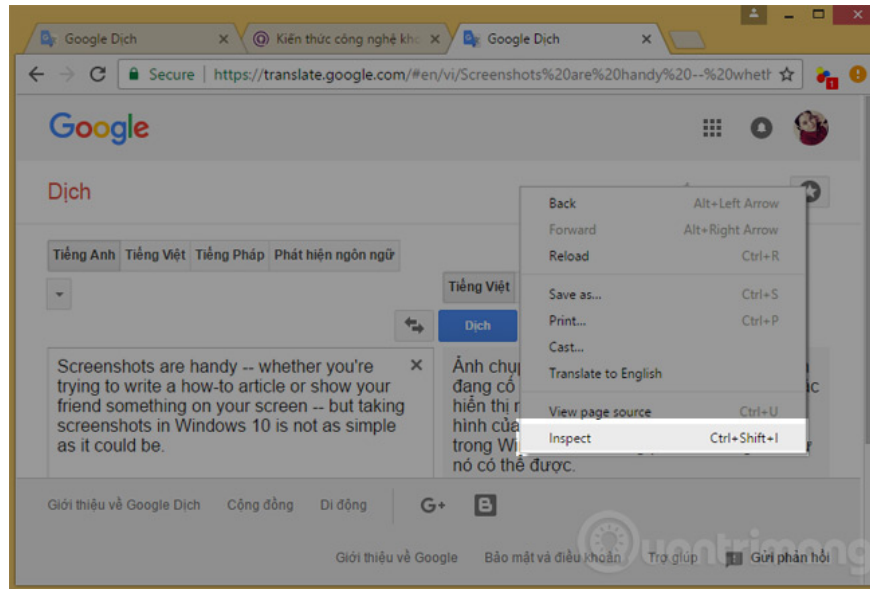

Method 1: Download audio files from Google Translate for those who like the code

I personally like this way the most, I don't need to install the application, support the large number of input characters (5000), no other audio files on the list to download (especially when you listen to music, watching movies again wants to download audio files of Google Translate). Previously, you could enter a text immediately after the Google Translate URL to download the audio file, but now this feature has been removed and hidden in the code.

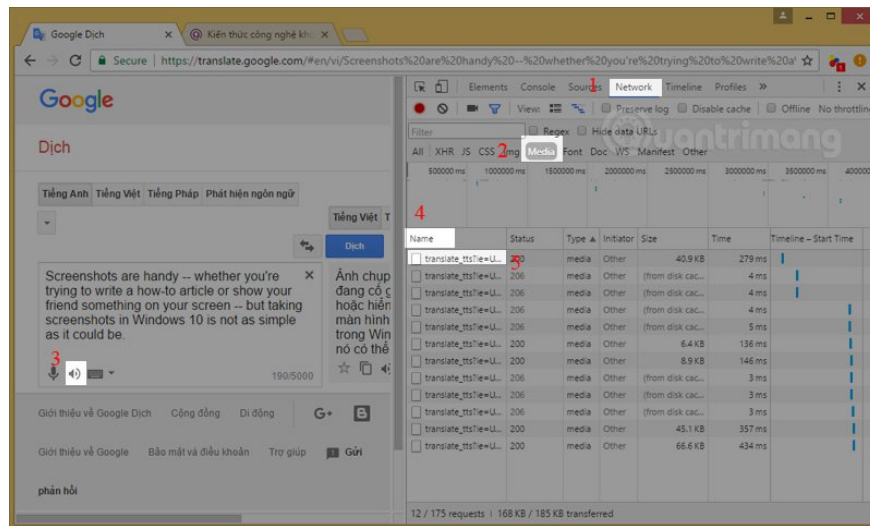
It sounds dangerous, but it doesn't need to know the code, HTML you can still download the desired audio file by following the steps below:

1. Visit the Google Translate page
2. Enter the text with a number of characters less than 5000
3. Right click on the website select **Inspect / Check** (or press **F12**)



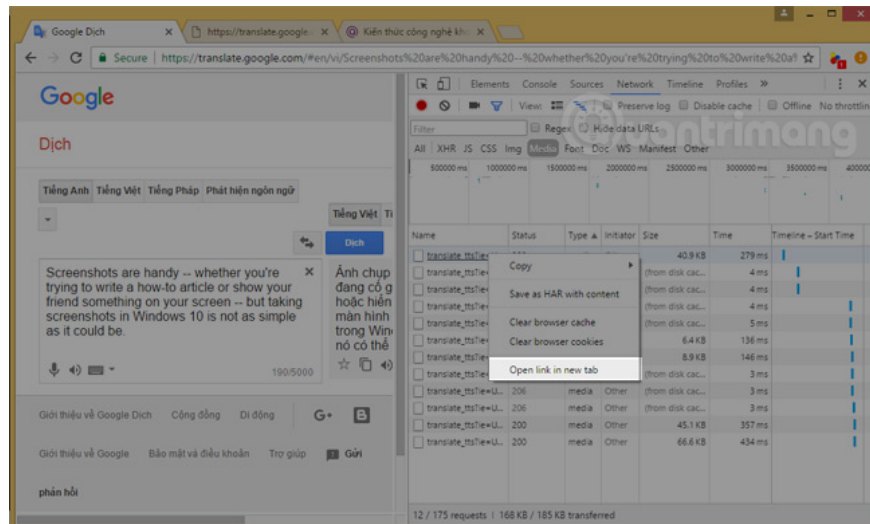
Select *Inspect* to open the Google Translate discovery page

1. In the window that appears on the right select **Network** at the top tab (4th from left)
2. Wait a few seconds, select **Media** (6th from left) in the menu just below the Network tab
3. If you have not clicked the speaker icon in the text box, then in the **Name** column of the Media tab will be empty. Each time you click on the speaker icon, a piece of text will appear



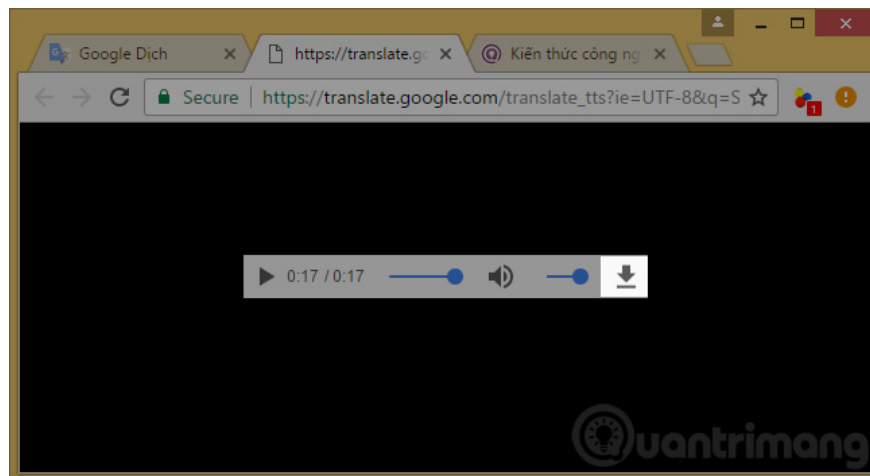
Click the order in the image when the discovery page appears

1. Right-click on the text in the Name column of Media, select **Open in new tab** (the last option)



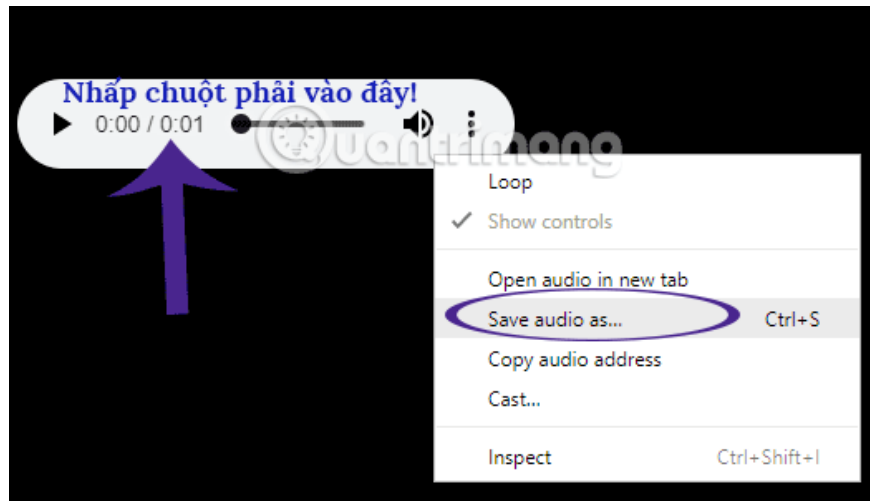
Select Open in new tab to open the audio file in the new tab

1. The new browser tab will open with an audible audio file
2. Click the black down arrow icon to save the file to your computer.



Download the Google Translate audio file to your computer

On the newer Chrome version, you may not see the arrow image as shown below, then you just need to press **Ctrl + S** or **right-click on the playback bar** and select **Save audio as ..**, select the folder Save the audio file Google Translate is okay.



Then, wait a moment and enjoy it.

Tell you:

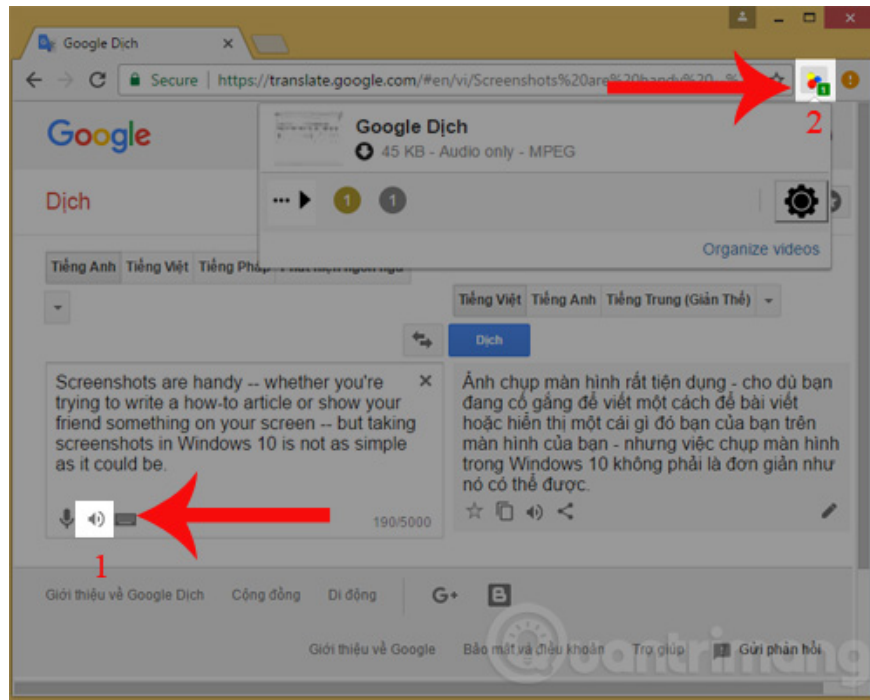
When you click on the speaker icon of Google Translate for the first time, you will hear with the normal speaking speed, if you want to listen at a slower speed, just click this icon again. If you do it in the third way, in the Size and Time columns, whichever is greater in Size and Time (in the same paragraph), it is the file that is pronounced at a slower rate.

Method 2: Download audio files from Google Translate with Download Video

Video DownloadHelper is an add-on on Google Chrome and Firefox browsers, helping users to download watching videos, music files, and audio files quickly and in good quality. Video DownloadHelper is completely free, works fast and works very accurately. In particular, it also captures audio files of online translation sites Google Translate.

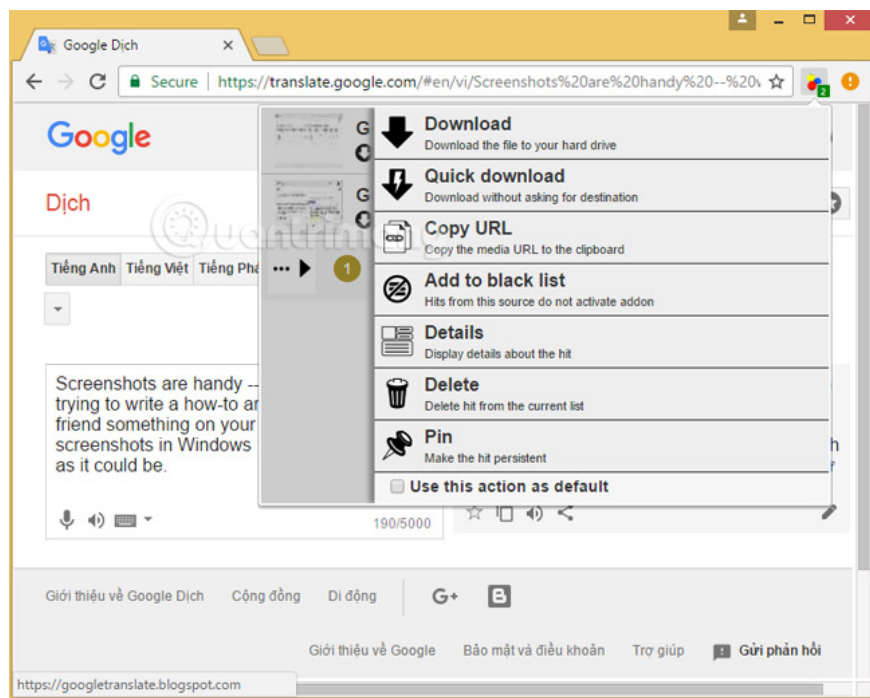
To download the audio file from Google Translate, follow these steps:

1. Download and install Video DownloadHelper on your browser (only Google Chrome and Mozilla Firefox are supported)
2. Go to **Google Translate** , enter the word or text you want to hear in the text box
3. Click **the speaker icon** in the box of the text to be translated
4. Click **the Video DownloadHelper icon** on the browser toolbar



Click the speaker icon to download DownloadHelper Video

1. If you want to quickly download to your computer (do not ask the folder you want to store files) just **click on the name of the sound file that appears**. If you want to select the saved folder, click the triangle icon on the right, select **Download**.



Download options of Video DownloadHelper

1. Wait a moment for the download process to complete
2. The downloaded file is in .mpeg format, which can be played with Windows Media Player by default on Windows
3. Double click on the downloaded file and enjoy the result

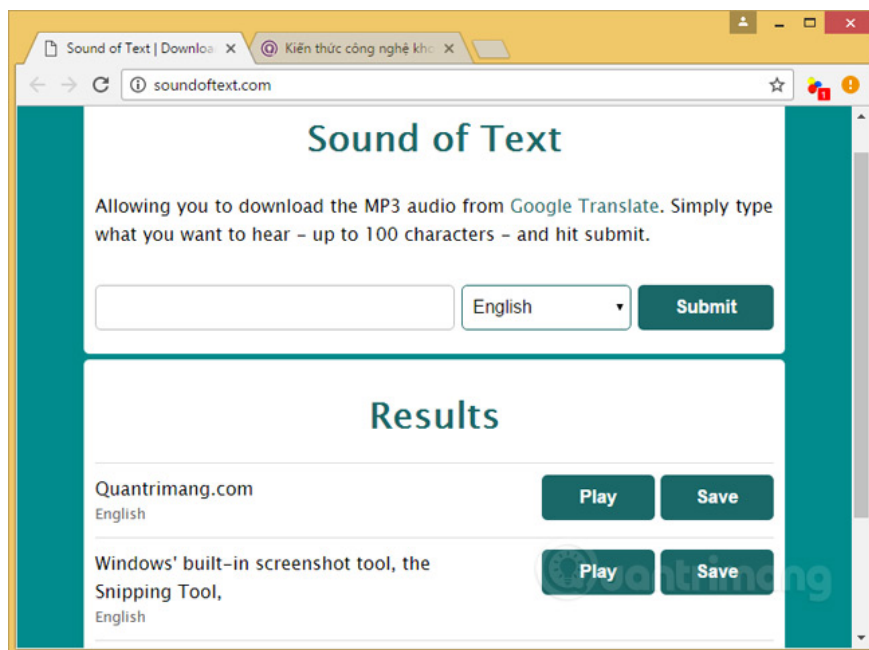
In the three ways mentioned in this article, using Video DownloadHelper is the fastest, but maybe you will prefer the following two ways.

Method 3: Download the pronunciation file of Google Translate online

This way you will not need to install any software or add-on, just visit the soundoftext.com website. This site allows downloading audio files from Google Translate in MP3 format. In particular, you don't need access to Google Translate, you can still choose the language to read the text and download it right on the page.

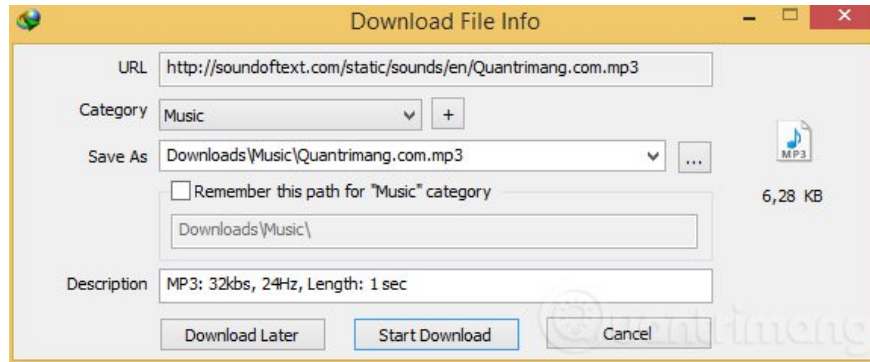
Making:

1. Visit the soundoftext.com website
2. Type the word, the paragraph you want to get the pronunciation file into the text box
3. Select the language you want to hear
4. Click **Submit**
5. In the **Results** section: Click **Play** to listen to the audio in advance, click **Save** to save the audio file to your computer

The drawback of this is that you can only enter up to 100 characters, the number of supported languages is less than that of Google Translate. If you install applications that support download such as IDM, Free Download Manager, when you click Save, the audio file will be downloaded through these applications.



Click the Save button and IDM catches the download file of the pronunciation file

If IDM is installed on your computer, this app sometimes catches the link when you hear the text on Google Translate, but it does not work properly so TipsMake.com does not mention this method officially in the article.
