Instructions on how to take a screenshot on Samsung Galaxy A32

The Samsung Galaxy A32 is the first version of the incredibly impressive A Series, launched in early 2021, and Samsung provides several different ways that users can take screenshots on the Samsung A32.

3 ways to take screenshots on a Samsung Galaxy A32 phone.

1. Taking a screenshot on a Samsung A32 using the physical buttons.

The first way to take a screenshot on a Galaxy A32 phone is to use the physical button located on the side of the phone. This is the easiest and most commonly used method. Here's how:

Step 1: Prepare the content you want to capture on your phone screen (website, game score, Zalo chat, etc.).

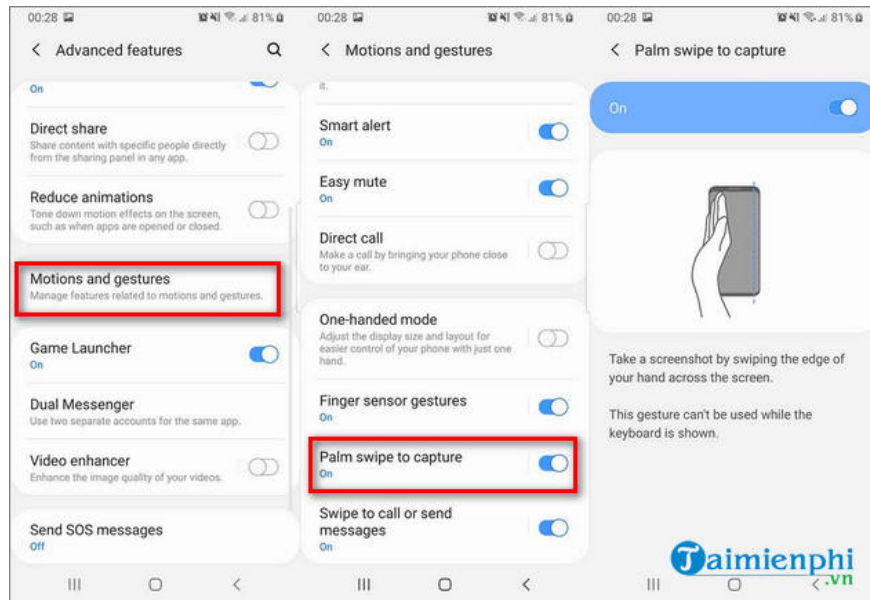
Step 2: Press and hold the volume down button and the power button simultaneously until you hear a camera shutter sound and the screen flashes.



Step 3: Next, you will see a small menu bar appear at the bottom of the screen, offering three options: editing and cropping the image, Scroll Capture, and sharing the image on social media.

2. Take a screenshot on Samsung A32 by swiping your palm.

Step 1. To take a screenshot on your Samsung A32 using a palm swipe, first enable this feature by going to Settings > **Advanced Features** > **Motions and Gestures** and turning on the **Palm swipe to capture** option .

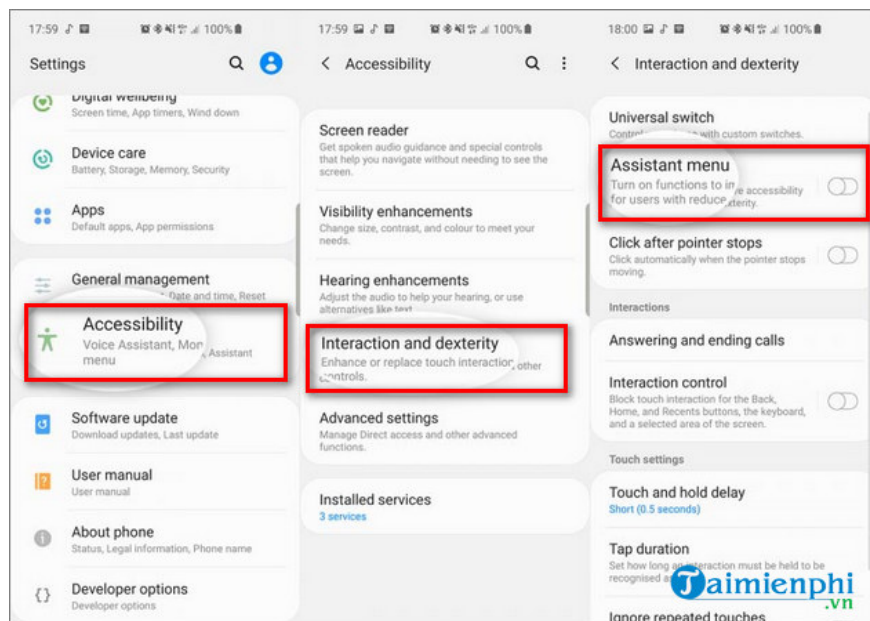


Step 2: Once the feature is activated, simply swipe the edge of your hand horizontally across the screen to capture the content currently on your phone screen.

3. Take a screenshot on your Samsung A32 phone using the Support Menu.

Besides using physical buttons and gestures to take screenshots on the Samsung A32, you can also use the virtual Home button, or more accurately, the Assistive Menu, to do this. Here's how:

Step 1: First, you need to activate the Assistant Menu by going to Settings > **Accessibility** > **Interaction and dexterity** and **turning on the Assistant menu**.



Step 2: A virtual Home button will appear on the screen. Simply tap the virtual Home button and select **Screenshots**. The phone screen will then flash to indicate that the image has been captured.

Above are three ways to take screenshots on the Samsung A32. It's great that Samsung has included some software features for taking screenshots in case the physical buttons malfunction.
