

3 Ways to unlock a locked computer without a password

One of the most troublesome situations you can encounter is getting your computer locked. When you are locked out, you cannot use any features or files on your computer because it is simply locked to you.

To gain access to your files, you will need to learn how to unlock your computer so that it is unlocked and you can access all of your files.

There are several ways to unlock your computer and access its files. While some methods require you to install software to unlock your computer, others allow you to perform the task without installing anything. Let's learn how to unlock a locked computer in different ways:

1. Method 1. Unlock a locked computer using another administrator account
2. Method 2. Unlock computer password using created password reset disk
3. Method 3. Unlock your computer using Professional PC Unlocker

Method 1. Unlock a locked computer using another administrator account

People often have multiple administrative user accounts on their computers, so they can perform many tasks that require administrative privileges using multiple accounts. If you have more than one administrator account on your computer, you can use the unlocked account to reset the password for the locked account.

Here's how you can unlock a locked computer using another administrator account:

Step 1: Log in to your computer using another administrator account. Right click on **My Computer** and select **Manage** . It will launch the **Computer Management utility**.

Step 2: When the utility opens, click **Local Users and Groups** in the left sidebar. Find the locked account, right-click on it and select **Set Password** .



On the following screen, you can define a new password for the selected account. Once the new password is set, you can sign out of your account and then sign back in with your locked account. This time make sure to use the newly created password and you will be logged in.

That's how to unlock your computer without a password using another account.

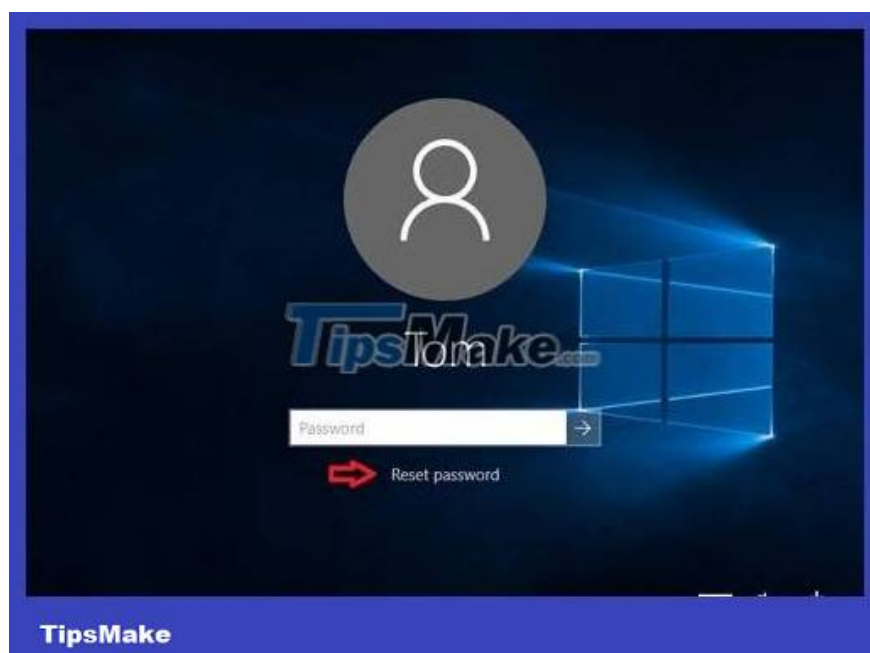
Method 2. Unlock computer password using created password reset disk

If you created a Windows password reset disk before your computer was locked, you can use the password reset disk to reset the password for your user account. Once your password is reset, you will be able to access your computer.

Here's how to unlock your computer password with a reset disk:

Step 1: Insert the password reset disk you have into your computer and start the computer from there. You can press the **F12 key on the BIOS** screen to do this.

Step 2: When the reset disk loads, find and click the option that says **Reset password** to begin the password reset process on your computer.



Step 3: On the next screen, click the **Next** button to continue in the reset wizard on your desktop.



Step 4: A drop-down menu will appear allowing you to select your reset disk from the available disks. Select a disk and then click the button that says **Next** .



Step 5: The next screen will allow you to set a new password for your user account. Enter the new password you want to use for your account and click the **Next** button .



Are you ready. The new password you entered above has been applied to your account, and you can enter it the next time you log in to your computer. That's how the password reset disk is used to reset your password and unlock your computer.

Method 3. Unlock your computer using Professional PC Unlocker

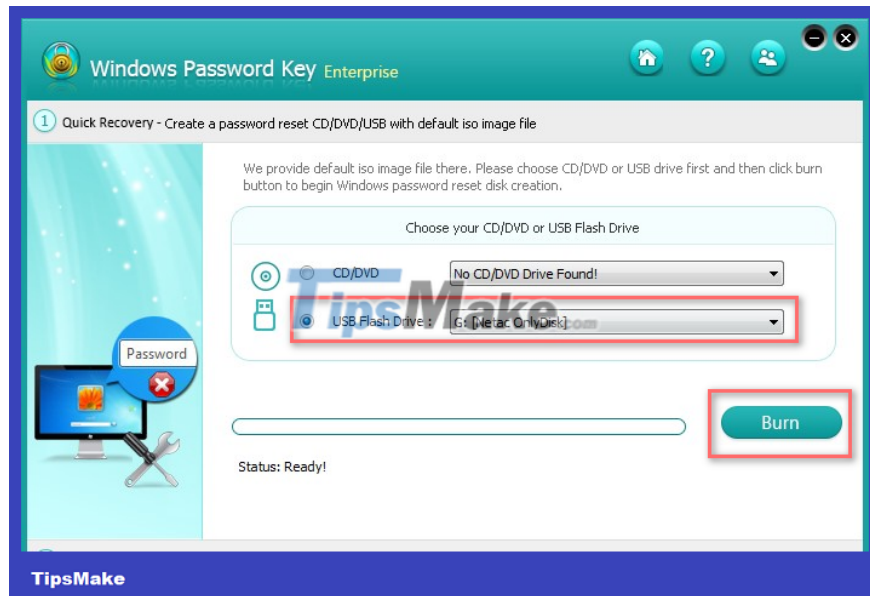

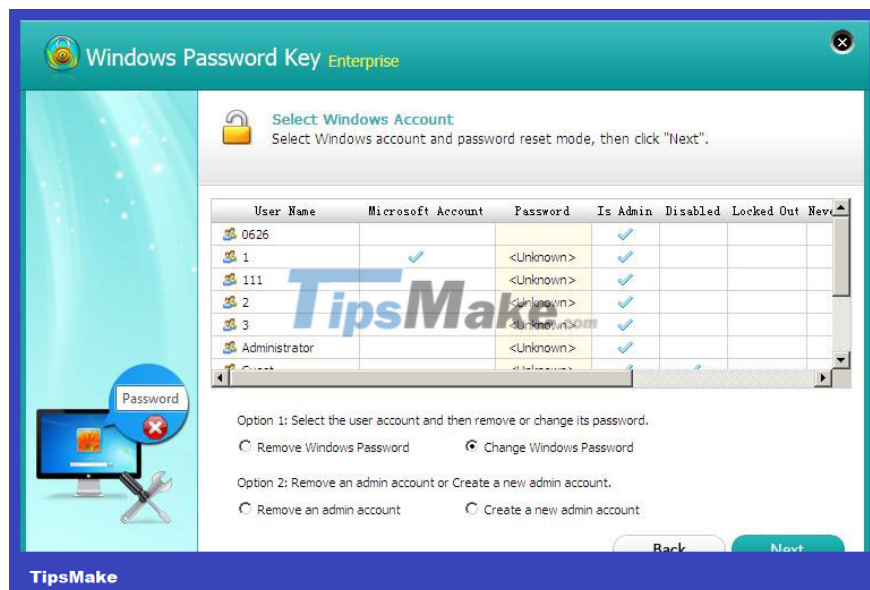


Step 2: Insert the removable media into your locked computer and boot your computer from there. You can press the **F12** key to do so.

Step 3: Once the software loads, select your Windows installation and click the **Next** button .



Step 4: Select your user account on the following screen, check **Remove Windows Password** and click the **Next** button .



That is all. The password from your locked computer should be deleted. Your computer is now unlocked and you can access all files stored on it.
