

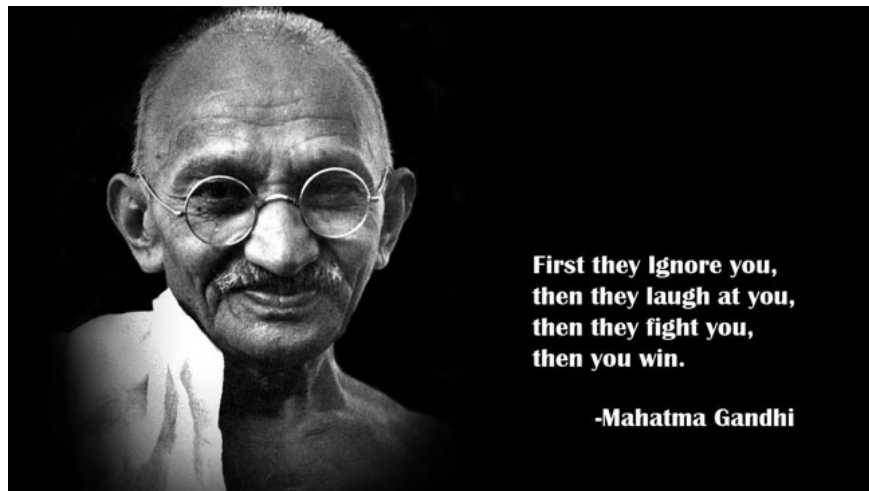
# 30 immortal philosophy of St. Mahatma Gandhi

3. Revenge only makes the world dark

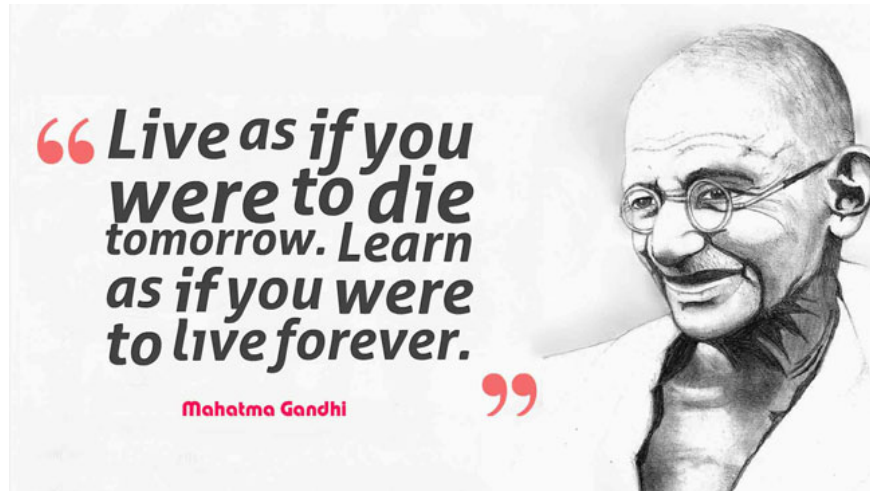
4. The world has enough for the needs of everyone but not enough for anyone's greed.
