The best map / navigation application



Google Maps

People use a lot of GPS on their iPhone when driving and it completely replaces the Garmin GPS that has been used for years. Apple Maps is pretty good, but it is still far behind the Google Maps application. Because it's a Google product, you can sign in with your Google account and sync all your data. This tool makes life much easier.

Waze

Waze is a turn-by-turn navigation tool that adds a social community that helps bring information to the driver. It was acquired by Google, but is still a separate application. Finally, it can be incorporated into Google Maps. This will make the Google Maps app the only app you really need to navigate GPS!

The best weather forecast application



There are millions of weather forecast applications. Here are a few suggestions. (If you have a better choice, please comment in the comment section below!)

Yahoo Weather

This is a favorite application of many people because it has a nice interface and lots of useful information. With a free application, this tool is quite perfect.

Weather Underground

A lot of people have used it and really liked it. It's free, but there are ads. That is the only downside. You can pay 99 cents to remove ads. But despite advertising, it is still a great weather app.

Best photography application



Flickr

Flickr application allows you to browse your Flickr photos and also allows you to download everything from iPhone to storage account with 1TB of free storage. If you often take lots of photos, this is a great option. It also has filters and editing tools, so you can edit your photos before uploading to Flickr, Twitter or Facebook.

Google+

Google+ is known as a social networking app, but it is listed in this section because it's really great for taking photos. If you've used Picasa Web Albums before, those albums have been converted into photo albums on Google+ and you can access them all from the Google+ app. It also automatically uploads all photos and videos to Google+ and creates animated GIFs, enhances photos and more for users.

Instagram

It's hard to find someone who doesn't use Instagram. Although Facebook has acquired it, Instagram is still one of the most popular photo-sharing apps on the Internet.

Snapseed

The applications mentioned above are mainly related to viewing and storing photos, and Snapseed is very suitable for using photo effects. You can convert and adjust images with many options and tools in this application. All are free.

Photo Editor by Aviary

This is another free application, but there is a paid version if you want more effects. The free version has a lot of features, enough to create some beautifully edited images.

VSCO Cam

Again, like the Aviary's photo app, you have a basic app and can buy additional features through the app. The program uses several advanced technologies to add stunning effects to your photos.

Best cloud storage application



Dropbox

Dropbox is very popular and widely known to be quite good for storing files in the cloud. It works on all devices, as well as on iPhone when automatically uploading all your photos and videos. The only downside is that if you store a lot of data, you will pay to buy more storage capacity (the price is quite expensive compared to other competitors).

Google Drive

This is a favorite application of many people with 15GB of free storage and it is currently very strong: only \$ 10 a month for 1TB of memory. While you only get 500 GB on Dropbox for \$ 500 a year. However, Google Drive

cannot automatically upload anything from your phone. Google+ is possible, but both are not well integrated. Google needs to improve this if they want to compete more with Dropbox.

OneDrive

Although OneDrive is a Microsoft product, this is still a pretty good app for iPhone. Everyone has a Windows PC and this makes this application really useful. OneDrive is integrated into Office 2013, Windows 8, Windows Phone, Microsoft Surface and other Microsoft products, so if you are using Microsoft products, this is a good cloud storage application. It is also cheaper than Dropbox in terms of storage capacity.

Best messaging / chat application



Google Hangouts

Hangouts is great for anyone using Gmail and other Google services. It allows you to chat with your friends and make video calls with groups of people.

WhatsApp

If you know Facebook has paid \$ 16 billion for this application, maybe you will use it right away? It's just a joke, but this app is useful for anyone who has a relative who settles abroad because most people often use WhatsApp to text.

Facebook Messenger

You can use sticker, make free calls, record voice messages and send free text messages with Facebook Messenger. Messenger is a pretty useful application to keep in touch with people. Also, since it's related to Facebook, you'll easily find anyone on it.

Snapchat

If you're in your teens, download this app and share your images with other peers.

Best social networking application



Facebook Paper

Paper is Facebook's new app that lets you track your News Feed in a more modern user interface. Everything looks better in the Paper application and it allows you to follow popular news stories on a variety of topics.

Twitter

If you haven't used Twitter yet, try it now. Even if you never post anything, you can still get a lot of useful information by following up properly.

LinkedIn

Even if you own a business, you should have a profile on LinkedIn. It is the best social networking site for professionals. Companies use LinkedIn a lot to find talent, so keep track of your connections through this app.

Pinterest

Netflix

If you have a Netflix subscription, you will definitely want your iPhone to have a binge-watch application Breaking Bad or House of Cards.

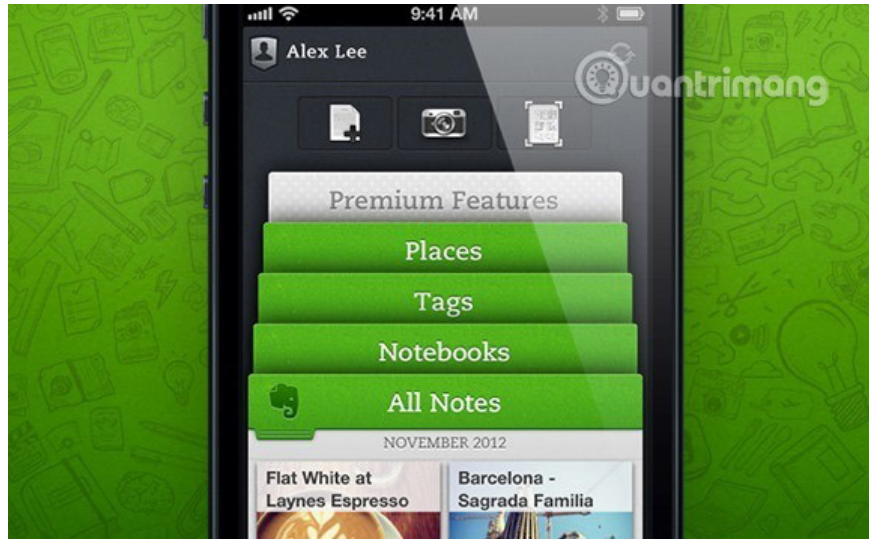
Amazon Instant Video

Best note application



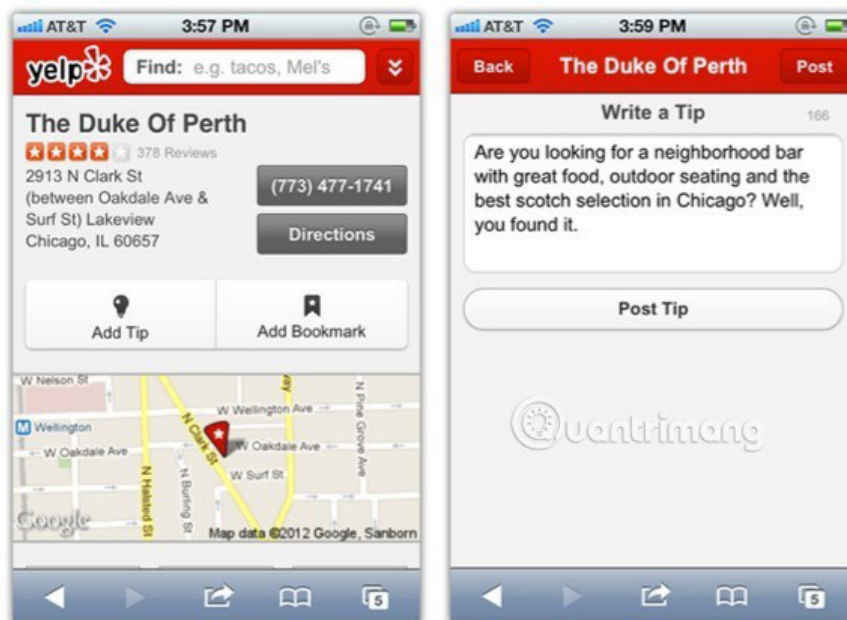
Evernote

The application searches for addresses near you best



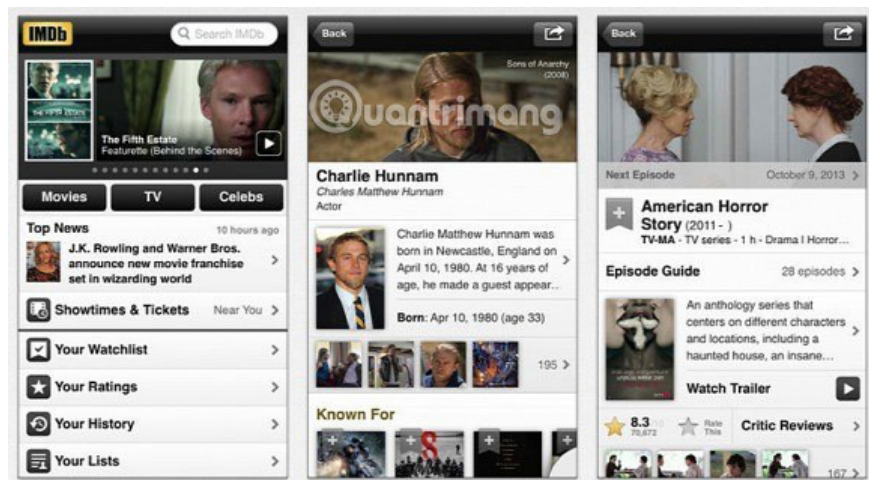
Yelp

Google Search

Find My iPhone

Mint

Do you have credit cards, bank accounts, loans, investments or mortgages? If yes, follow them all by using the Mint app for free.

Runkeeper

Runkeeper is the only jogging app mentioned in this article because it's free and it's really great to keep track of your physical activity.
