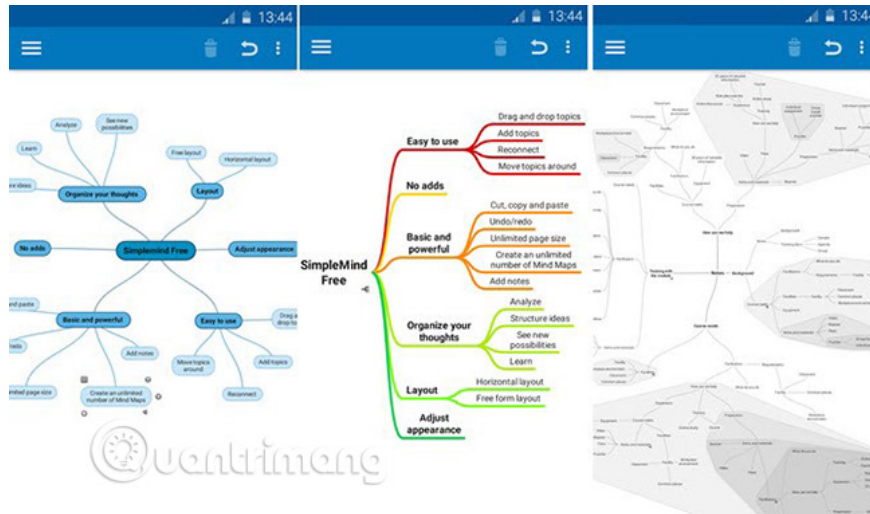

1. SimpleMind

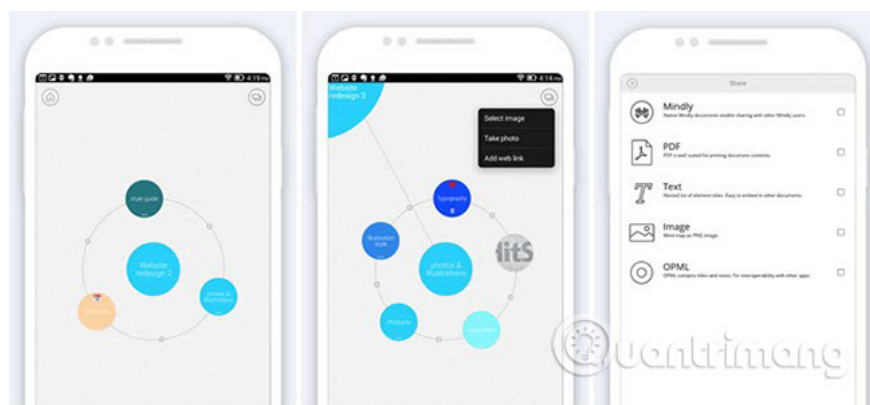


SimpleMind is one of the most popular mind map applications for Android, helping you organize and deploy your ideas better. The plus points of SimpleMind are that with its intuitive user interface and tools, you can create a series of mind maps with just a few taps. Features for the free version of SimpleMind application are not limited to the ability to create free layout maps, integrated auto layouts, unlimited page sizes, number of elements, stylesheet (stylesheet) predefined, ability to mark branches, support multiple maps on one page, etc.

For advanced features like labels, automatic numbering, reordering and refactoring, etc., you need to buy the Pro version. Moreover, the application features cross platform, ie, it supports iOS, Windows and Mac OS.

1. **Advantages** : Very easy to use and has all the features you need to create mind maps. This application is compatible with many platforms and you can download the application on request from the official website: <https://simplemind.eu/>. You do not have to register for the service to use the application for free.
2. **Cons** : Compared to the Pro version, the free version is limited in features. However, it's quite enough for you to start, create and manage mind maps.
3. **Is it free?** The basic version is free. For advanced features, you can download the Pro version for \$ 5.99.

2. Mindly

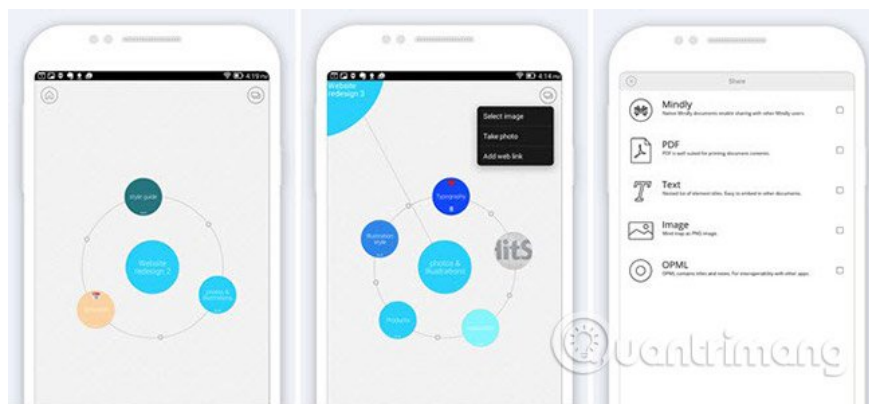


Mindly is another popular application that not only looks beautiful, but also allows you to create many different mind maps to plan the project, whether it's structuring, collecting ideas, or any other task. any other case. In

addition to creating complex and logical mind maps, you can use it for simpler things like writing a quick summary, preparing for a speech or meeting, etc. Mindly has everything including the necessary features that you need such as support for hierarchies between elements, the ability to add colors, symbols and images to the elements, the ability to reorganize content, export as PDF, OPML or Text, clipboard images, password protection, Dropbox sync, etc. So if you are looking for a simple, beautiful and full-featured thinking mapping application, Mindly is the app for for you.

1. **Advantages** : The app's user interface is minimalistic and helps you focus on creating mind maps to suit your ideas. The ability to synchronize with Dropbox and export is very useful features.
2. **Disadvantages** : The free version is limited in features. For example, the free version lacks some important features such as password protection, additional export options, search functionality, etc.
3. **Is it free?** The base version is free and you can unlock additional features with in-app purchases.

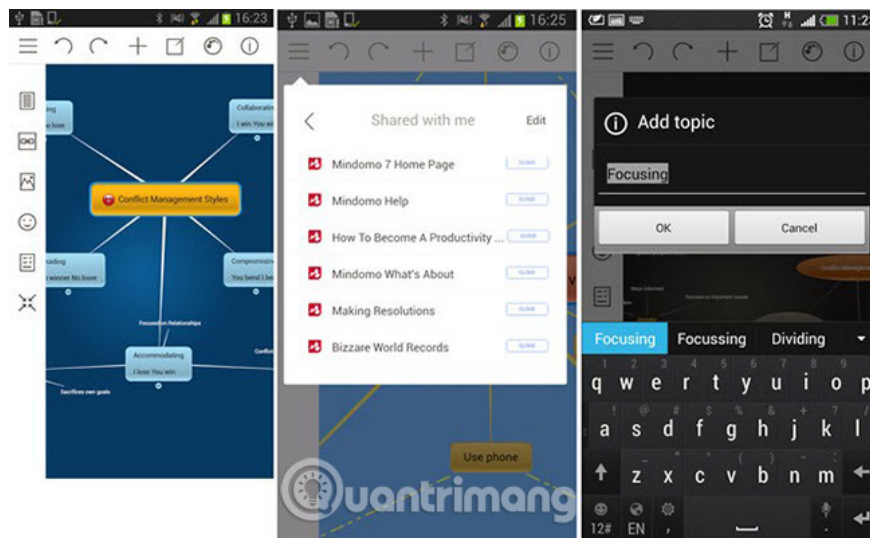
3. Mindomo



Mindomo is one of the best full-featured and free thinking mind map apps for Android. This application is specially designed for schools and students. Therefore, the application integrates with the organization's or school's Google Apps or Office 365 accounts. Some of the app's unlimited features include video and audio notes, web image search, predefined templates, history tracking, import and export of mind maps, bookmarks page, integrating FTP, integrating Google Drive and Dropbox, collaborative mind mapping, custom mind map themes, etc. To make things better, Mindomo supports other platforms like Windows, MacOS, Linux and iOS.

1. **Advantages** : Free application and compatible with many platforms. Support integration of Google Apps, Office 365, Google Drive and Dropbox. You can download the app for other platforms from: <https://www.mindomo.com/fr/>
2. **Disadvantages** : Although the user interface is quite minimalistic, small icons can make it difficult to create mind maps. This is especially true when you are using this application on a small screen Android device.
3. **Is it free?** Yes, it's free.

4. Gureum



Among all the shared apps here, Gureum is quite unique and created for a specific purpose. Unlike other applications, you can create text-based thinking maps and logical hierarchies. Because the application creates hierarchical mind maps, it is suitable for things like writing logic of good programs for quick and reasonable notes, etc. If you want, you can also import mapping files Other only from compatible programs. However, this app is quite small and you won't get any advanced features, like with other apps in the list.

1. **Advantages** : This is a simple text-based application created for specific purposes, ie notes and create hierarchical mind maps.
2. **Disadvantages** : Compared to other mind map applications, Gureum is quite limited in features. Moreover, besides text-based hierarchical thinking maps, you cannot create any other kind of mind map.
3. **Is it free?** Yes, it's free.
