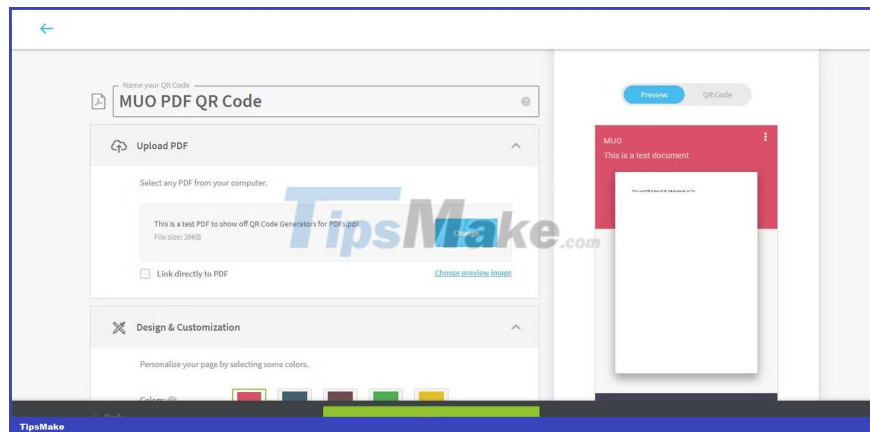


4 best QR code generator tools for PDF

If you're trying to share a document but want to keep all images, formatting, fonts, etc. intact, then a PDF is the way to go. But did you know that you can also share an entire PDF file from a QR code?

This allows you to share the information in your QR code with the peace of mind that it will be received with the exact same content as you created it. Better yet, there are many different online services that allow you to generate QR codes quickly and easily. Here are the 4 best QR code generator tools for PDF.

1. QR Code Generator for PDF



First on this list is the QR Code Generator for PDF. If you're looking for a surprisingly powerful set of features that you can use to convert your PDF files to QR code format, this is a great place to start.

To get started with this QR code generator, you first need to sign up for an account. If you're worried about privacy or simply don't have email, there are plenty of ways to instantly create a new email address for yourself that you can use. Creating an account will give you a 13+ day free trial of all the features mentioned and after that, your code will expire.

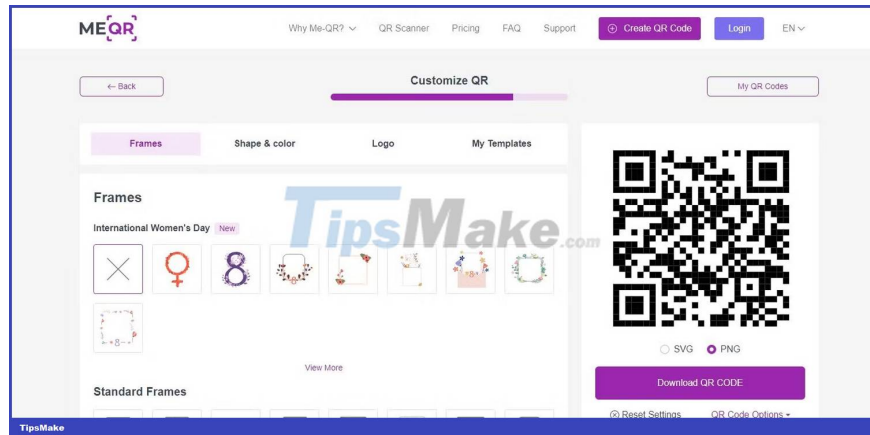
If you create an account, QR Code Generator for PDF allows you to get more out of your QR code. You can upload a PDF file to have your QR code run directly into the file, or you can create a small landing page to help explain the file.

For example, you can give the page a title explaining that you're sharing a category with a brief description of what's inside. If you go this route, you can adjust the colors used for this landing page and even upload the logo to display while the page loads, which is pretty impressive.

Once you've chosen how you want your PDF to be displayed, you can also tailor the features to your own QR code. This includes frames that ask the user to scan a QR code, the color of the code, how the code looks, and even a logo that you can add in the middle of the code.

There are tons of customization possibilities here to choose from, which is great for making QR codes work exactly the way you want them to.

2. Me-QR



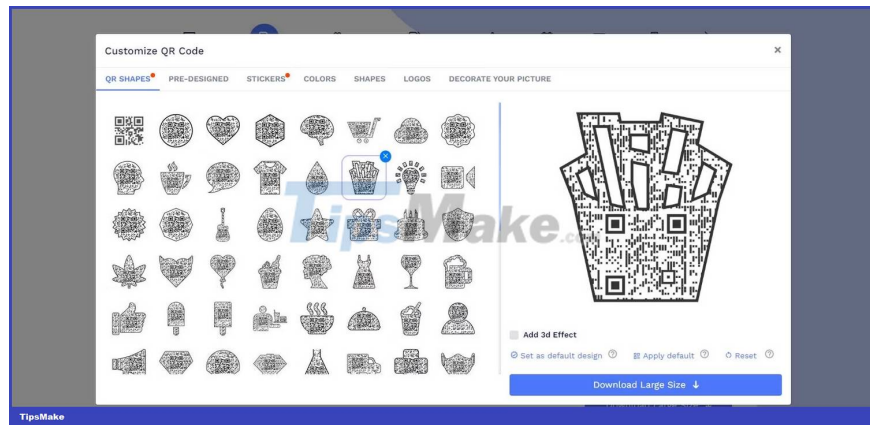
Next on this list is Me-QR. If you are looking to convert your PDF file to QR code with various QR code and frame options, this is a good option to use.

There are not many options for displaying PDF files with Me-QR. All you can really do is upload your PDF and Me-QR will generate a QR code to open the file directly to anyone who scans it.

However, where Me-QR really shines is when you start to tweak the way your QR codes are displayed. Here are options for different frame types, frame color, additional text, QR code pattern, QR code color, shape, logo, etc.

If you want to create a really unique looking QR code, this is a great way to do it. On top of that, you get access to all of these features, plus analytics and statistics such as how many people accessed your QR code when you signed up for an account. The only downside here is that Me-QR puts ads in your QR code unless you pay for a premium subscription.

3. QRcode Chimp



QRcode Chimp has some more unique QR code designs, with lots of customization options that look really different from what many other QR code generators are offering.

To get started with QRcode Chimp, you'll first need to register to upload your PDF, but once that's done, you'll be ready to customize the QR code to your liking.

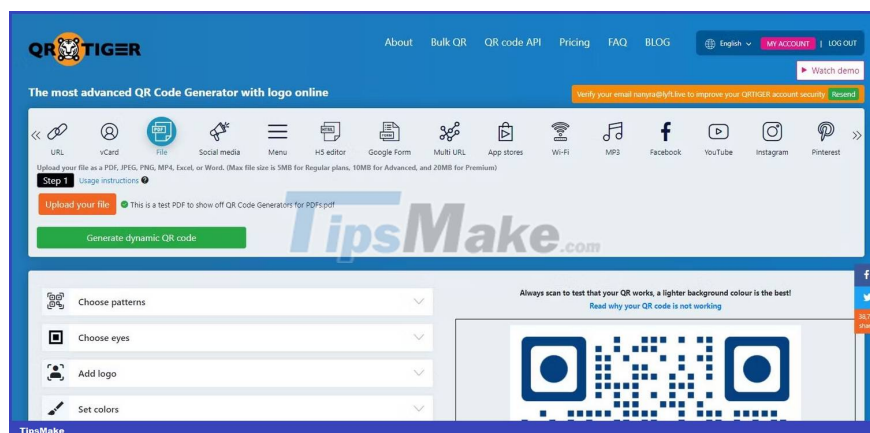
There are a lot of great simple online tools for generating QR codes, but the options here are really different from what you would normally think of QR codes, even though they work the same.

There are options for clothes, dialogue bubbles, animals, plants, food, etc. On top of that, you can add additional aspects like changing the color of the QR code, adding borders, Adjust QR code shape and add logo.

There are a ton of options and sliders here that you can use to tweak how the final result looks, so if you have a specific idea, this is a great way to get around. It.

With QRcode Chimp you can do all this for free. For larger files, more dynamic QR codes, more scans per month, etc., you might consider upgrading to a premium account.

4. QRTiger



Finally, we have QRTiger. If you're looking for a reliable little QR code generator for your PDF files, then QRTiger might be just what you're looking for.

QRTiger allows you to easily generate online QR codes for your PDF files. All you have to do is upload your PDF file and create an account, then everything will be ready.

The QR customization options here are quite interesting, with a nice variety of combinations that aren't overwhelming. You can adjust the pattern that the QR code uses, how it looks, add a logo and adjust the colors, and more.

With a free QRTiger account, you'll get access to 3 dynamic QR codes, meaning you can edit them once they're released, as well as see an analysis of how they're performing. This also includes the QRTiger logo pop-up, which you can avoid by upgrading to the premium plan.
