Playing SNES games on Android is really easy, thanks to a series of well-established emulators.

Here are the favorite SNES emulators for Android.

### 1. Retroarch

If you're looking to play games, not only from SNES but also from most other retro consoles that exist, Retroarch is definitely a wise choice. The setup can be a bit difficult, plus a huge amount of options - from shaders to graphic editing or driver changes - makes beginners feel overwhelmed, but the popularity of Retroarch as a role. A basic front-end simulator is worth it.



Retroarch allows you to download 'cores', essentially emulators included in Retroarch. There are quite a number of SNES cores to choose from, but in the opinion of many users, the best option is **Snes9x**, which works with a great balance between accuracy and quality.

### 2. Snes9x EX / +

Snes9x EX and EX + are other Android-specific SNES emulators, if you don't want to use Retroarch.

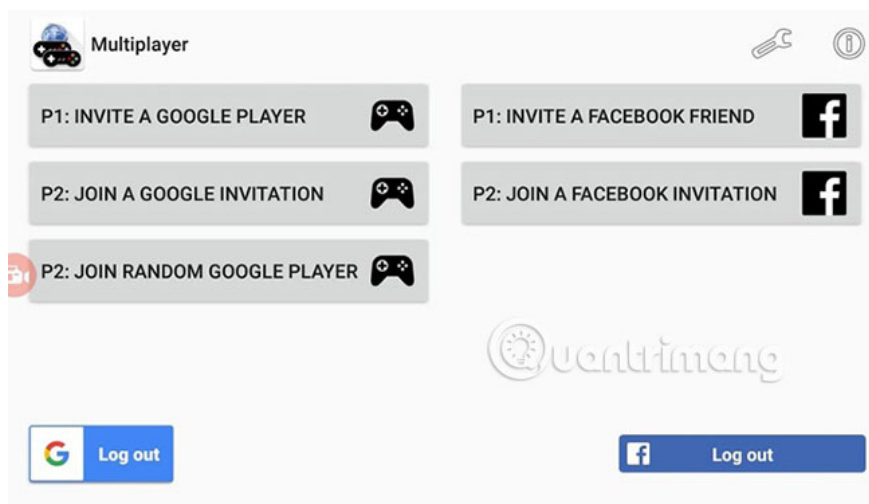


The EX + variant of the app is available in Play Store and is designed for powerful devices. You can find the regular version EX on the developer's website (link: <http://www.explusalpha.com/home/snes9x-ex/downloads>) and use it to run on low-end devices. . Although these emulators are not updated as often as the Retroarch Snes9x cores, they still work very well. Snes9x has many options to tweak and choose.

Like most SNES emulators for Android, the PS4 and Xbox One controllers will easily detect automatically, via Bluetooth and have the appropriate buttons assigned to them.

### 3. Multi Snes9x

Another variant of the open source Snes9x emulator, Multi Snes9x, solves one of the concerns from emulation: Play online games. Although operating perfectly as a player emulator, the real focus of Multi Snes9x is to allow you to play your favorite SNES games with your friends on the LAN or online.



Locally, you can play games with people via a router or Wi-Fi Direct. Multi Snes9x is surprisingly stable and there are very few problems with extracting.

Multi Snes9x has all the options you want in an online emulator, including instant messaging capabilities in games. You sign in with your Google or Facebook account and can invite friends to play through one of those platforms.

### 4. John NESS

If you remember that the paid John NES and John SNES emulators have been removed from Play Store due to copyright infringement, you will feel familiar with John NESS. This is the next part, combining NES, SNES and GBA emulators in a single package. (You can still download the original John NES and John SNES emulator from their official website).



Everything about this emulator works smoothly with high accuracy. It has a variety of common features like shader, turbo button, save-state (a form of game saved in the emulator), cheat and many other features you expect to find on an emulator. .

This is one of the most updated emulators, although you should know that this developer has previously been accused of using (and making money through in-app purchases) the exact code. used in existing Snes9x, VBA-M

and FCEUX emulators.

Above are some of the best SNES emulators you can get for Android and don't need to pay a penny to use them! You should use a controller and a good controller controller because the touch screen can never replace the feel of the real controller.
