

4 extremely simple ways to rotate the computer screen to your liking

4 ways to rotate your computer screen will help you display more website content and save space at the edge of the screen when rotating horizontally.

Customizing **the laptop screen rotation** helps you meet specific work needs. However, sometimes you accidentally rotate the computer screen and don't know how to reset it to default. In this article, TipsMake will guide you **how to rotate your computer screen** .

Benefits of rotating computer and laptop screens

Knowing **how to rotate a laptop screen** will bring many benefits to users, specifically as follows:

1. You can customize your computer screen as you like to meet your work, study or personal preferences.
1. Knowing **how to rotate the computer screen horizontally** or vertically helps you use the computer both vertically and horizontally.
2. When your computer encounters an error, you can quickly restore the screen to its default state.

4 ways to rotate computer and laptop screens in Windows 10, 8, 7

To **rotate the computer screen of Win 10** , Win 8 and Win 7, do one of the following 4 ways:

How to rotate Windows 10 computer screen in Display Settings

Step 1: Right-click any empty space on the Desktop screen and then click **Display Settings**.

Step 2: Continue clicking on **Display**.

Step 3: In the new dialog box that opens, select **Orientation** and start customizing one of the following options:

1. **Landscape** is the default vertical screen customization.
2. **Portrait** is the option to rotate the screen horizontally to the left.
3. **Landscape (flipped)** is the option to rotate the screen upside down.

4. **Portrait (flipped)** is the option to rotate the screen horizontally to the right.

Step 4: After you have finished setting the customizations, click **Keep Change** to save the newly changed customizations or click **Revert** to cancel and reset.

Rotate Windows laptop screen using Graphics Options

How to rotate the computer screen includes the following 2 steps:

Step 1: Right-click anywhere on the Desktop screen and select **Graphics Options** .

Step 2: In the new dialog box that opens, click on **Rotation** and then customize the screen rotation by choosing one of the following 4 options:

1. **Rotate to 0 Degrees** means the screen will display along the default setting.
2. **Rotate to 90 Degrees** is to customize the screen to rotate horizontally to the left.
3. **Rotate to 180 Degrees** is the option to rotate the screen downwards.
4. **Rotate to 270 Degrees** is a customization for the screen to rotate horizontally to the right.

So, with just 2 simple steps you can successfully rotate your laptop screen.

How to rotate Windows 7 laptop screen in Screen Resolution

Step 1: Right-click anywhere on the laptop screen and select **Screen resolution**.

Step 2: In the new window that appears on the screen, continue to select **Orientation** and customize **the rotation of the Win 7 screen** with one of the following 3 options:

1. **Landscape** is the option to rotate the laptop screen upside down.
2. **Portrait** is the option **to rotate the computer screen** to the left.
3. **Portrait (flipped)** is the option **to rotate the laptop screen** to the right.

Use the key combination to rotate the computer screen in Windows 10, 8, 7

The following are **key combinations to rotate the Windows 10 computer screen** to help you as you like:

1. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Up Arrow** to rotate the display vertically by default.
2. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Down Arrow** to rotate the computer screen downwards.

3. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Left arrow** to rotate the computer screen horizontally to the left.
4. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Right arrow** to customize **the horizontally rotated computer screen in Windows 10** to the right.

Why does the laptop screen rotate?

The computer screen being rotated in different directions is not a serious problem and you don't need to worry too much. The cause of this problem may be that while using and manipulating the computer, you pressed a certain key combination by mistake.

And there are many **ways to rotate the computer screen** to default to fix this problem. Specifically, follow the next content for more detailed instructions.

Fix laptop screen rotation error

Currently, there are 2 ways to fix the problem of rotating the computer screen as follows:

Fix laptop screen with Rotation using Rotation

How to rotate the computer screen using the mouse is as follows:

Step 1: Right-click anywhere on the Desktop screen and select **Graphics Options > Rotation > Built-in Display > Rotate to 0 Degrees** .

If your computer uses Windows 7, select **Screen resolution** , if your computer uses Windows 10, select **Display settings** .

Step 2: After opening the new dialog box, in the **Display orientation** section , choose the screen rotation type that best suits you by clicking on one of the following 4 options:

1. **Landscape** is the option to rotate the screen horizontally in the default direction.
2. **Landscape (flipped)** is the option to rotate and reverse the screen.
3. **Portrait** is the option to rotate the screen to the left at a 90 degree angle.
4. **Portrait (flipped)** is the option to rotate the screen to the right at a 90 degree angle.

Fix laptop screen rotated with keyboard shortcuts

In addition to using the mouse to fix the screen rotation error, you can also use the following keyboard shortcuts:

1. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Up Arrow** to rotate the screen horizontally in the default direction.
2. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Down arrow** to reverse the screen.

3. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Left Arrow** to rotate the screen to the left at a 90 degree angle.
4. Press the key combination **CTRL + ALT + Right Arrow** to rotate the screen to the right at a 90 degree angle.
