

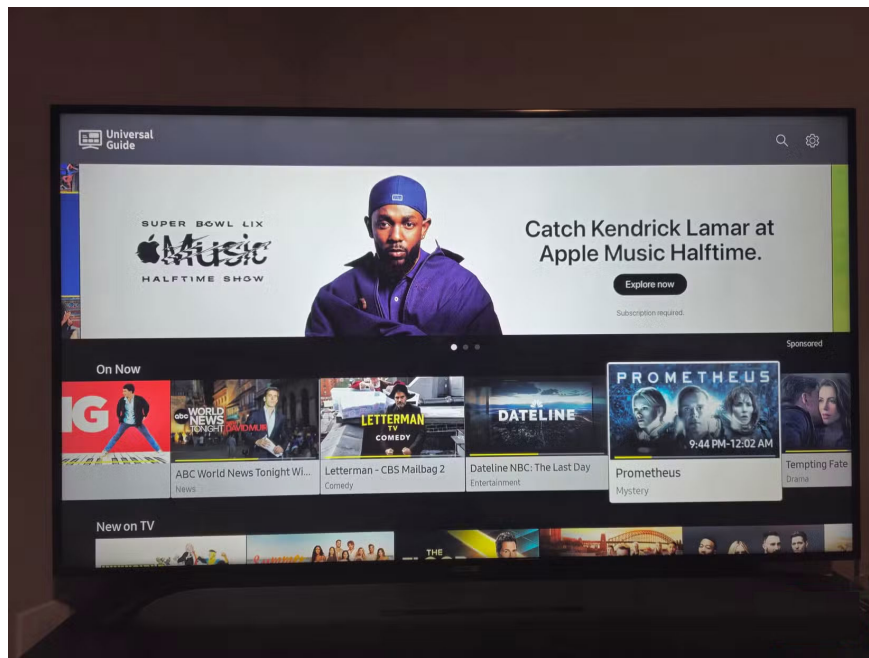

4. Universal Guide

With so many specialized streaming services out there, it can be difficult to keep track of all the content on these platforms. With platforms like Prime and Hulu, this isn't a huge problem since most of the content is available on-demand. On the other hand, if you're already subscribed to streaming platforms to watch live TV, you can easily miss out on a long-awaited show or event because you weren't tuned to the right platform at the right time.



Samsung's Universal Guide solves this problem by organizing all your content in one place, making it easy to see what's streaming without having to manually check each app.

Note : You can usually access Universal Guide by pressing the Home button on your remote. You must have a Samsung account set up and a stable Internet connection to access this feature.

3. Samsung TV Plus

If you subscribe to streaming platforms, you know how expensive they've become lately. Of course, there are ways to cut the cost of streaming subscriptions, but not everyone wants to watch ads or share their account to save money. That's why Samsung TV Plus, a built-in streaming service that comes with most Samsung TVs, is so popular.

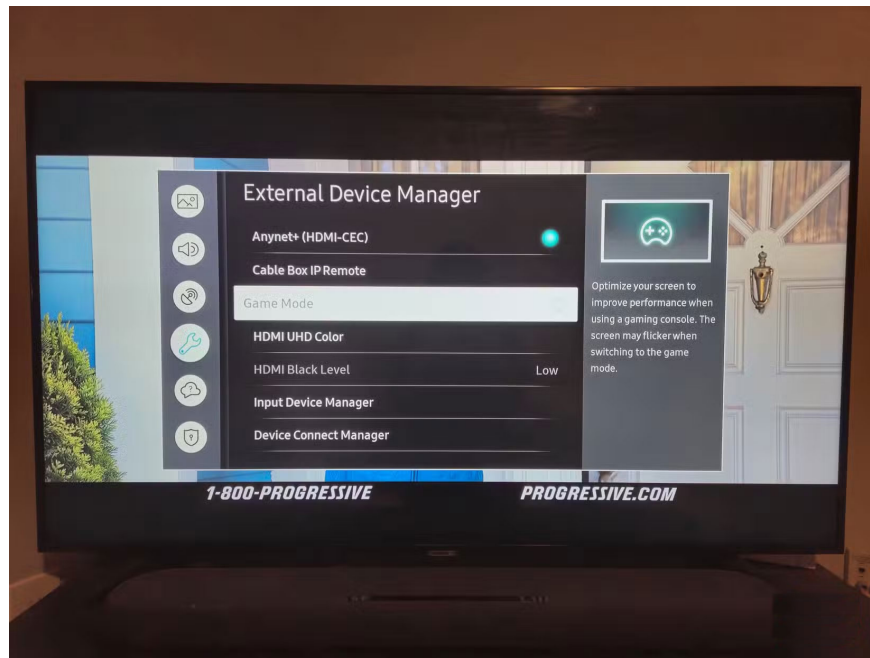
The service lets you watch over 100 live channels, including sports and news, without requiring a separate subscription, additional equipment, or downloads. Best of all, you get all of this for free. Keep in mind, though, that the library isn't as extensive as Netflix and Prime, but there's still plenty of content worth exploring.



You're not limited to watching this content at home on your Samsung TV. Downloading the Samsung TV Plus app will give you access to all your on-demand movies and shows, as well as live content, on your smartphone or tablet. You can download the Samsung TV Plus mobile app through the Play Store or Galaxy Store.

2. Game Mode

Many people own gaming consoles. If you're one of them, enable Game Mode on your Samsung Smart TV. This setting often improves your gaming experience by reducing lag and motion blur.



If you have a new Samsung smart TV, you'll find that this setting is automatically enabled the first time you connect your game console to your TV. If you have an older TV or have turned it off at some point, you'll have to manually turn it back on. Either way, once you do, you'll have a better gaming experience.

1. Screen mirroring via SmartThings app

If you want to share content directly from your Samsung phone to your Samsung smart TV, the SmartThings app can be useful. This feature is especially useful if you don't want to use external hardware like a Google Chromecast or an HDMI cable to connect your devices.

As long as you have a Samsung smartphone with the SmartThings app, you can wirelessly stream content from your phone to your TV screen by touching the back of your phone to the TV. A light tap will activate the feature. You can also use AirPlay to mirror content if you have an iPhone.



These are just a few of the many features you might stumble upon while using a Samsung TV. Some other Samsung smart TV features worth checking out include multi-view, which lets you watch multiple content sources at once, ambient mode settings that help your TV blend in with its surroundings (a big benefit as lifestyle TVs become more popular), and Bixby (Samsung's voice assistant) for hands-free TV control.
