While Grammarly can't completely replace the human editing eye, it's still an extremely effective 'writing assistant'.

2. ChatGPT



ChatGPT is increasingly becoming a reliable 'companion' for problem solving and brainstorming. Even the free version is enough to meet the needs of most users.

This tool helps writers brainstorm article titles, create outlines, research sources, or even explore complex concepts. Compared to manually searching on Google, ChatGPT quickly aggregates information and provides links to reliable sources like PubMed or the American Psychological Association (APA).

In addition, ChatGPT can also support learning, creative research, or simply bring a little joy when 'chatting' with artificial intelligence. Although not always perfect, if exploited properly, ChatGPT is a great tool to improve work performance.

3. Everything Search Tool



Instead of using the default Windows search bar, many people choose **Everything** – a super-fast file search tool, extremely convenient for those whose computers contain a series of overlapping folders.

Everything lets users type in a keyword and instantly see results in seconds. Even though it knows exactly where the files are, it's still a much faster time-saver than clicking through each folder.

Once installed, Everything will run smoothly in the background, helping users search for files quickly without consuming system resources.

4. Ditto Clipboard Manager



For those who frequently **copy and paste content**, Ditto Clipboard Manager is a real 'savior'. The default Windows Clipboard can only save one item, but Ditto allows users to save **a history of all copied content**, making it easy for users to retrieve it at any time.

Ditto's interface is simple, easy to use, and can be customized for storage time or maximum number of backups (default is 500). Users can quickly search through history or turn on 'Always on top' mode for convenience.

This tool is especially useful for writers, editors, students or anyone who regularly works with text.
