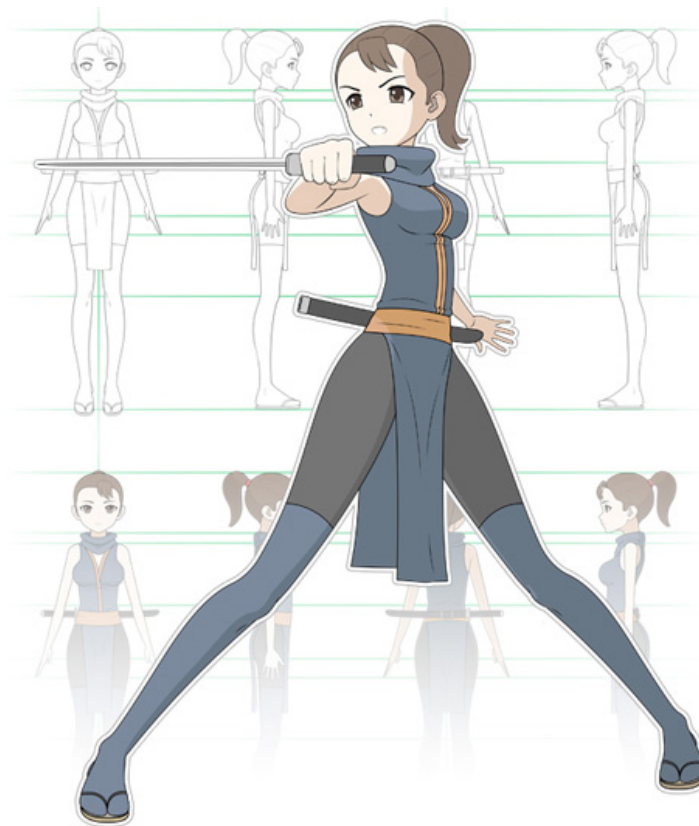


## 4 important steps for creating Manga characters - your own Anime

# Difference between Character Design and Normal Drawing

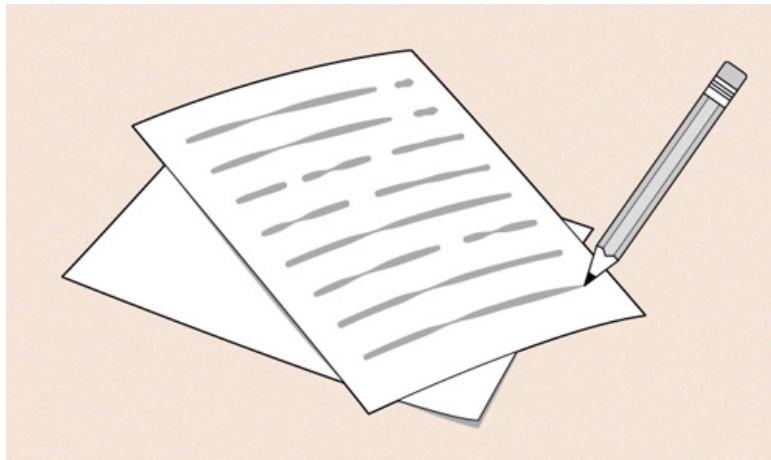
The design of a cartoon character in general, manga or anime in particular is quite different from painting, sketching a character once. When drawing once, you only care what the character looks like from a perspective in that picture. But when drawing comics, animation, character design needs you to draw from many different perspectives / angles to create diversity, to meet every situation happening in your story.

## Two things to keep in mind when designing and creating manga - anime characters

1. Characters should have a simple design. It will take a lot of time to draw too many characters with complex details.
2. Need to consider, consider, understand how your character will look at all angles. You will have to draw them from many different angles in many times.

## Steps for shaping Manga characters - Anime

### Step 1: Create character profile

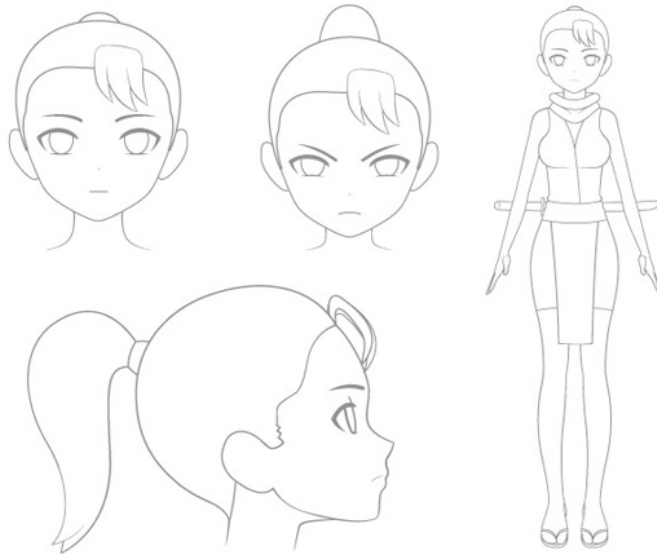


Write character profiles

**Decide how you want to draw the character** and choose the minimum details needed to convey the character to the viewer. For example, the type of clothes, accessories needed to describe the character in the best way.

Should **write down some basic information about the character** such as age, work, personality . and character design based on these characteristics.

### Step 2: Sketch the character briefly



### Sketch of manga and anime characters

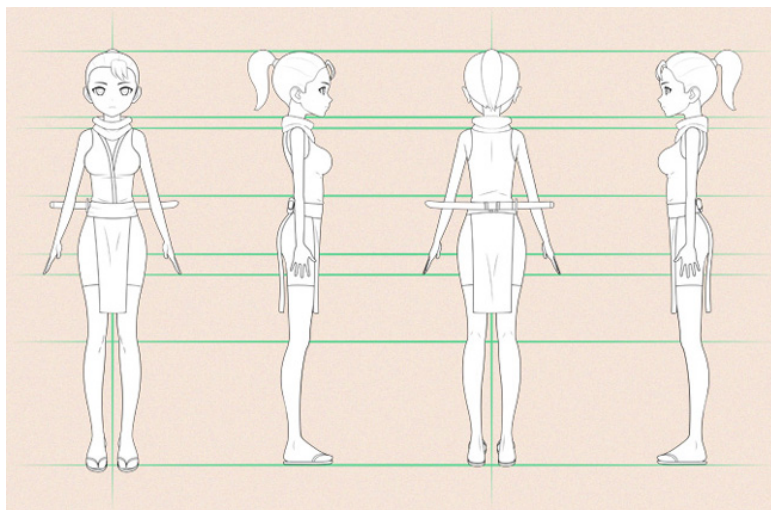
Sketch **sketches** of your **ideas** . This can be a **character image from any angle or posture** you want. Draw whatever you feel can describe your character well. Complete at least one outline of the whole body and several close-ups.

If your character is very big or very small, you can sketch it next to a character with a normal ratio to grasp the character size.

Use simple details or little details for the character, don't make the characters too complicated. You can add details later if you find the character too simple yet impressive.

When you've finished sketching, select the drawings you like best and combine them into your complete character.

### Step 3: Develop character formation



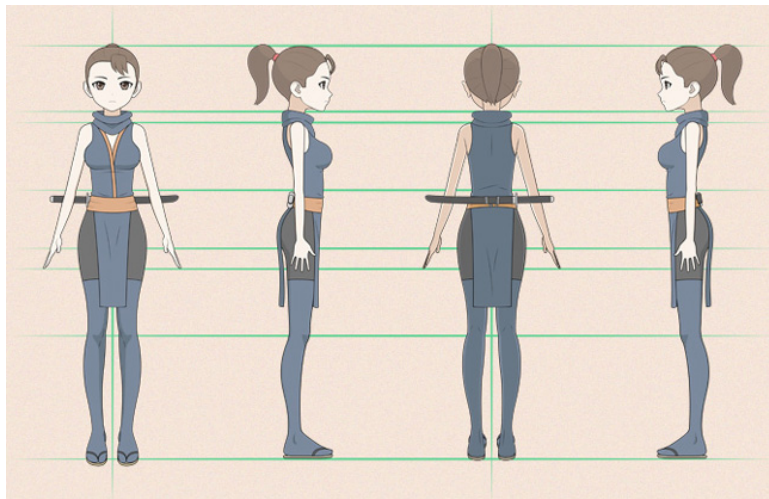
## Design of manga and anime characters

To continue developing your design, **draw characters from the front, from the sides (unless they're identical) and from the rear view** . You can also draw more details if needed.

Doing these drawings will help you get the most comprehensive view of the character, then use them as reference when you start drawing the work.

To keep the right proportions in different viewing angles and views, you can **draw basic guidelines for the body from one perspective to another** . Perspective notes are also important when drawing, there are different details that look at different angles. For example, you can see the foot in the figure above, looking at the right angle, it will be over the baseline.

### Step 4: Color your character

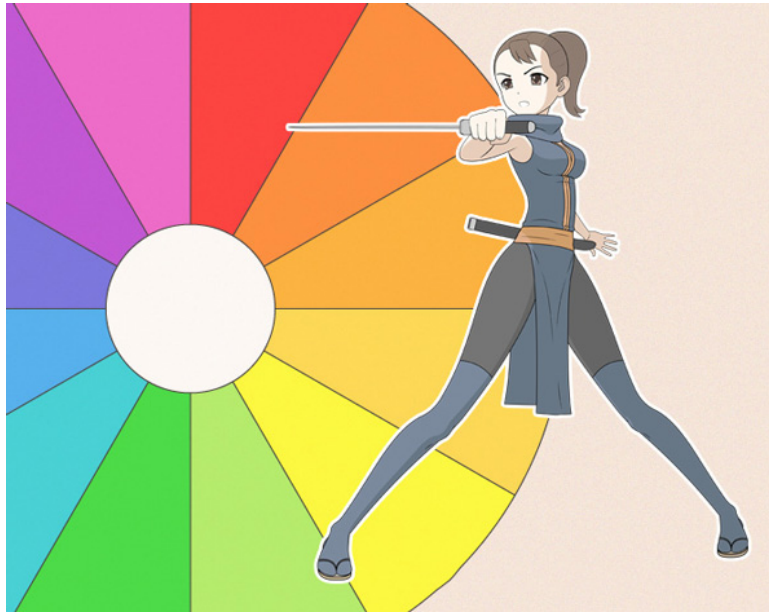


## Color design for manga and anime characters

The manga - anime are usually black and white, but sometimes they are still filled with colors to add a lively part, such as on the cover pages or some opening pages.

Even if you have a certain idea of ??color for your character, you should note some of the following points:

1. **Not all colors should work together** , color combinations, colors. Combined colors are often **complementary colors or opposite each other on the color wheel (color wheel)**, except black and white can be combined with almost all. You will often see manga characters - popular anime all use colors as stated. They do not necessarily have to be the exact opposite color on the wheel but may be the color / nuance near that color.
2. Choose colors that match the type of character you want to create. Colors also contribute to certain moods, details, characteristics for the character. For example, blue is considered a cool color, while red is a warm color, you create a fictional character using snow and ice magic.

## Tips for you

**Create characters that match the plot of the mine h.** Many manga - anime have big, generic, not so impressive characters, but the story is still very good. You should balance between originality and what fits your work.

For example, if your story is of a normal type, life slices, you should probably create characters like ordinary people around you. If you draw fantasy or science fiction, create a strange, unusual character for it to suit.

In addition, characters should not be copied from other people's works. Of course, if you take the idea, it doesn't matter, just don't copy the majority of the characters and make a little difference. **Use your ideas and creativity to produce your own works.**
