

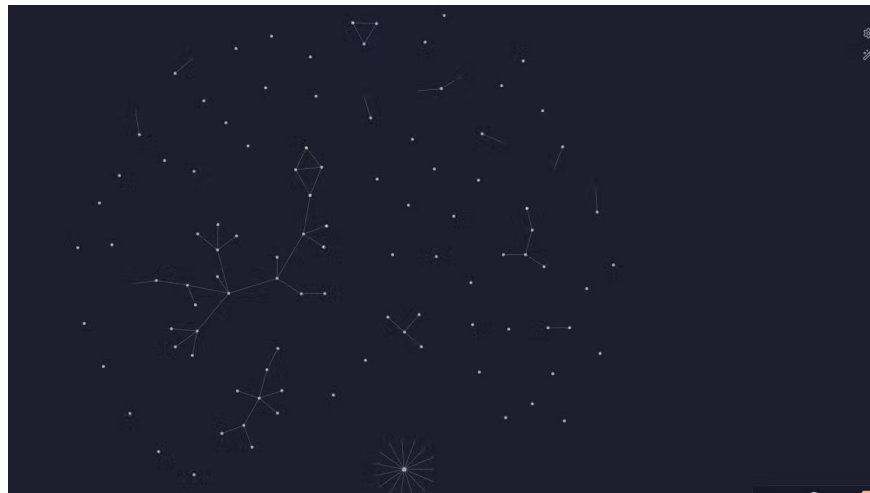
4 Smart Ways to Link Notes in Obsidian Automatically

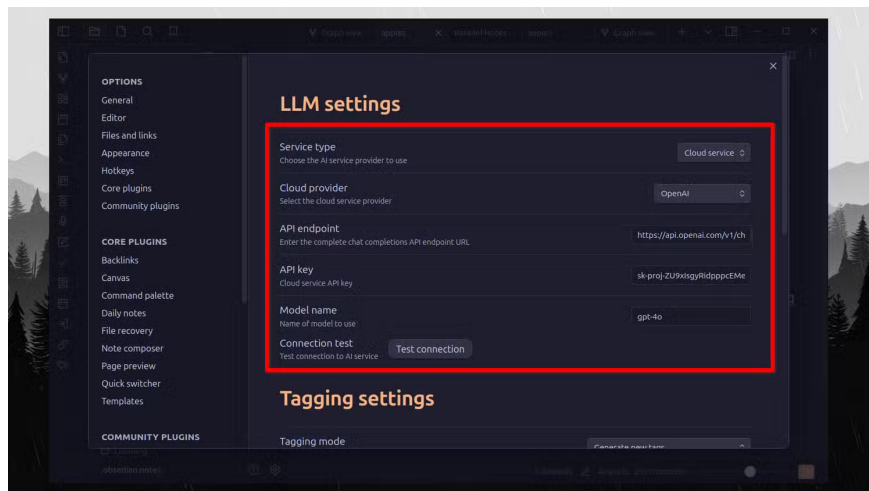
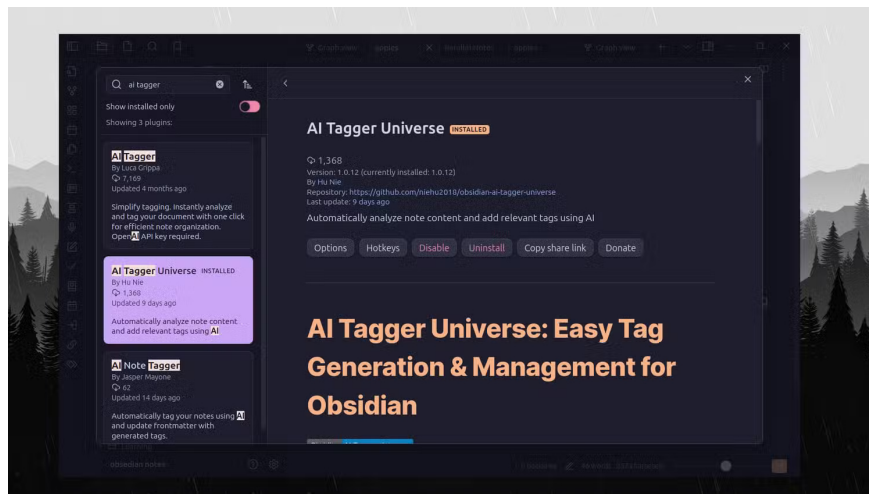
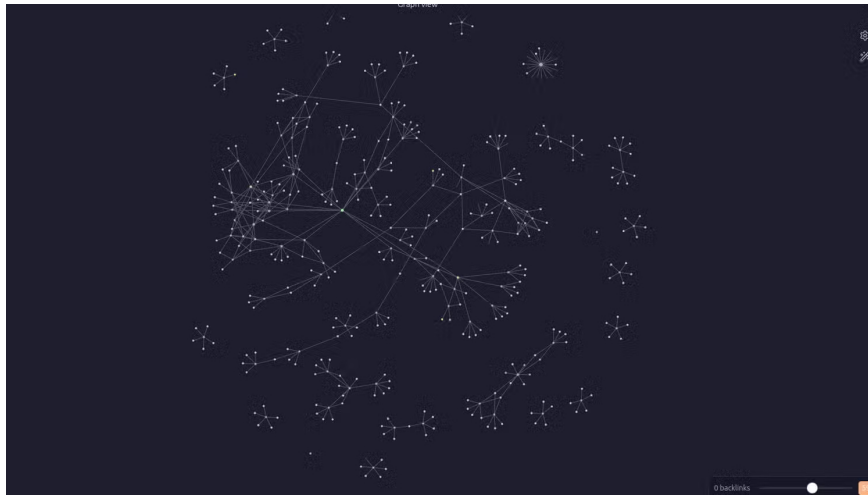
Obsidian is a powerful note-taking tool, and one of its best features is note linking. However, note linking needs to be done manually, which makes note-taking less enjoyable.

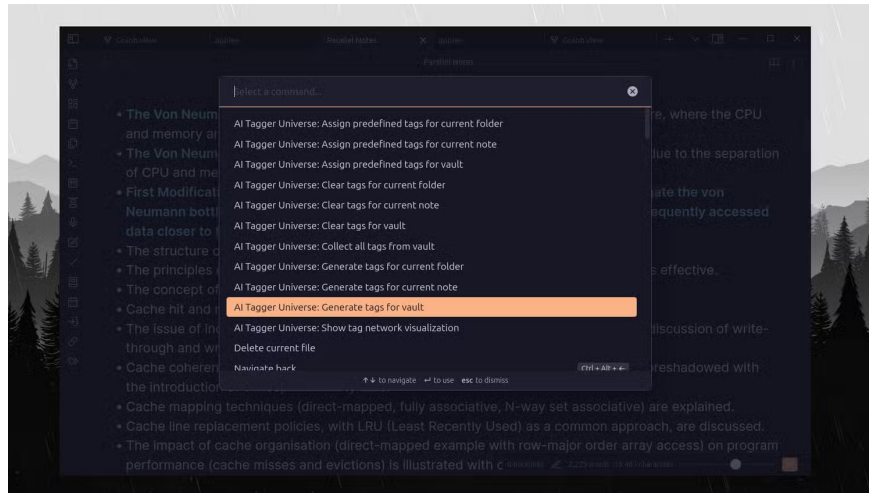
Obsidian is a powerful note-taking tool, and one of its best features is note linking. However, note linking has to be done manually, which makes note-taking less enjoyable. But there are alternatives that make note linking automatic. Building a second brain doesn't mean having to guess every link.

4. AI Tagger Universe

AI may be the buzzword of the moment, but if there's one thing that Obsidian can really do, it's automatic tagging - and luckily, there's a plugin for that. AI Tagger Universe automatically tags notes based on their content. It takes your notes into LLM and exports tags for your notes, all automatically. This can make organizing your knowledge base a lot easier. Especially if you have a lot of notes that need to be linked, this plugin is exactly what you need to try.







I tested the plugin on one of my Obsidian repositories with only a few notes connected to each other. After using the plugin, the repositories had much denser connections between notes. You can see that in the attached images.

The plugin works with AI services such as OpenAI, Gemini, Deepseek, etc. Furthermore, if you are concerned about privacy and don't want to share your data with external services, you can even run LLM locally using Ollama and connect it to the plugin.

Here's how you can set up the plugin:

1. Download the plugin, then enable the plugin.
2. Select service type (cloud or local LLM).
3. Choose a cloud provider.
4. Enter your API key and model name.
5. Check your connection to make sure it works.
6. Access your notes and open the command center with the keyboard shortcut (**Ctrl/Cmd + P**).
7. Type **AI Tagger** and you will see a list of options.

What I love most about this plugin is that it can help you discover connections and patterns in your knowledge base that you didn't even know existed. It's interesting to see the tags that the AI ??comes up with. During testing, the tagging was quite accurate and to the point. Furthermore, there's a useful batch feature where you can ask the plugin to tag all the notes in your repository.

Note : It is important to remember that using the API is expensive. However, you can run LLM locally for free.

3. Virtual Linker

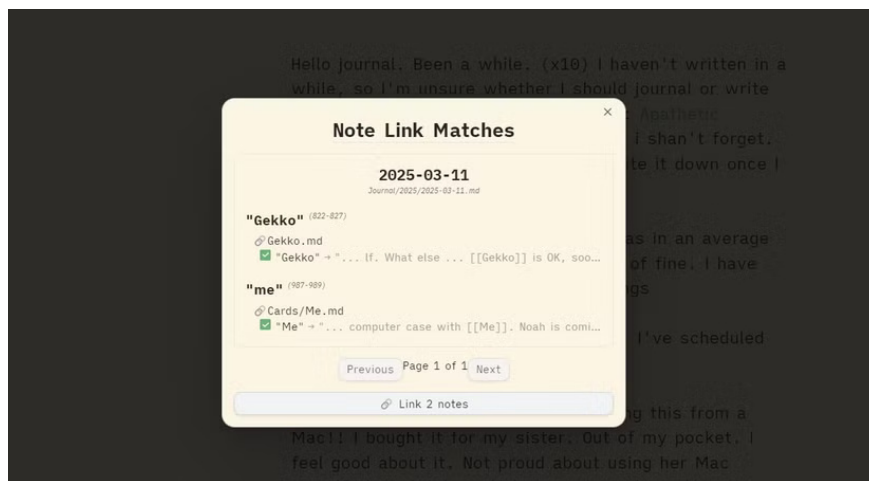

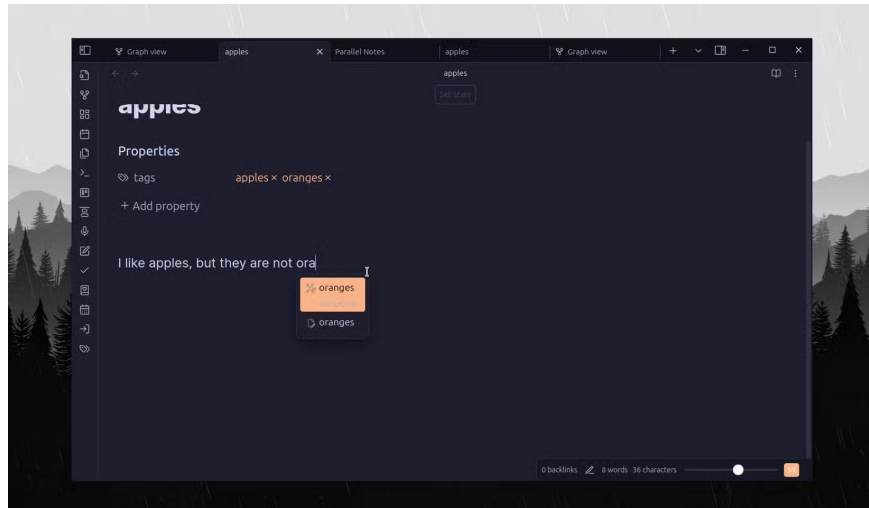

Now you've seen some plugins that can make note linking much more autonomous than the default. You should try them all and see for yourself. Use the AI ??Tagger Universe plugin and its bulk tagging feature to tag multiple notes at once (provided you have a lot of unlinked notes in Obsidian). But make sure to use stricter tagging rules, as the quality of the tags will depend on the configuration. Try changing the maximum number of tags created from 5 to 2. This means that only the 2 best tags will be used.

Then, for future notes, you can enable the Virtual Linker plugin. It will automatically detect potential notes to link to.
