Microsoft has just released a Technical Preview version of Office 15 for a small group of users with an undisclosed agreement on the software. Users can only download Office 15 Beta for trial and error for Microsoft from the summer of 2012. The complete version of Microsoft Office 15 is expected to appear on the market later this year.

Microsoft Office is an office suite that is very important for most computer users. In order to continue to maintain success in a rapidly changing technology world, Microsoft should take steps to match the new trend. Here are 4 expected innovations in Office 15.

1. A useful Web version

The current Web version of Office is not impressive when it only performs basic tasks. In some cases, users may not even create a background (wallpaper) or open a new editing page. Some users said that whenever they need to create or edit documents on the Web, they often switch to using Google Docs even though Microsoft Office is

still the main software suite they use every day.

2. Automatically sync 'to the cloud'

Microsoft has SkyDrive cloud storage service and Windows Live Mesh document synchronization software. However, no service has been integrated with Microsoft Office.

3. A single interface to open and manage documents

When having to deal with many different documents, users often need to open multiple files simultaneously from Word, Excel, PowerPoint. At that time, they cannot open Excel files through Word, but must use Excel applications themselves. . Some other office applications, like OpenOffice.org, have allowed this to be done long ago. The time has come for Microsoft to add this utility to its suite.

4. A version for Android or iOS

While more and more people are using mobile devices to work, but Android and iOS (on the iPad) are the two most popular platforms on mobile devices today, Microsoft should put Office 15 on Android and iOS. to increase the popularity of the software suite.
