Private message

When you message other WhatsApp users using WhatsApp Messenger, end-to-end encryption is used. This end-to-end encryption ensures that only you and the person you're messaging can see and hear your messages. No one else, not even WhatsApp, can hear and see these messages.

This is completely automatic and you don't need to turn on or set anything up for it to work.

Texting at work

All WhatsApp messages are secured with encryption before leaving your device. This means that if you use a WhatsApp business account, the messages you send will be secure - but keep in mind that this does not prevent someone from taking screenshots of your messages or forwarding secure messages. your password from the other end.

Pay

Not all countries have the option to use payments on WhatsApp, but in countries that support this feature, WhatsApp ensures payments can be made between accounts at financial institutions. While card and bank details are stored and encrypted in highly secure networks, financial institutions need certain information regarding these transactions.

That means while the bank details are encrypted, the information you send to the financial institution will not be end-to-end encrypted.

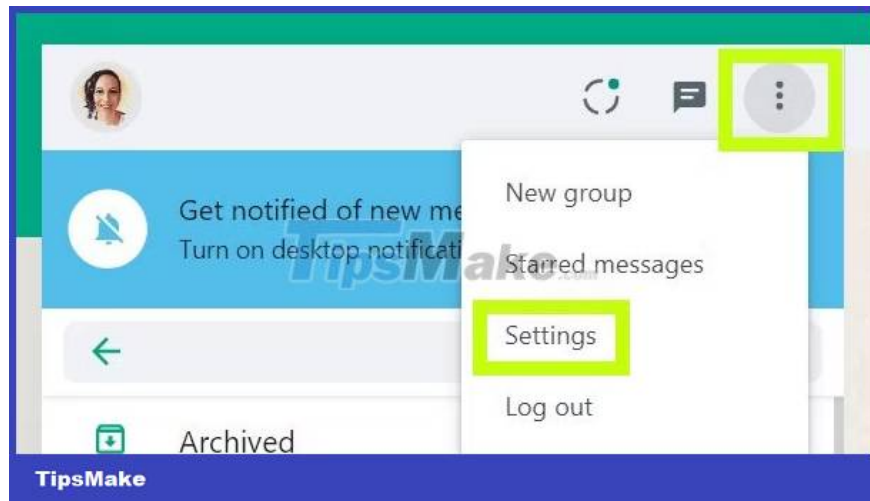
Control

WhatsApp wants to make sure that you only receive the messages that you want to receive. To help you do this, the platform provides the option to delete or block a person or company from sending you messages that you do not want to receive. You can do this by removing or blocking them directly from the chat, or by removing or blocking them from your contact list.

How to make WhatsApp Web more private

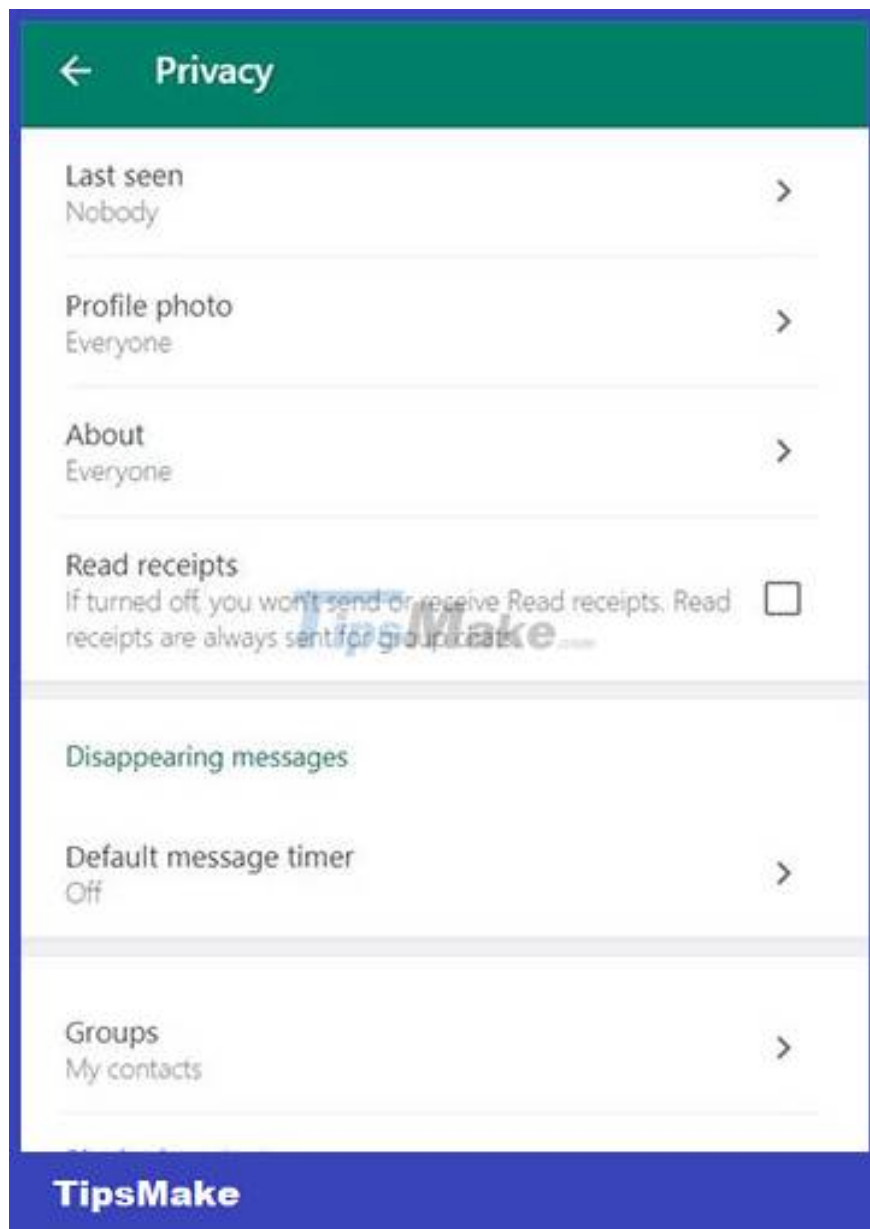
While knowing that you have a right to privacy and security when using WhatsApp Web, why not learn these simple tricks to know how WhatsApp accounts work. The article will list below some simple tips that anyone using the online web version can follow.

1. Sign in to your WhatsApp Web account using your laptop or desktop.
2. In the top left corner of the screen, you will see three dots representing the **Menu list**. Click here and then go to **Settings**.



3. Scroll down and click **Privacy**.

4. The **Privacy** menu has options to edit certain items in your WhatsApp Web account. The article will list them below with detailed explanations:



1. **Last seen** : Customize who saw when you last appeared. You won't be able to see when anyone else last appeared, unless you've enabled the feature.
2. **Profile photo** : Customize who is allowed to see your profile picture.
3. **About** : This is a small highlight that you add to your profile, and this setting allows you to choose who can see this information.
4. **Read receipts** : Read receipts will always be sent in group chats, however, for chats sent to individuals, you can turn this feature on and off. If it is turned off, you will not be able to confirm whether sent or received messages have been read.
5. **Disappearing messages** : WhatsApp offers the ability to set the length of time your messages can be viewed before they are deleted. Changing this setting does not affect existing messages.
6. **Groups** : Choose who can add you to group chats.
7. **Blocked contacts** : See who you've blocked and decide if you need to block them or if you need to unblock them.

Why should you use WhatsApp Web's privacy and security settings?

WhatsApp doesn't just want users to control their accounts, how information is sent and received, and how it is delivered. There are 4 main components that WhatsApp lists as the reasons why you should use WhatsApp Messenger.

Option to talk freely

Whether you are calling someone in your home country or in another country, WhatsApp Calling allows you to talk freely without fear of being overheard or recorded.

Keep the message to yourself

WhatsApp stores your messages using end-to-end encryption on your device. Nothing will be stored on the WhatsApp server once it is sent.

Keep them to yourself!

Confirm everything by yourself

You'll always be able to manually search to see if your messages are end-to-end encrypted. All you need to do is view the message itself or view the contact information to confirm.



Capture everything

WhatsApp has an end-to-end encryption explanation for those who want to learn more about it. This was developed in partnership with Open Whisper Systems, the same team that started the development of the Signal Protocol software, which now supports multiple end-to-end encryption, including WhatsApp.
