

5 attractive products expected to launch at Google I/O 2021

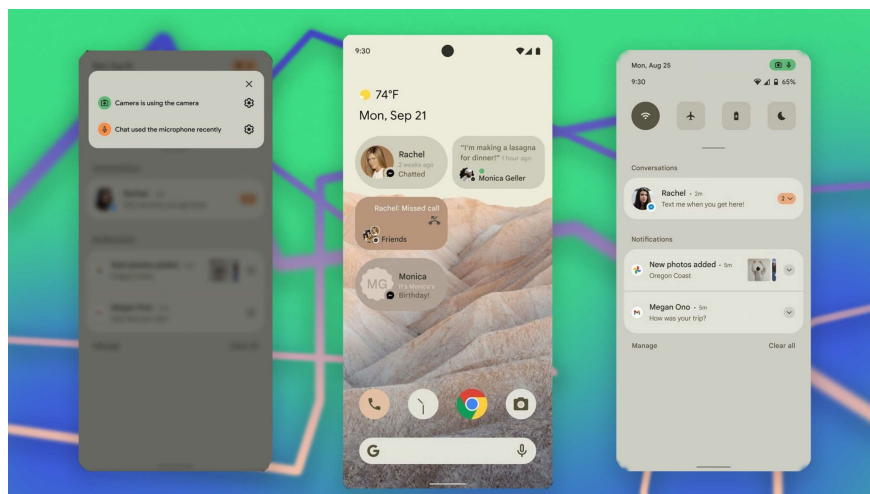
The Google I/O 2021 event is an opportunity for Google to showcase its latest technology products. Google I/O is the world's largest search engine developer's annual conference.

At the conference, the latest achievements in the field of technology such as web development, applications and hardware devices of Google will be introduced.



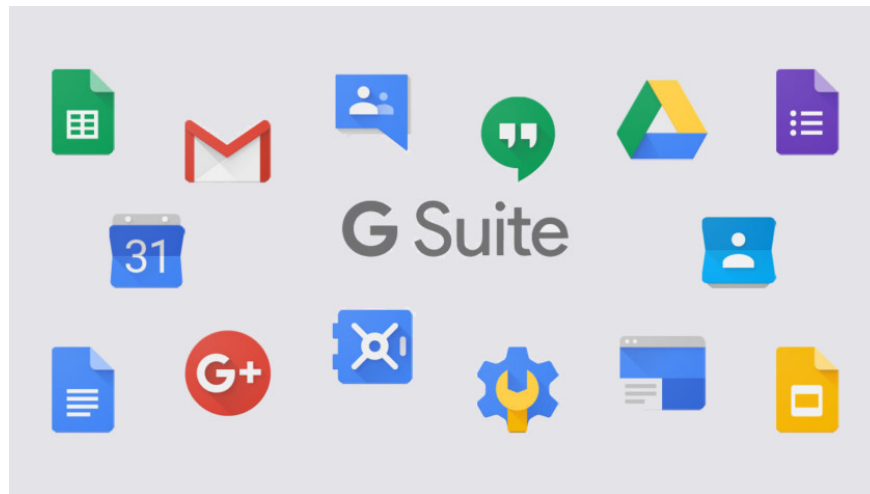

Pixel 5a or Pixel 6" smartphone



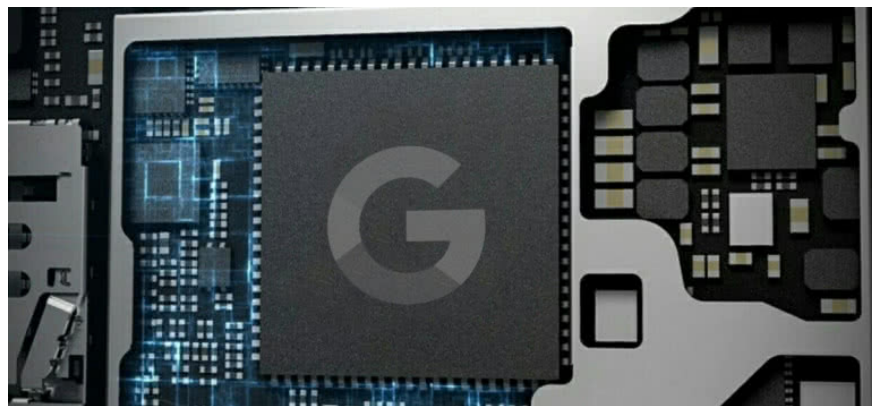
