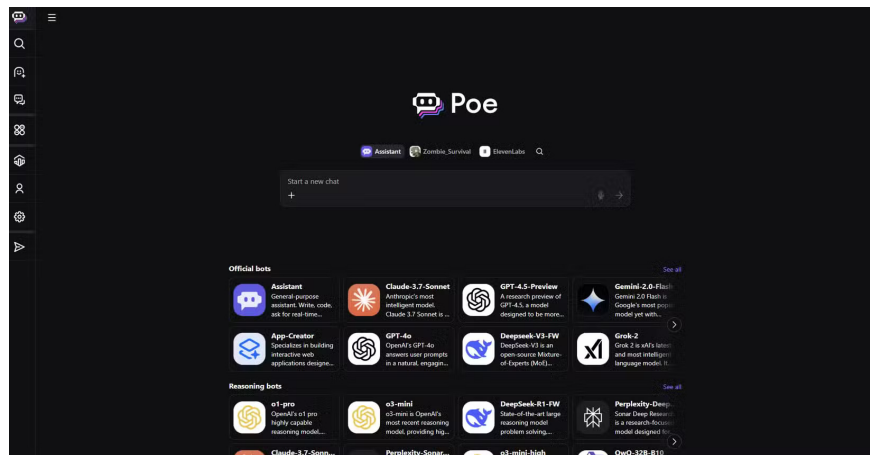


5 Best Apps to Try Multiple AI Chatbots at Once

No one wants to be limited to just one AI chatbot. Sure, you can sign up for a bunch of different AI tools and use them individually. But you can also do what you like and check out the best all-in-one AI chatbots that put them all into one app.

5. Poe



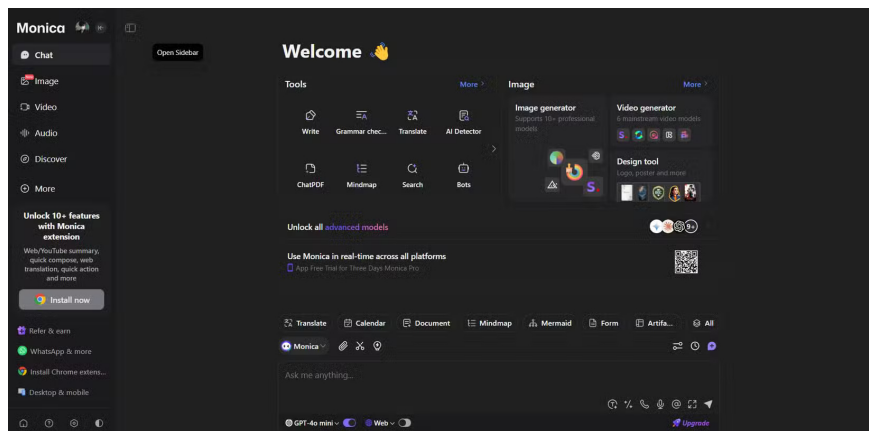
Poe offers a wide playground of AI models in a complete environment. Developed by question-and-answer site Quora, Poe offers a clean and user-friendly interface that provides seamless access to a variety of basic and advanced AI chatbots. After each prompt, you'll have the opportunity to try out different model responses to see which one you like best.

Poe offers the most extensive list of AI models, including popular models from OpenAI, Anthropic, DeepSeek, and Google. You can access many of them for free using the platform's daily limit of 3000 credits. Credit costs will vary depending on the AI model selected, as well as the tokens spent to generate responses. Poe offers a way to set a token limit for chat responses, as this allows you to prevent overspending on credits. However, it does not have the option to use API keys from other platforms, limiting customization for more advanced integrations.

Poe stands out as a platform that is primarily geared toward AI development, experimentation, and testing rather than a comprehensive enterprise and productivity tool. While Poe does have a premium subscription plan starting at \$4.99/month, it doesn't seem to push these plans to everyone. Instead, it encourages you to create your own AI bots/apps using the platform and even offers a way to earn money by becoming a top creator.

Overall, Poe is best used to explore and experiment with a variety of AI tools in a cost-effective manner. Its powerful features and creative environment ensure that experimenting with AI models remains fun and educational.

4. Monica

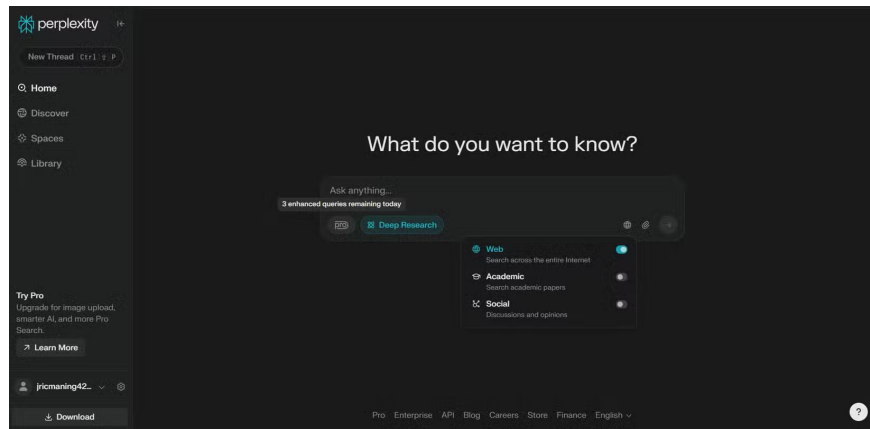


Monica is a versatile AI assistant that lets you use multiple AI models for free. Its many features have made it a top choice for AI Chrome extensions. It is available as a Chrome extension as well as on PC, smartphones, and via a web interface. The tool integrates a comprehensive set of features, including a podcast generator, content summarizer, mind map, and image generator.

One of Monica's standout features is its wide access to a wide variety of basic AI models for free, seemingly without any strict limitations. Some popular models include DeepSeek, GPT-4, Claude, Llama, and Gemini . For those who require more advanced capabilities, there is a premium subscription plan that unlocks basic and advanced models and many AI functions. However, these features are scattered all over the place, making the interface a bit cluttered.

Based on the platform's features, Monica is one of the best AI tools for solopreneurs, content creators, and virtual assistants. Plus, if you want to experiment with AI chatbots, Monica's subscription is inexpensive at just \$4.90/month!

3. Perplexity



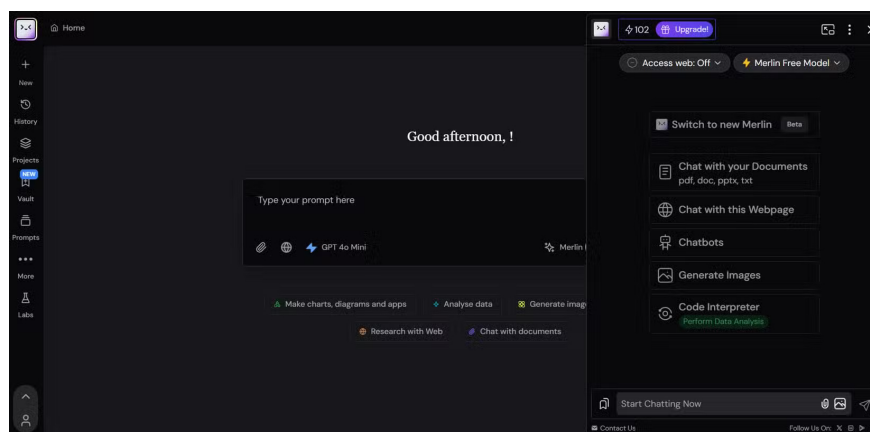
Perplexity offers a refined and flexible experience that combines simplicity with powerful AI features. It has a Chrome extension, a smartphone app, and a main web app, ensuring a seamless experience across all devices. While Perplexity has a desktop app, we recommend using the Perplexity web app until it is fully developed. Perplexity instantly reminds you of ChatGPT but with a greater level of flexibility by allowing you to use a variety of models, such as GPT-4 Omni, Claude Sonnet, DeepSeek r1, and Sonar.

What people really like about Perplexity is the clean and uncluttered interface it offers. In contrast to Monica's feature-packed approach to AI tools, Perplexity takes a simpler approach, offering a limited but cohesive set of AI tools and features. This makes it easy to do research and day-to-day queries, which is a big plus.

The downside is that Perplexity only offers a limited set of models, even if you upgrade to the Pro version for \$20/month. While these are some of the best AI chatbots, this might be a deal breaker if you want to explore as many different AI models as possible.

My experience with Perplexity has been pretty good. It stands out as a flexible and user-friendly chatbot that builds on the strengths and features of the popular ChatGPT. Even though it has some limitations in terms of model diversity, Perplexity is worth a try.

2. Merlin



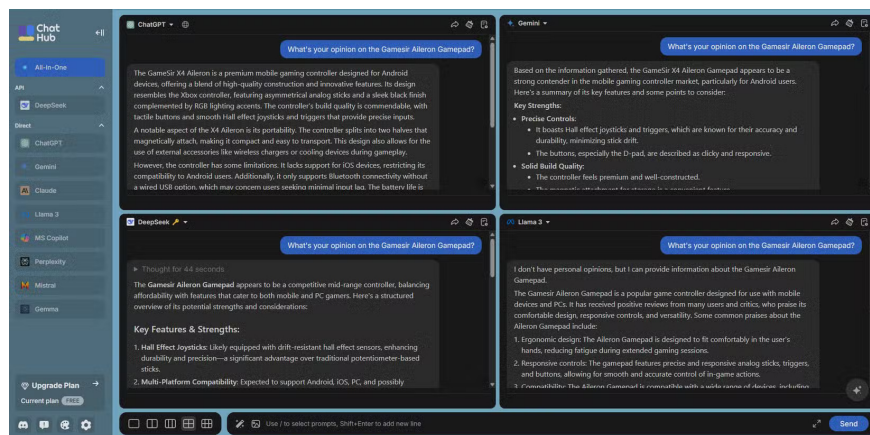
Using Merlin is one way you can access GPT-4 and other advanced models for free. What people like about Merlin is the ability to perform web searches even for free users — a feature that many in the AI field find extremely useful. This ability allows the application to pull the latest information directly from the Internet, expanding its utility beyond static training-based responses. The way the application allows you to focus these web searches on your current page, a specific domain, or the entire web is also appreciated.

For an AI Chrome extension, Merlin's user interface is surprisingly simple and clean. It offers multiple AI models and works seamlessly on any device, be it on a computer or a smartphone.

One downside to Merlin is that its interface can sometimes suffer from performance issues. You're also limited by the number of prompts you can run in a day. While the free 102 credits per day may be enough for basic AI models, advanced models like GPT-4o will burn through your credits in just 3 prompts. Still, you can at least experiment with different advanced models, albeit limited. If you want to expand the available models you can use, Merlin offers a Pro subscription for \$29/month. It's definitely more expensive than the other plans on this list, but it's still cheaper than buying separate subscriptions for ChatGPT Plus, Claude Pro, and Gemini Advanced.

Overall, Merlin excels at providing a good combination of AI capabilities with real-time data retrieval, making it a great choice if you plan to use it to get the latest information and test different AI models.

1. ChatHub



ChatHub introduces a unique feature by allowing real-time side-by-side comparison of up to 6 AI chatbots at once. This setup serves as a live testing platform where the speed and accuracy of multiple models can be observed at the same time. The platform also supports the use of API keys, giving you more control over your experience and the ability to tailor interactions to your specific needs.

ChatHub's design emphasizes direct comparison, allowing you to see the difference in response time and output quality without switching between separate apps. This makes ChatHub a useful tool for evaluating which model works best in certain situations. Premium features further expand the tool's functionality by incorporating real-time web access, one-click chat summaries, full-text search of chat histories, image import, custom chatbot creation, code preview, and quick access via the Chrome sidebar. ChatHub also offers a lifetime subscription option for around \$60, but still requires you to provide an API key.

However, beyond testing and comparison, ChatHub is quite limited, especially for free users. So if you need a fully integrated AI assistant for everyday tasks, ChatHub may not offer all the necessary features. Its main strength lies in the ability to quickly compare different models, making it more of a specialized tool than a general productivity extension.

From full-scale testing to real-time web productivity tools, these five apps offer some of the best ways to experiment with different AI chatbots without having to sign up for multiple AI platforms. Try Monica or Merlin for web productivity, Perplexity as an AI assistant, Poe as a fun AI platform, and ChatHub as a comparison tool for different AI chatbots.
