

# 5 best iPad models of 2024

It's no surprise that Apple's iPad line is loved by creators and is among the best tablets available today.

## Apple iPad Pro 11 (2024)



The Apple iPad Pro 13 is no slouch, but because the Apple iPad Pro 11 has a smaller 2-inch screen at a significantly cheaper price, this model takes the number 1 spot. Unless you're an artist or projector. If you plan to use the iPad Pro as your primary workstation, size won't make a difference and it's still a very comfortable experience.

Compared to the 13-inch model, iPad Pro 11 is 100g lighter, making it easier to hold and carry. More important is the hardware inside. The most recent iPad Pro model has a still powerful M2 chipset, but the iPad Pro 11 (2024) uses the same M4 processor in Apple's iMac and MacBook. It's a powerhouse for productivity, art, editing, and even gaming.

## Apple iPad Mini (6th generation)



Apple iPad (10th generation) is more affordable than Apple iPad Mini (6th generation). However, the Mini model is the best cheap iPad thanks to the A15 Bionic chipset, which has more staying power than the iPad's A14 Bionic chipset. Additionally, the price gap between iPad Mini and iPad is much smaller than between iPad Mini and iPad Air (5th generation).

If you plan to create, edit, or return to games, that extra graphics and processing performance will ensure a smoother experience without breaking the bank. Another big plus of the Apple iPad Mini (6th generation) is battery life. 10 hours of usage is more than enough for a day of work or study. iPad Mini (6th generation) works with both Apple Pencil and Smart Folio.

## **Apple iPad Air 13-inch (M2)**



As an artist, you never have enough screen space. At 13 inches, the Apple iPad Air 13 offers as much space as the latest iPad Pro while maintaining a light and slim profile.

More importantly, Apple iPad Air 13 also supports the new Apple Pencil Pro, bringing more amazing features like squeezing and scrolling. Combine that with the additional screen space and portability, and you have a very comfortable drawing experience. The M2 chipset is still suitable, at least more so than the A15 and M1.

## **Apple iPad (10th generation)**



If you need a powerful e-reader, the Apple iPad 10th generation is one of the cheapest options. This product can now easily be repurposed into your own entertainment machine, from keeping up with the news to reading the latest novel.

With a 10.9 inch screen, reading books is quite an enjoyable experience. It is suitable for books as well as comics, magazines and even newspapers. What's especially cool is that the Apple iPad (10th generation) will naturally adjust to ambient light, so your eyes won't strain when looking at a screen that's too bright or too dark.

## **Apple iPad Pro 13 (2024)**
