1. Zorin OS

If you love Windows 7, Zorin OS will replicate that Windows experience for you.

Zorin OS's desktop interface not only feels familiar as it is when using Windows, but it is also very beautiful and easy to use. You are not restricted in this interface. If you like something different, Zorin OS will provide some options to adjust.



You can choose a GNOME 3 layout or use the same interface as Windows XP, if you want to keep it completely the same as when using Windows. Zorin OS has been built from scratch to provide a seamless conversion experience for Windows users. In fact, Zorin OS is the only distribution on this list that includes Wine - a compatibility layer that allows users to install Windows applications on Linux.

Download Zorin OS.

2. Robolinux

Robolinux is an interesting distribution aimed at Windows users. Most people know that Linux users can run Windows programs in a virtual machine like WINE. If you are migrating from Windows to Linux and want to bring all your programs, files and settings with you, unfortunately it is not an easy task. But fortunately, Robolinux appeared.



Robolinux includes the Stealth VM, a virtual machine that is supposed to be able to run any Windows program without lag. In addition, Robolinux has a tool that allows you to copy the entire C drive on Windows, meaning that you can move all the programs and data already in advance. Although Robolinux is currently offered for free, developers are actively asking for donations.

3. ChaletOS

Some Linux distributions try to simulate the interface of Windows and produce many different results, but ChaletOS is the version that does this most accurately. With a familiar look, making Windows users feel so close, ChaletOS boasts a **Start** button and desktop icons.



Beautiful ChaletOS interface and works very much like Windows. At first glance, most people will assume that it is really Windows. The only problem with ChaletOS is that it does not come with the Office suite. Most Linux distributions come with LibreOffice, providing basic functions like word processing, spreadsheets and presentation capabilities. Although users can install the Office suite of their choice, deciding to skip ChaletOS's Office suite is confusing.

Download ChaletOS.

4. Linux Mint

Linux Mint is one of the most popular distributions in the Linux community, as it is easy to use and has an intuitive interface. If you switch from Windows to Linux, Linux Mint is a great choice.



Linux Mint has three official versions: Cinnamon, MATE and XFCE. Each option has its own strengths and weaknesses. If you've just started using Linux, you should consider MATE or Cinnamon, because XFCE is a bit complicated for newbies.

Linux Mint is also more user friendly for users switching from Windows to Linux, as it provides familiar elements on the desktop. Popular shortcuts that you find on Windows, such as the **Start** button, clickable icons, system tray, etc., are also available on Linux Mint. In addition, Linux Mint is very cautious with updates, so you will never have to worry about the required updates - the cause of the problem for Windows 10.

5. Solus

Solus is another great Linux distribution, best for beginners and Windows users. Solus has a nice, intuitive user interface, suitable for beginners and children. Solus also carries most of Windows features, making it a perfect replacement for this operating system. For example, Solus has a **Software Center**, which allows you to manage all your installed applications and more or less like **Control Panel** in Windows.



Solus comes with a variety of pre-installed applications including **Mozilla Firefox**, **Files** (similar to **File Explorer** in Windows 10) for document management and **GNOME MPV** to control media playback. Solus is also highly customizable, with every tweak designed to provide a seamless experience.

Although there are many powerful Linux distributions, not all are great for beginners, especially those who have just converted from the Windows environment. For example, Elementary OS is a very powerful Linux distribution, but the interface, features and feel that it brings are somewhat similar to macOS.
