

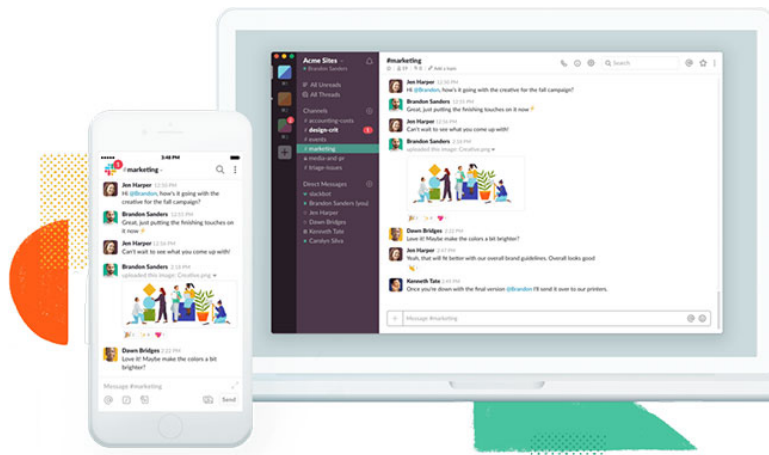

Defect

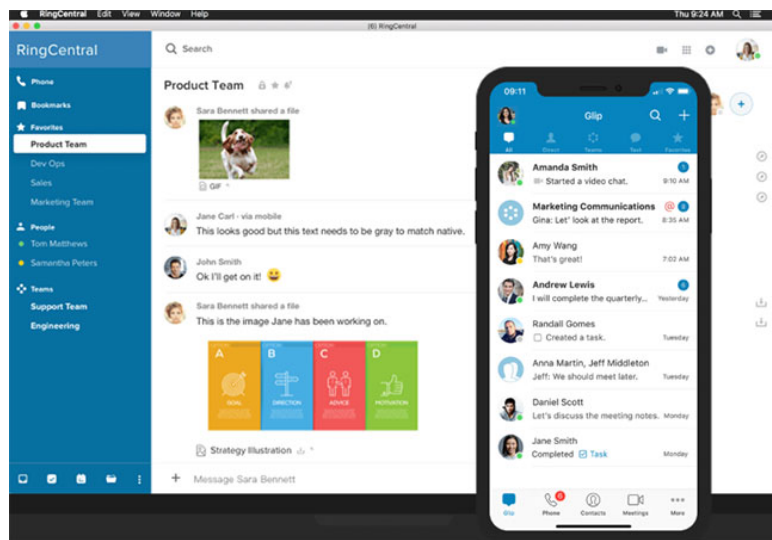
1. Expensive

2. Good channel and group admin options

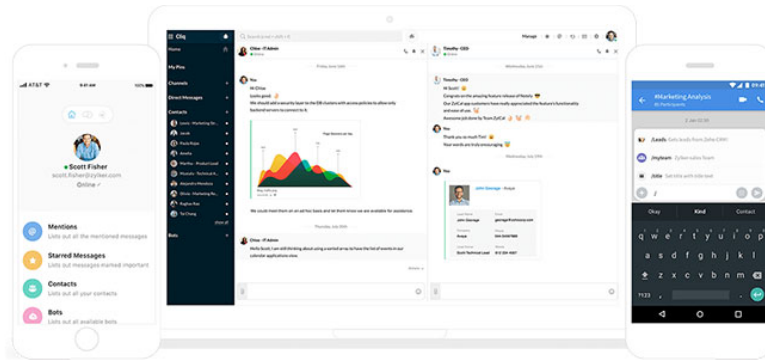
Defect

4. Inexpensive

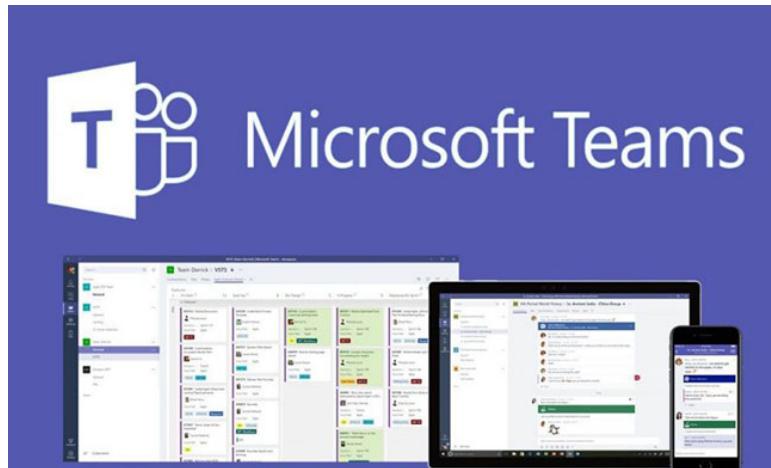
Defect

1. There is no notification when the keyword appears
2. Better options are required for the **Out of Office** and **Do Not Disturb** modes.

Zoho Cliq has many of the same good features as group messaging apps like Slack and adds the ability to view multiple channels in one window, for a very low price.

4. Includes Office 365 business accounts

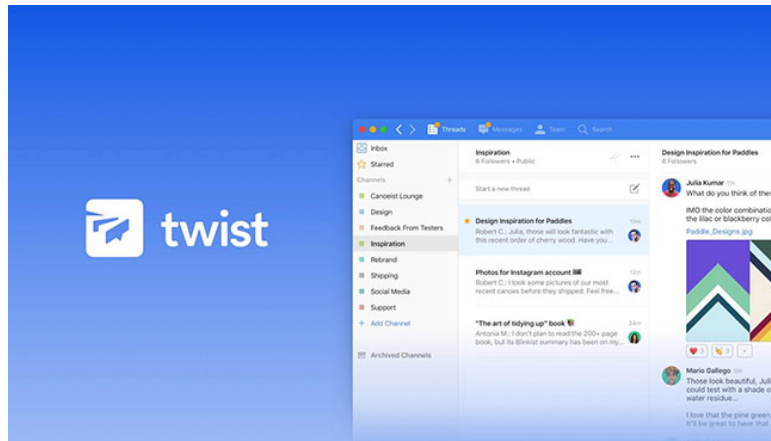
Defect

2. Design gives a sense of solemnity and obedience to the rules, which can interfere with open dialogue
