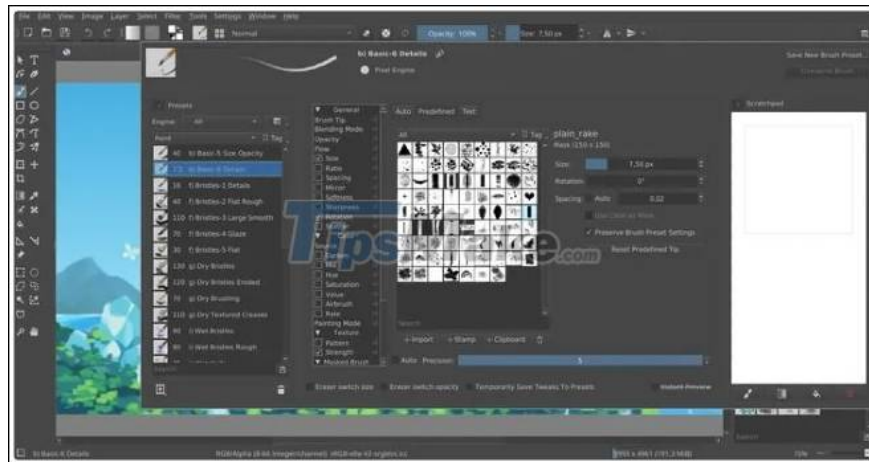


# 5 best photo editing software for Linux

## 1. Krita

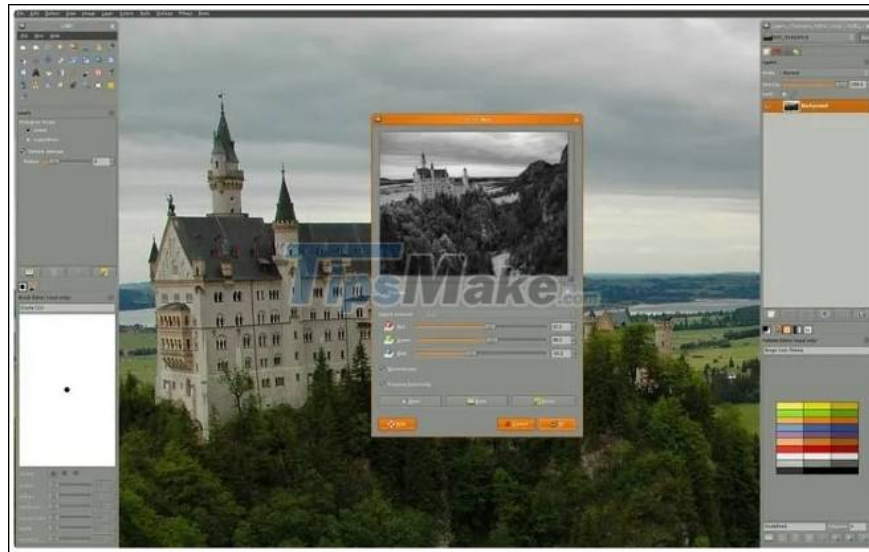
Krita is an open source graphics software that allows users to create 16 bit RGB, CMYK, Lab and OpenEXR images. It supports almost all image formats including PNG, TIFF, Dicom, PSD and GIF. Krita 6th version has new support for PSD.



Krita is written in C++ and can include Python and Ruby scripts. It supports DCOP interface which makes it easy to customize. Moreover, you can choose from different plugins to extend the built-in functionality.

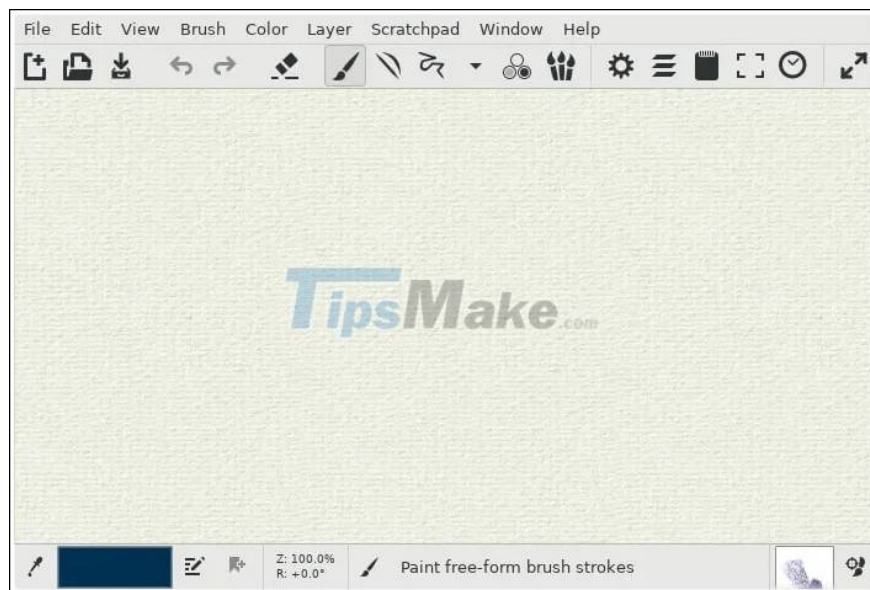
## 2. GIMP

The GNU Image Manipulation Program, also known as GIMP, is one of the best graphics software available for Linux. It is also the default image editing software on many Linux distros. It provides a full range of drawing tools along with editing and composing functions. You can even take screenshots of Linux computers using GIMP.



### 3. MyPaint

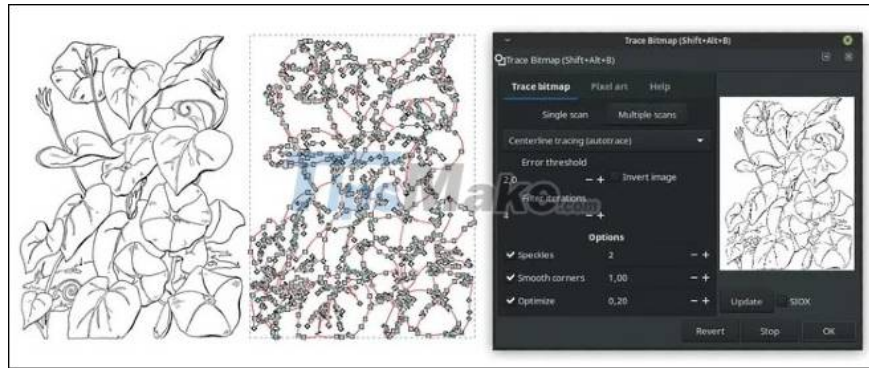

Another advantage of MyPaint is that the developer is very active and regularly releases updates to Linux.

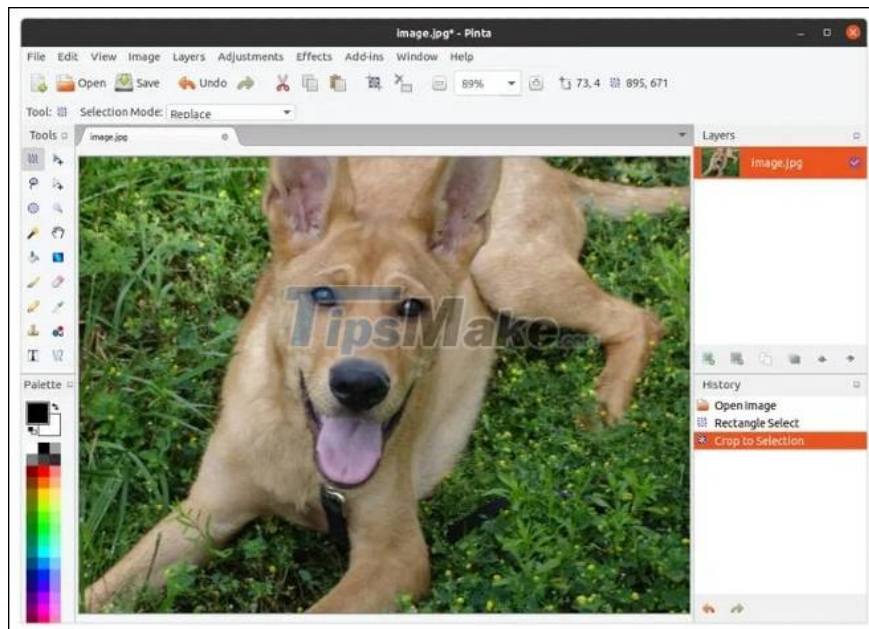
### 4. Inkscape
