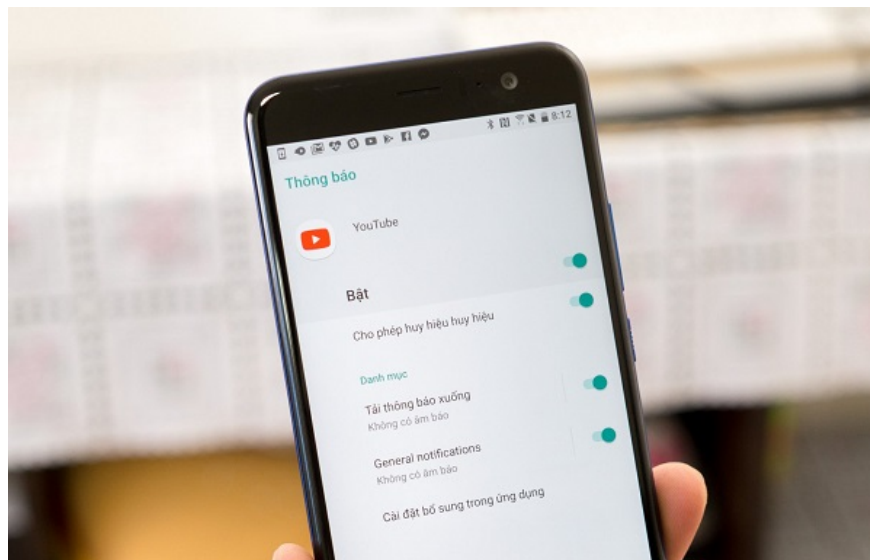

Stronger notification control

You can easily customize notifications with some applications, such as Gmail, so far, it also notifies the notification, but you can completely tweak it to allow only some common mailbox notifications. used (previously configured from Gmail, quite time consuming).

Or with the YouTube application, you can now turn on / off notifications about downloading videos for offline viewing, the types of notifications when new videos are available remain the same. This is how Android 8 synthesizes all notification preferences in one place for you to control easily.



2 ways to control notifications are as follows:

1. Method 1: In the notification bar of your phone, you flick your finger to the right or left in any message. Then, click on the gear icon and select the application you want to tweak, toggle what you like.
2. Method 2: From the device main screen, you access this link: *Settings*> *Sound & Notifications*> *Advanced*> *Notifications*> *Select app to adjust*> *Set notification as you like*.

Postpone notification and repeat later

This trick is quite useful in cases where you are in a meeting, presenting a presentation, talking to a partner, . then the notification needs to be followed right? However, if you don't see it right away, you'll probably forget it because it doesn't report back, but just stay quiet on the notification. To overcome this problem, Android 8 has allowed the snooze notification for user convenience.

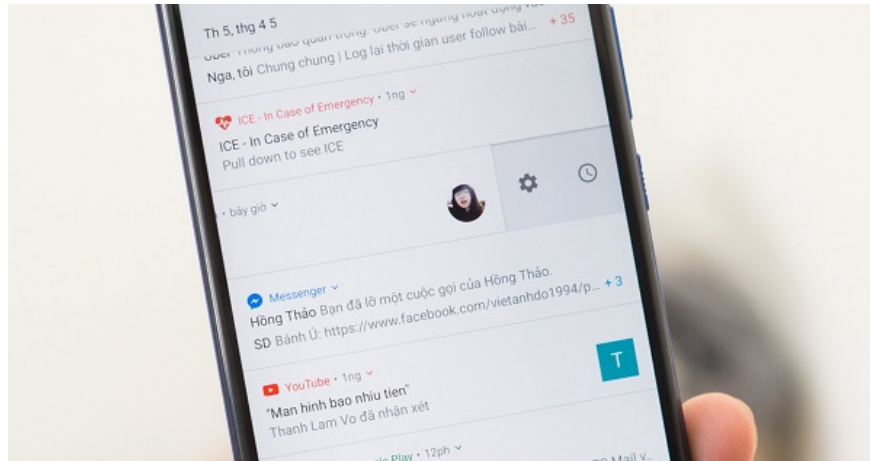
To delay the notification and repeat later, in the message you want to remind, flick your finger left or right> Press the clock icon> Select the time to remind and finish.



Turn on Notification Dot

Notification Dot, also known as small dots inform when the application has a new notification, it usually appears on the home screen like iPhone. Nova Launcher and some third-party applications have supported this feature for a long time, but Android itself now integrates into the operating system. If you want to see these dots, you will need to use Pixel Launcher, then go to *Settings*> *Sound and Notifications*> *Dot notification (or Allow badge)*> *Activate it*.

Note: For those of you who are using HTC, Sony, Samsung or Nova Launcher, it is highly likely that you do not need to turn on anything, it is already running.



How to watch video Picture in Picture

Picture in Picture is considered an attractive new feature of Android 8 that allows you to view video as a miniature window while using another app. There are currently not many apps that support this function, only available on Chrome, YouTube, VLC, Google Maps, etc. You can refer to the picture-in-picture User Guide on Android Oreo to know how Watch Picture in Picture video on Android 8.



Don't forget to use Google Play Protect

Google has integrated a great function into the operating system from Android 7.0 and above to help protect users better from malware threats. Google Play Protect is the name mentioned here, it is responsible for testing applications closely before downloading from Play Store, checking malicious software from different sources for comparison, copper Notify you if you have a suspicious application installed on your phone.

To enable Google Play Protect, run *Play Store (CH Play)*> *Click the menu button*> *Play Protect*. If you do not see the Play Store, go to *Settings*> *Google*> *Google Play Protect*> *Turn on two swipe bars at the bottom of the screen* . Here, you will also see the status of your device is safe or not, there is a problem to handle or not.
