## 1. Disable unnecessary default applications

On most smatrphone, there are some default applications and services integrated, but these applications often do not have many attractive features other than filling up memory and slowing down the system. By default, you will not be able to remove the application, so the best solution in this case is to disable them. To do this, do the following:

1. Go to Settings> Applications> select Application to disable and press Force stop.

## 2. Turn off sound and vibration feedback

Newly purchased phones, many people enjoy a few feedback effects through vibrating signals and sound when operating on the screen. However, experience for a long time they have to "cry" up because of being "threatened" startled, not only that it also "consumes" no less battery of the smartphone. If you also feel that this feature is a bit annoying, it is possible to mute and vibrate screen feedback by:

1. Go to *Settings* > *Sound and vibration*.

In this section, you can turn off everything: keyboard tones, screen lock sounds, touch tones, vibration when touching, .

### 3. Turn off the machine start signal

Every time you reboot, you will see a short video with the phone label of that phone, although it is not a big problem, but it will cause minor trouble if you are in public places. You try to imagine, in a quiet space suddenly, what is this soundtrack? Certainly create attention and influence people around. Therefore, follow this guide to turn off this video and soundtrack immediately:

1. Go to *Settings*> *Sound*> Here, each firm arranges the way to turn off the different soundtracks, usually *the Startup Sound*.



This is what you should do with a new smartphone.

#### **4. Turn off vibration when entering the keyboard**

When all the feedback and vibrations are turned off, the next thing you need to do is go to the keyboard settings section to turn off the vibration function when you enter the keyboard. Many users said that this feature is really unnecessary, even it is the leading cause of ease of falling during typing. When the phone is finished, turn off the vibration when entering the keyboard using the following link:

1. *Settings*> *Additional settings*> *Language and input method*> *General settings (Customize keystrokes)*> *Disable keypress sounds*.



Please turn off the Keyboard Vibration feature.

## 5. Turn off automatic spelling correction

Undeniably automatically correcting spelling or predictive suggestions is a convenient feature for smartphone users. By default, it is pre-set after activation so that we can edit the text faster and fix it ourselves if we type

wrong. However, many people expressed annoyance because the machine constantly misunderstood the special characters that they deliberately wrote, there were many funny stories or words that were not conveyed with advanced features. guess this. Therefore, in order not to take time and trouble, please correct spelling errors right after purchasing new smartphones by following simple steps:

1. Go to *Settings*> *Additional settings*> *Language and input method*> *Smart input*> uncheck *Auto-fix*.



Self-correction for spelling often happens more 'accidents' than useful.

With this feature, in some other devices you can apply the following: Settings> *General management*> *Language and keyboard*> *Keyboard*> *Edit text*> cancel selection *Auto-fix*.
