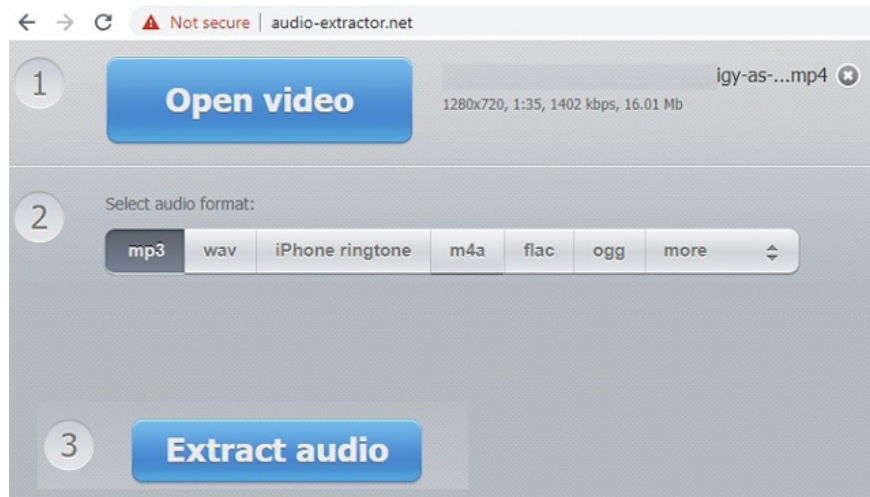
1. How to extract the lyrics from the music to get the beat

## Ways to separate audio from video

1. Use Audio Extractor tool online
2. Use VLC Media Player
3. Using QuickTime for Mac users
4. Using Audacity software
5. Use the application on the phone

### 1. Use Audio Extractor tool online

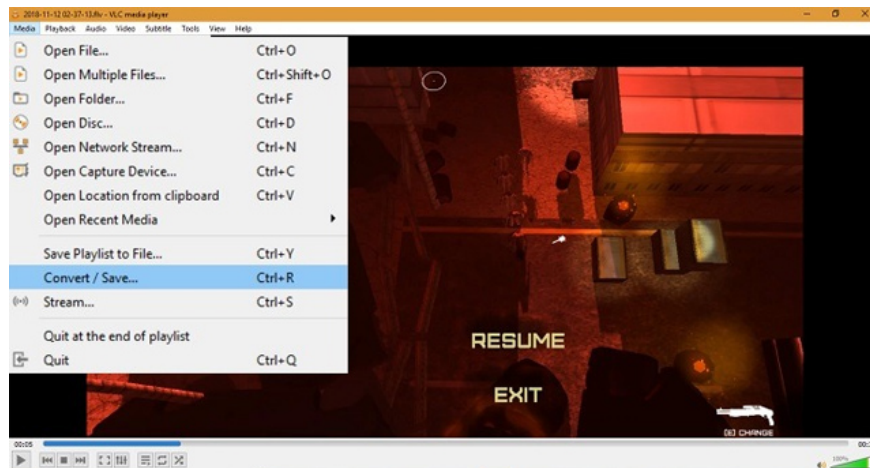
Audio-extractor.net is one of the best online tools to extract audio from any type of video. With this tool, you can save audio as MP3, WAV or make iPhone ringtone with fast time.



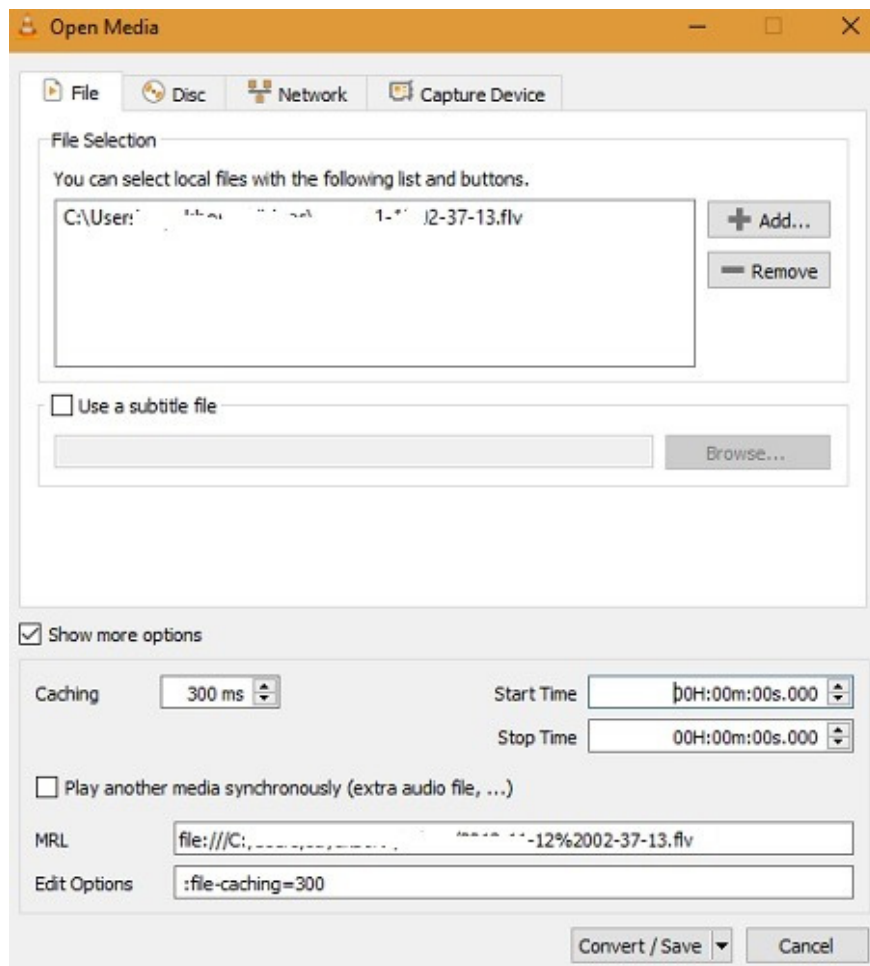
Audio Extractor does not disappoint you when splitting audio with great quality. If you want to cut a small segment from this video, you can use some audio file cutting tools like iTunes or WavePad Audio Spiltter. This tool is very useful when you want to save a movie conversation as a ringtone.

## 2. Use VLC Media Player

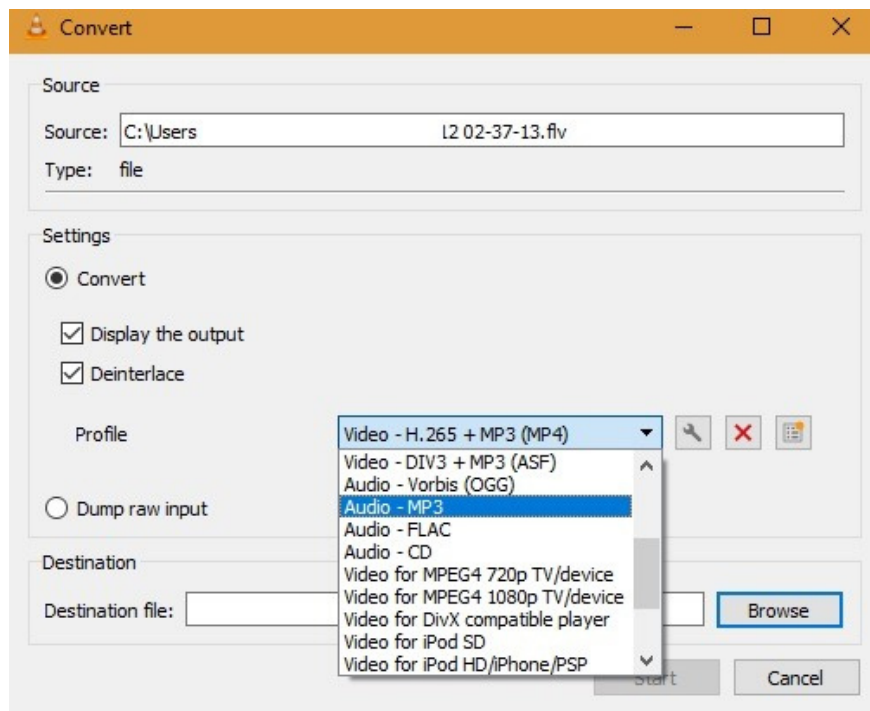
If you are a Windows user, you can use VLC Media Player software, it has an integrated tool that can extract audio from video files. How to do it is simple, just go to **Media** and click **Convert / Save** .



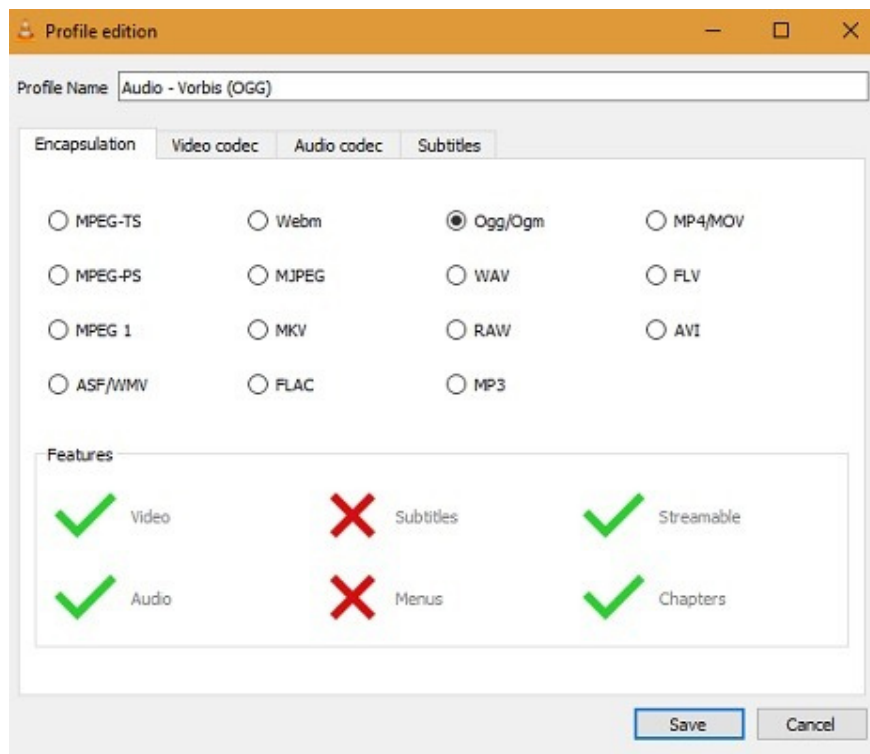
Then, a dialog box appears to select the conversion file, check the **Show more options** option to select the exact timeline you want to extract the audio, then select **Convert / Save** .



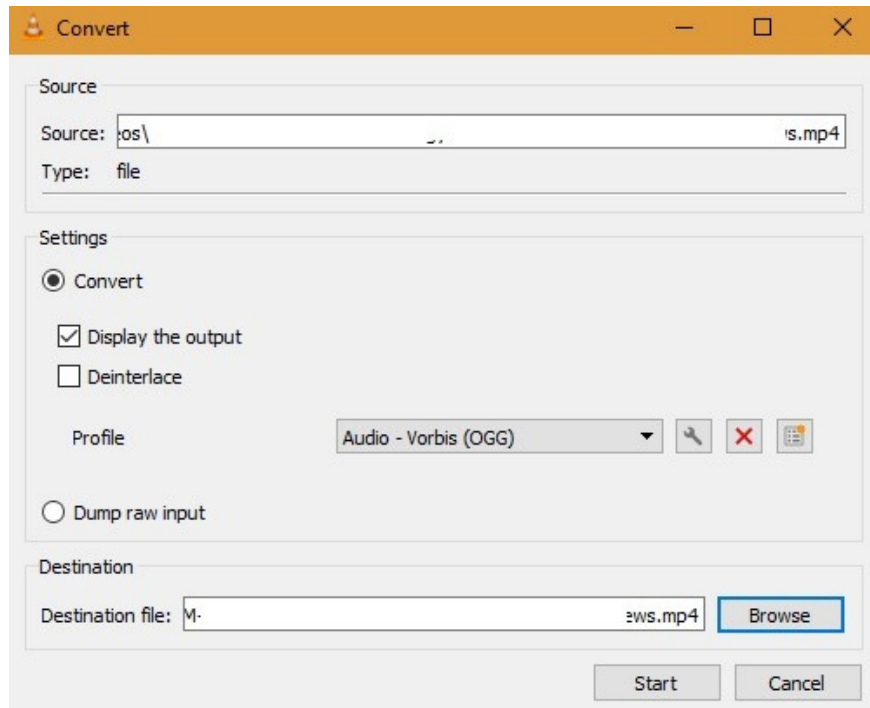
Next, you will see some other conversion options such as OGG audio output, MP3, etc. Or take the next steps carefully or you can skip some important steps.



After selecting the desired sound configuration, click on the wrench icon. Here you have to name the audio file and click the **Save** button.

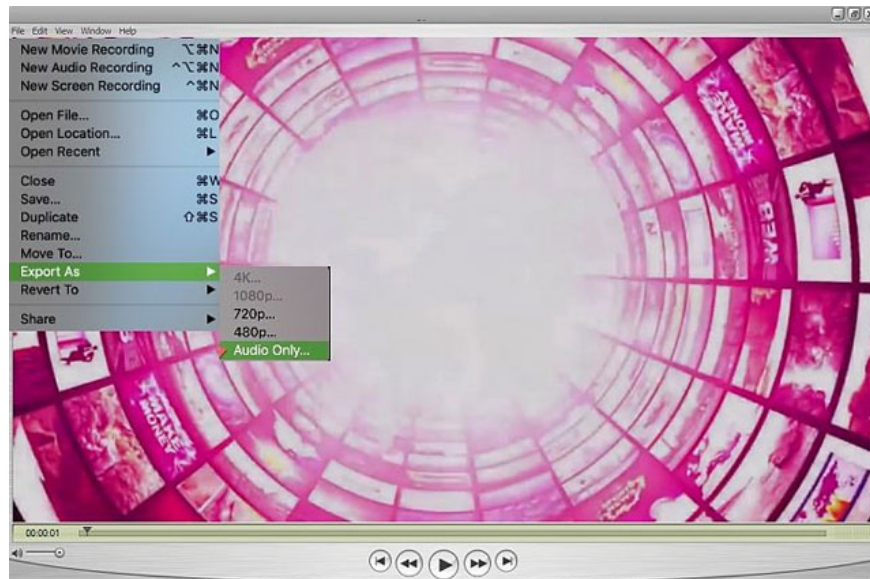


Finally, click **Browse** to select where to save the converted audio file and press the **Start** button to start the conversion process.



### 3. Using QuickTime for Mac users

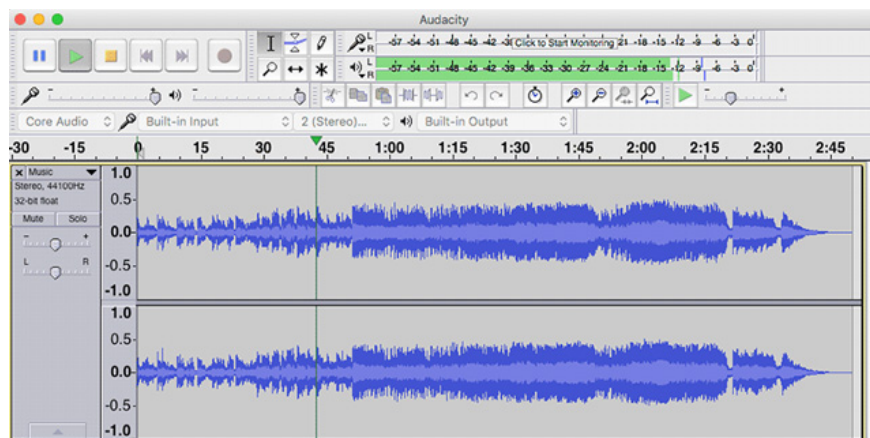
Fortunately for Mac users, you will not have to take the same steps as above with QuickTime. The operation is very simple, just open the video file with this tool and select **Export As** to save the file as an audio file.



### 4. Using Audacity software

Audacity is one of the best software to perform versatile audio requirements and it is completely free. To extract audio from a video file, simply open Audacity, click **Open Files** and a window will appear to select the file you

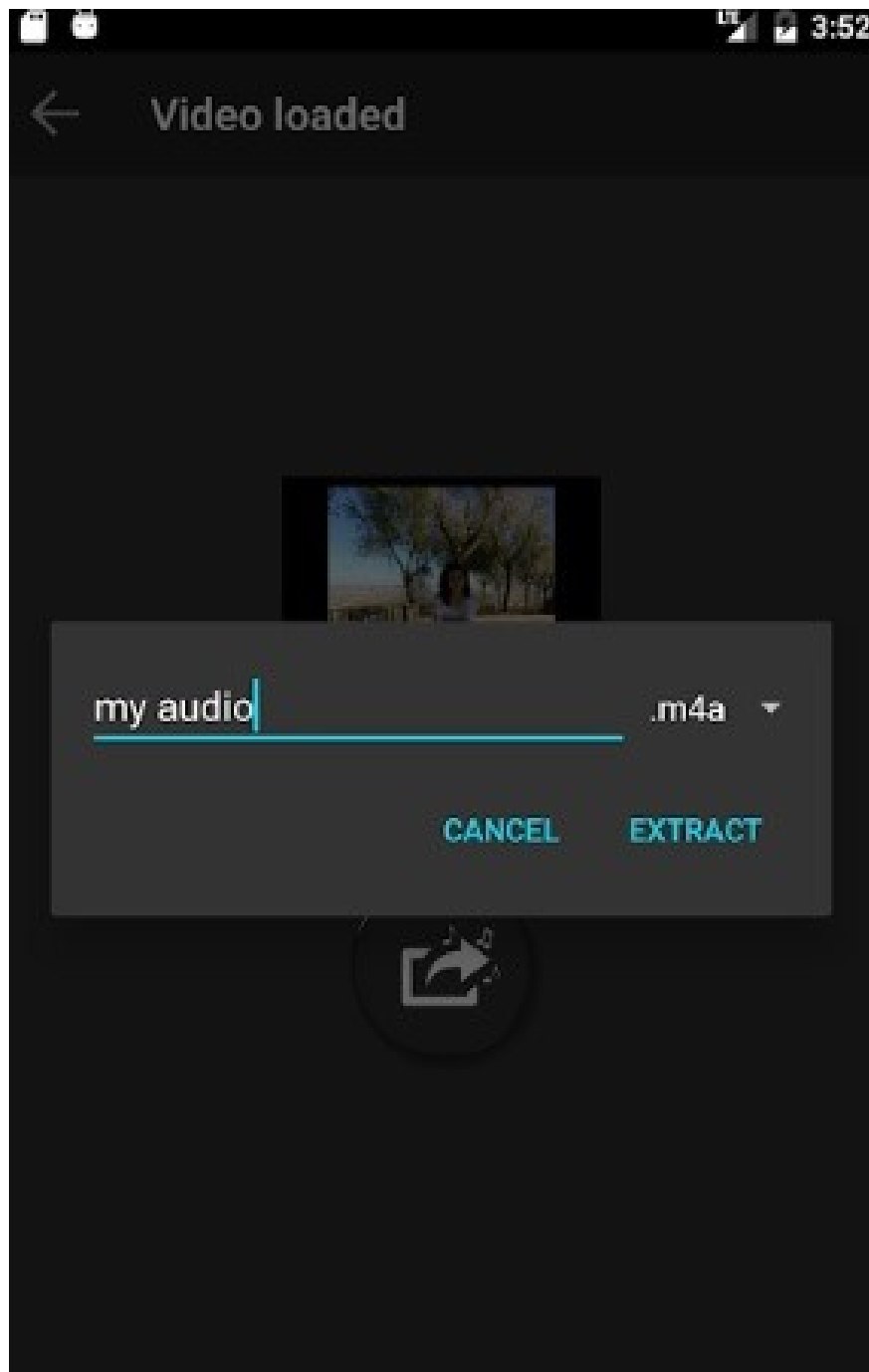
want to extract audio from. Then select the conversion format and save the file.

## 5. Use the application on the phone

If you want to extract audio from your phone, you can use the Extract Audio from Video application. After importing MP4, 3GP or WEBM video files, you can select the desired audio file format. Then just click **Extract** as shown below.
