1. Appmakr.com

AppMakr is a manufacturer of cloud-based applications that allows you to create iOS, HTML5 and Android applications. You are not limited to the number of applications that can be built as well as the number of updates that can be added.

It has many features, including high-resolution photo collections, push notifications (push notification), live updates, online music and videos, chat rooms, Google map integration, split event calendars share, in-app shopping and more. You can monitor your application on the dashboard and adjust the application's interface and functionality. In addition, you can add content using tabs. Its fee ranges from free to one-time payment of \$ 99 when you publish.



2. Gamesalad.com

GameSalad is the platform for building and publishing game applications for Android, iOS, HTML5 and macOS platforms. Working on this platform does not require programming knowledge and it involves using a drag and drop interface.



Its mode includes editing characters in a scene, designing features, sounds and alternating between characters. This platform includes drag and drop components, in-app purchases and GameCircle APIs. In addition, it also has a forum, a place to exchange and learn from other users' experiences in building applications.

Beginners are free but then pay \$ 299 per year.

3. Appypie.com

Appy Pie allows users without the knowledge of code to build applications in the cloud. This platform can be used to create apps for Windows, iOS and Android that you can publish to Google Play or iTunes. It includes the use of drag and drop components, without downloading or installing anything.



The complete version of the created application is hybrid applications based on HTML5 and works on all platforms, including Blackberry. You can send push notifications, view analytics in real time, monetize ads and use GPS to track location. You can also link apps with websites, blogs, audio, radio, media feeds and more.

It has an appointment containing features like One Touch Call and QR code, in which you can embed custom code and iFrames, this feature is especially useful for most businesses. You can use it for free or pay \$ 33 per month.

4. Appery.io

Using Appery to build applications is easy and fast. No need to write code or download and install anything. It is made exclusively on Cloud and uses drag and drop components to create the user interface. This platform is used to build applications for Android, Windows and iOS phones with Apache with built-in components.

Appery has a plugin catalog that allows you to add some functionality to the app, but you can also create specific plugins for your application. It allows you to share projects with business users, customers or developers in real time. Prices range from free to about \$ 180 a month.

5. Swiftic.com

Swiftic is renamed from Como. This is an instant application creator that allows you to create applications whether you have experience or not. This is one of the best mobile app manufacturers because it has many features to make money and attract customers. With Como you can easily create applications with just three simple steps and dozens of classified themes. All you need to do is choose an application category, theme and publish.



In addition, the platform also features advanced analytics to monitor application performance (to know what works and what doesn't). Other features on the application creator include drag and drop interface, user reviews, the ability to create custom menus, RSS feeds and social feeds, customize the look and functionality of the application. , earning features and push notifications.

Rates range from free to \$ 29 per month (pay once in two years), \$ 33 per month (pay once per year) to \$ 39 (monthly payment).

All of the above five platforms are cloud-based, which allows you to make changes and publish applications in real time. The above platforms are good but based on Swiftic evaluation (Como) is the best. All you need to do is select the application you want to build, choose a theme and publish.
