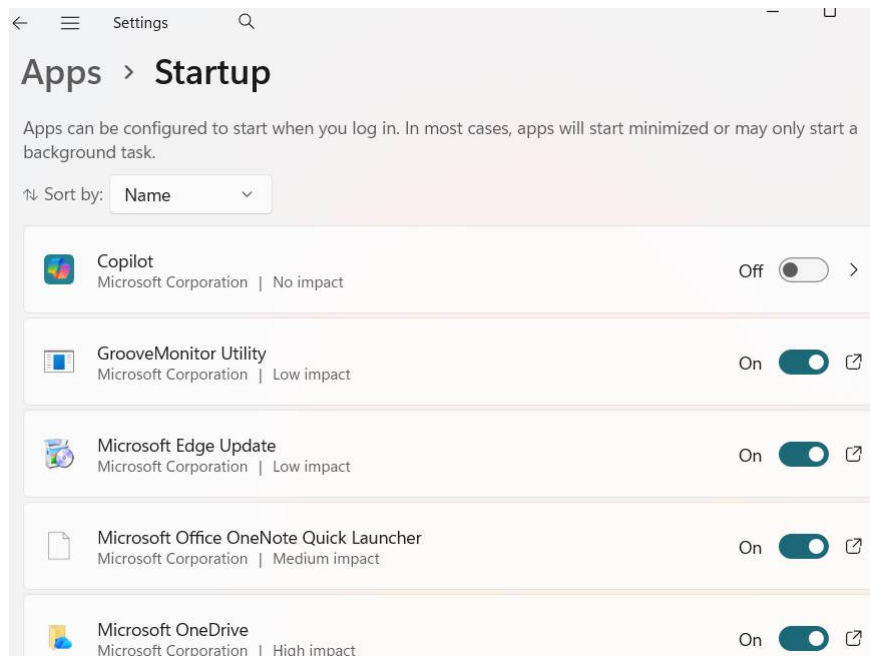

1. How to disable applications that start with Windows

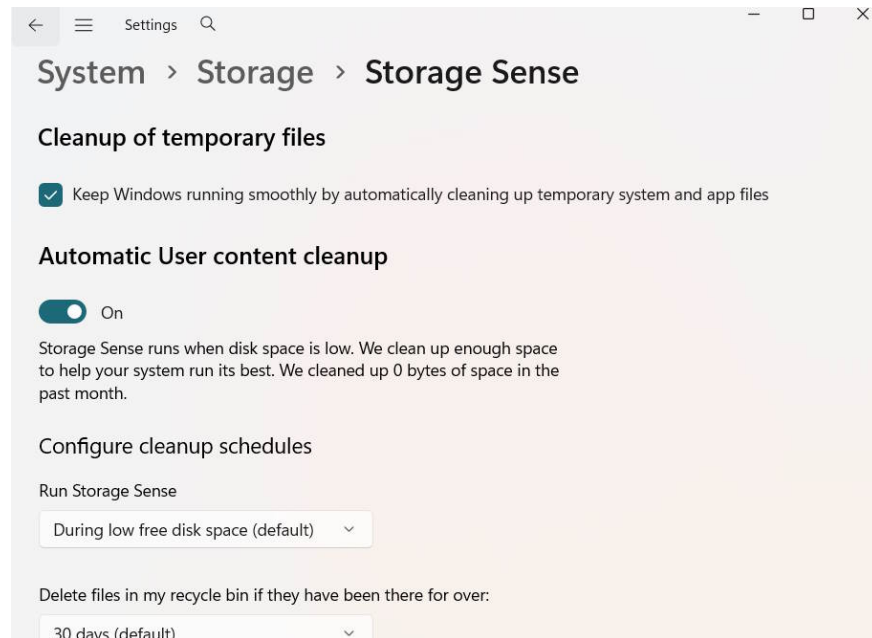


Turn on Windows Storage Sense

If the main drive is often full, it is also one of the reasons why the computer runs slowly. You can use a hidden setting in Windows 11 to free up space.

When you enable Storage Sense, it automatically deletes unnecessary data on your drive, such as cached data, temporary files, and more. You can also adjust the feature's settings to delete specific unnecessary data, such as items in your Downloads folder.

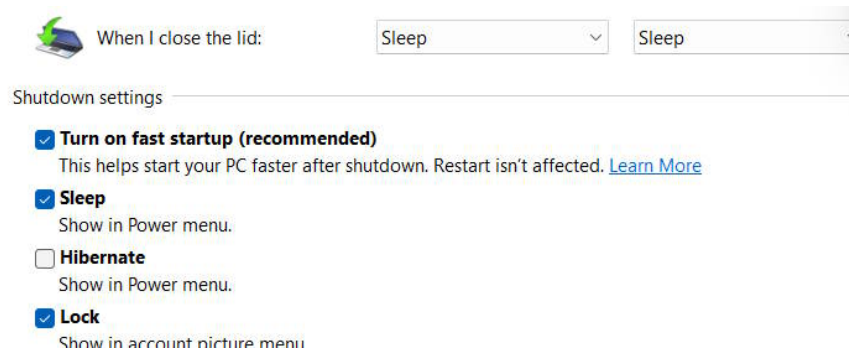
1. How to use Storage sense Windows to free up disk space



Enable Fast Startup

Fast startup on your PC reduces the time it takes to boot up. This is especially useful if your computer takes a long time to boot up. This setting allows your computer to boot up faster by skipping loading everything from scratch. Instead, it picks up where it left off by saving a small system file that speeds up the boot process.

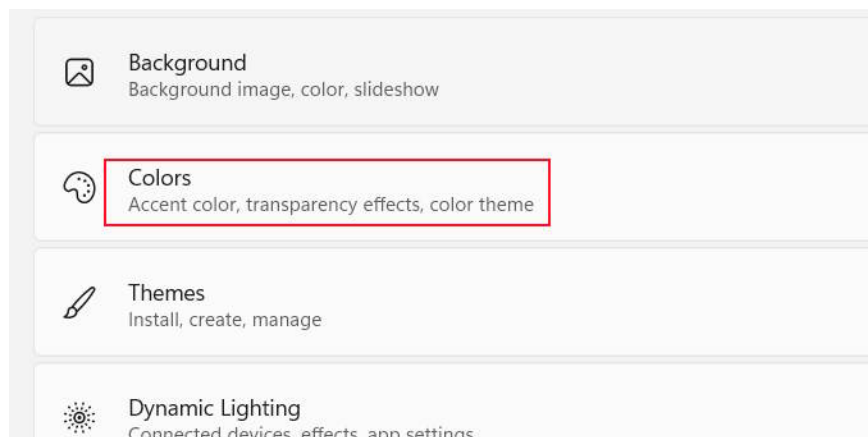
1. Start Windows 10 "as fast as the wind" with Fast Startup



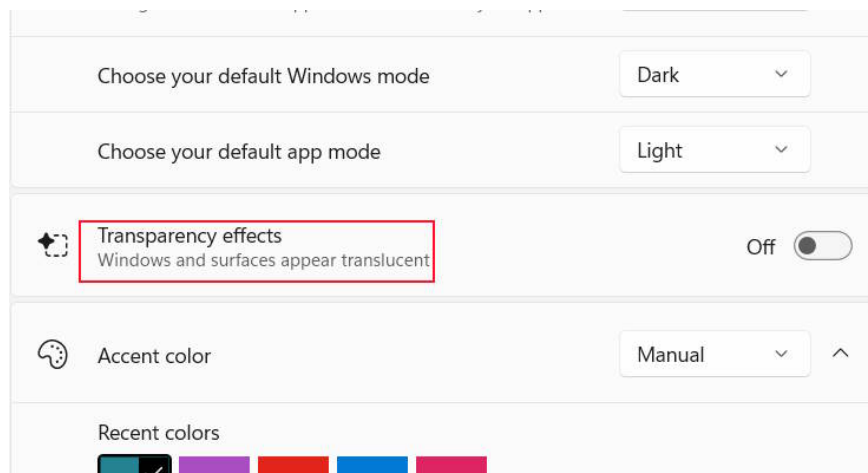
Turn off Windows 11 transparency effects

If your computer is running slower, consider turning off transparency effects on Windows 11. This setting makes your Windows 11 computer look better, but it can also take up some of your computer's GPU resources if you don't have many resources left to use.

Go to Settings then **click Personalization** on the left side and look to the side **and select Colors** .



Next, you just need to **turn off Transparency effects** .



Windows 11 virtual memory management

Virtual memory acts as a backup for RAM, kicking in to take the load off RAM whenever your computer is running low on physical memory. You can increase virtual memory in the settings, which is a useful tool if you find your computer frequently running out of RAM and running slow.
