Also, if you want to receive a message notification without displaying the content on the lock screen, turn **on Show on Lock Screen** , select **When Unlocked** or **Never** (**Never**) hours) in the **Show Preview** section. You will now receive a notification message on the lock screen, but this message only includes the sender's name without a preview. To read the entire message, you need to open the iPhone and access Message.

Users will often use both iPad or Mac to text with their account. For better security, only use iPhone and disable messaging via other devices. To block, select **Settings** -> **Messages** then turn off all unnecessary devices **in Text Message Forwarding** .

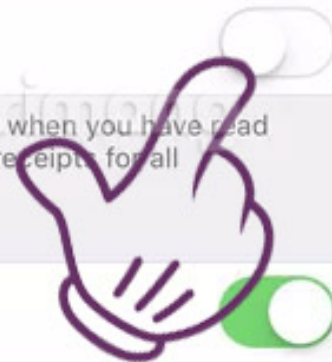
Text Message Forwarding

Automatically delete old messages

To do so, go to **Settings** -> **Messages** then go to **Message History** , select **30 days** (30 days) or **1 year** (1 year) in **Keep Messages** (Keep the message). Deleting old messages not only frees iPhone memory but also helps messages avoid being read by others.

Filter messages from strangers

If you don't want to receive notifications from strange numbers, you can turn them off and put them in a separate list. Done, select **Settings** -> **Messages** then turn on **Filter Unknown Senders** . At this time, when accessing Message, you will see 2 **Contacts & SMS** lists (Contacts) and **Unknown Senders** (Strangers).

Turn off read notifications

This is a way to prevent others from knowing you have read the message they sent. To ensure the sender does not receive the **Seen** message (Read), select **Settings** -> **Messages** and turn off **Send Read Receipts** (Turn off read notifications).

Alternatively, you can turn off read notifications for each contact. Open a conversation (must be an iMessage conversation (green) and not an SMS message (blue), click the " **i** " button at the top right and turn off **Send Read Receipts** .
