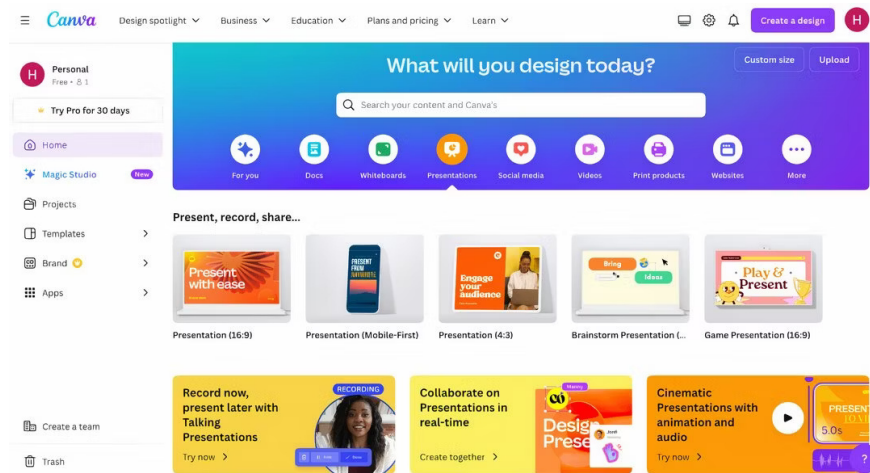


5 reliable sources of slideshow templates for presentations

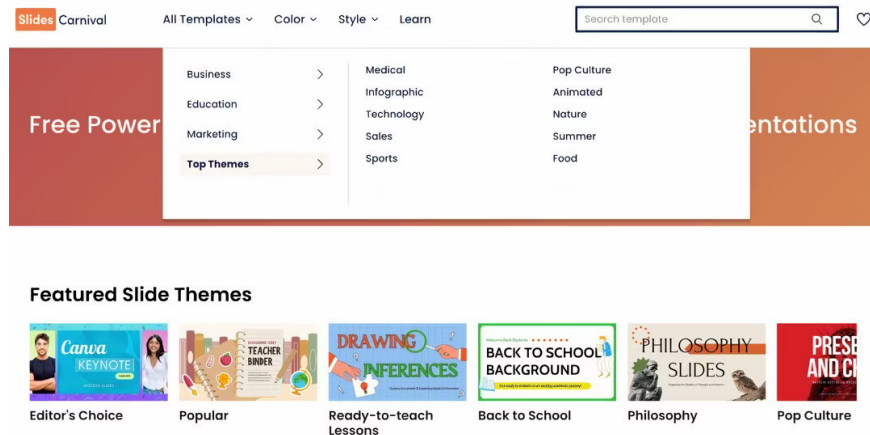
- The resource page is also helpful in the creative process. This page provides a guide to available tools and features, maximizing the tool's potential during the editing process. This helps create polished and impactful designs.

2. SlideEgg



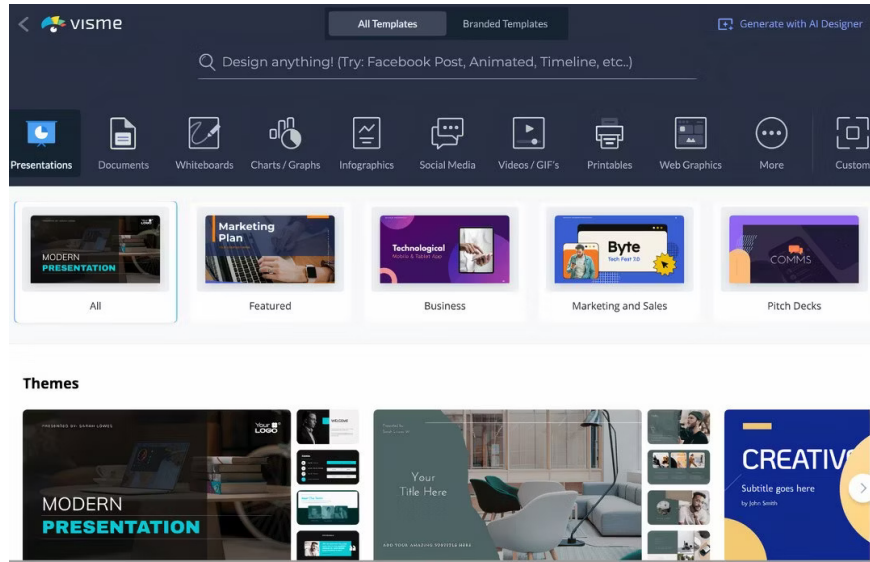

3. SlidesCarnival



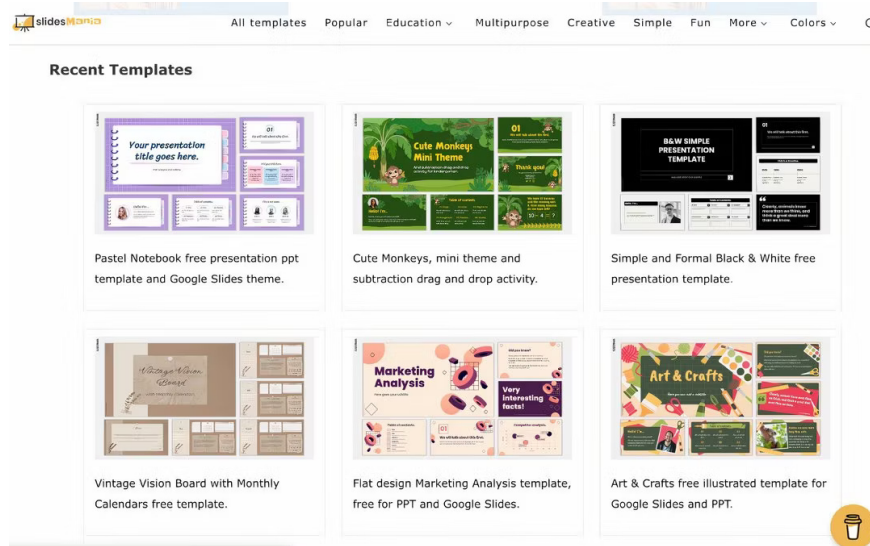
