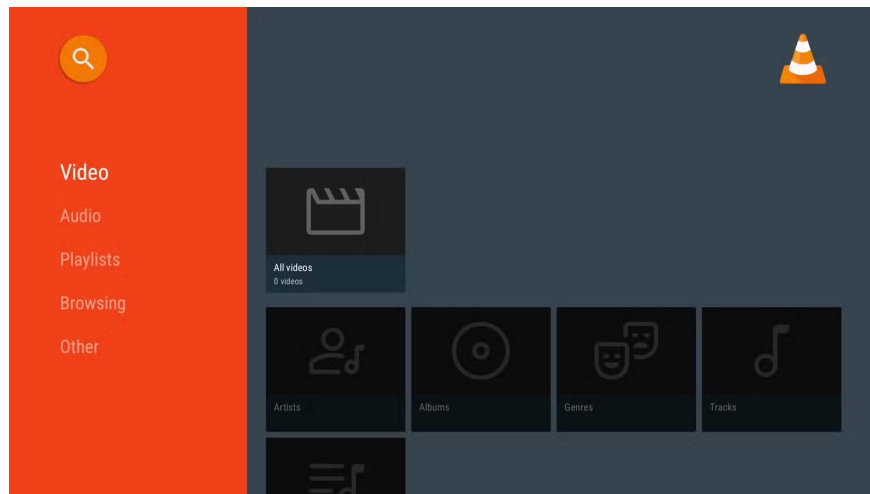


# 5 Smart TV Apps You Can Use Without Wi-Fi

## 5. Media Player or VLC

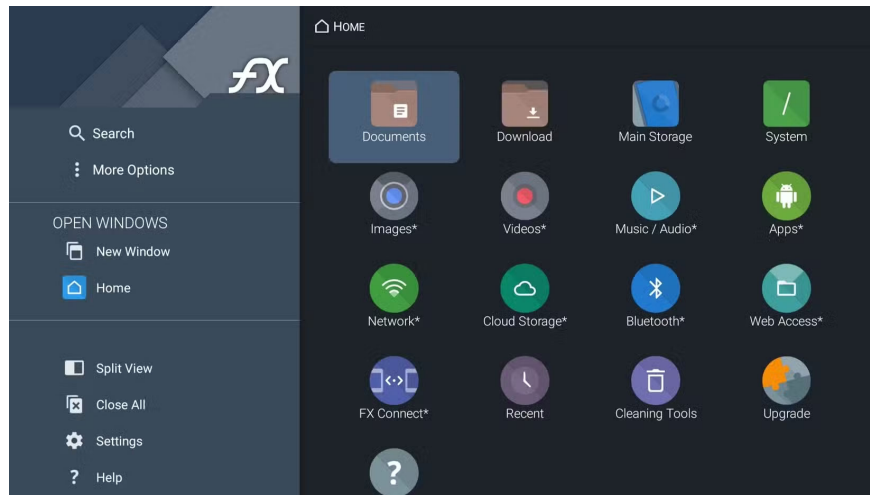

## 4. FX File Explorer

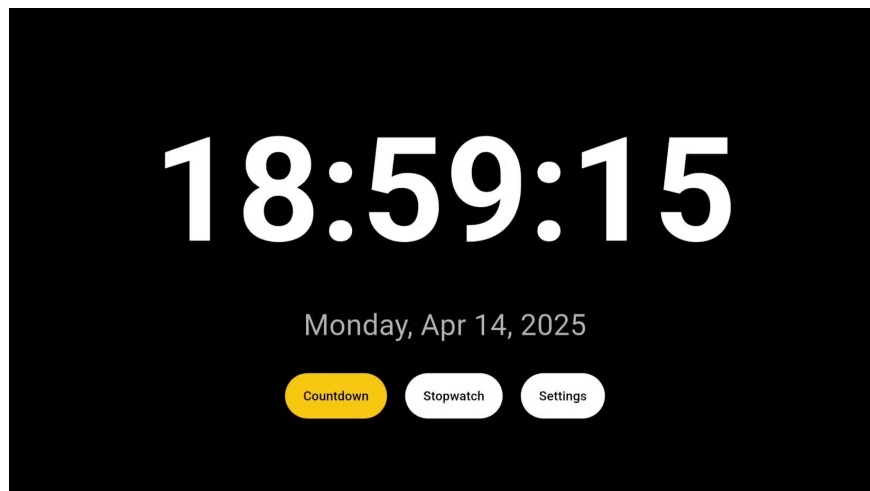


Most Smart TVs don't have a built-in File Manager app. However, if you frequently use USB storage devices with your Smart TV, FX File Explorer is a must-have app.

The app even has a built-in image viewer and video player, so you can skip downloading a media player like VLC if your TV is running low on storage.

### 3. Clock, Timer, & Stopwatch



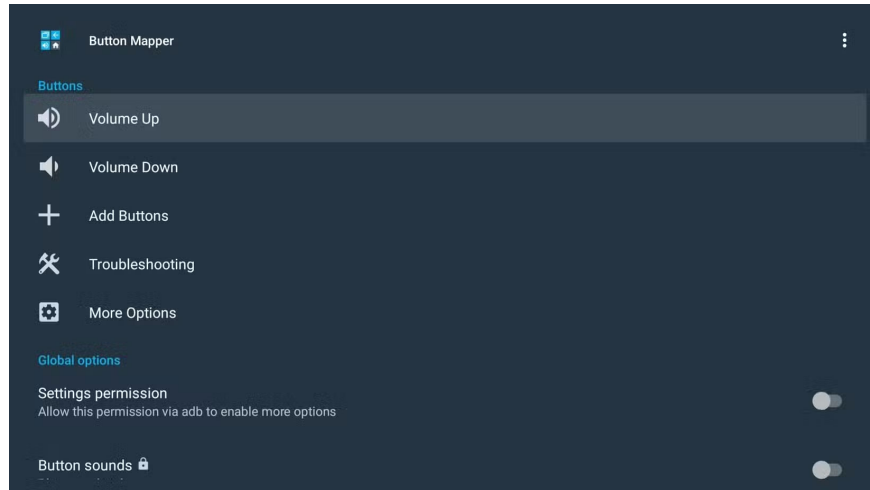
Smart TVs aren't just for watching content. With apps like Clock, Timer, & Stopwatch, you can instantly turn it into a digital clock.

require precise tracking.
