Set up HD cameras at different angles

Speaking of which, the best live dealer casino setups feature multiple [HD cameras](#). Set up your cameras at least three different angles around your live dealer tables to give players a 360-degree view of their playing field. For roulette, for instance, give players a top view of the entire table, a wide view of the table, and a top-and-down view of the roulette wheel.

Install a powerful GCU at the table

Your cameras are only part of the equation. To encode images and videos and deliver them to players in real time, install a game control unit (GCU) at every table. The most advanced GCUs are no bigger than a shoe box. Large operators like Betway place them discreetly under live dealer tables to maintain strong connections between the dealer's signal and the player's screen. Pick a GCU that can handle all your players simultaneously without buffering or causing signal lags.

Clear storage on your monitor

The table monitor is the screen on which your live dealers watch the action, keep track of player decisions, assess current bets, and engage with players through live chat. It sounds like a lot of work because it is. When buying a monitor for your live dealer casino, choose a large screen with enough [storage](#) to handle all these tasks in real time. It's also important to clean it regularly and update the software periodically to maintain a smooth connection between the live dealer and players.

Activate the live chat function

The live chat function is arguably the most exciting aspect of live dealer gambling. Players enjoy the interaction and the ability to communicate with each other and the dealer as the game goes on, just as they would in a real casino.
