

# 5 tips to keep your social network account in a 'safe' state

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That's why you should use tricks to increase the security of your social network accounts.



## 1. Activate 2-layer security for your social network accounts



**Enter your password**

Whenever you sign into Google you'll enter your username and password as usual.

**Enter code from phone\***

Next, you'll be asked for a code that will be sent to you via text, voice call, or our mobile app.

**That's it, you're signed in!**

Now your account has additional protection against hijackers.

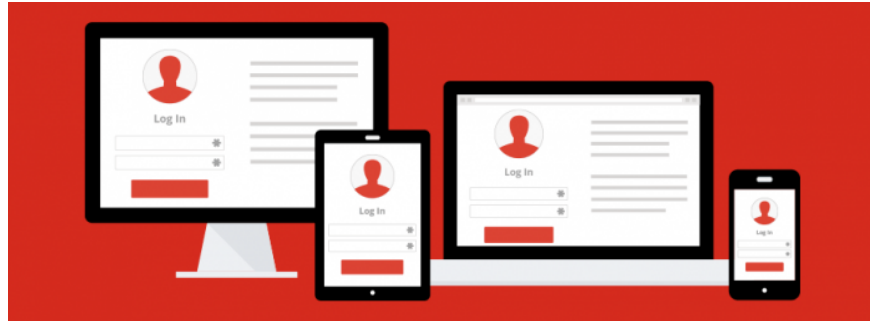
The best and most reliable way to secure your social networking accounts is to enable 2-layer security. Each site will have ways to activate 2-layer security, but to enable 2-layer security, you should use the text messaging option.

To search and enable the 2-layer security feature, it is best to 'dig' the settings, account settings or access the help page (help) to find options to enable the feature.

This feature works when you log in to your account, at this time on the login screen you will be asked to enter your account verification code. Your task is to enter the confirmation code sent to the phone number you registered to log into your account.

Once you have enabled two-layer security, hackers can hardly attack your social network accounts.

## 2. Password management



One of the rules when creating passwords for social networking accounts is that each account creates a password. Should create a long password, including numbers and lowercase characters, .

Using each password for each account to prevent your accounts from being "attacked" and "lost" at the same time. However, the drawback is that you cannot create and remember a series of random passwords for your online accounts. So the best way to manage passwords for your online accounts is through the help of password management applications.

There are many effective password management applications that you can use. One of the applications that you can refer to is LastPass .

## 3. Use separate email addresses for each account



In some cases, users create a password and use a common password for multiple accounts. Then hackers can easily access your profile, get an email account - the main key, which you used to create an account, and just a few basic steps are that hackers have taken the account. Your social network.

This is why for each social network account you should use a separate email address.

#### **4. Add your phone number as the recovery option**
