

5 tips to play the most tricky Among Us impersonator

Among Us takes you and 9 other players into a space shuttle, one or three of the crew members are the Imposter with the goal of destroying all members of the crew alive. , try to escape.

Here are 5 tips to play the best Impersonator **Among Us**.

In order to avoid the assassination of Among U the Impersonator, the crew members need to complete a number of common missions found on each map of the game, they can detect and vote on the Hacker stone List out of the ship. To avoid suspicion, impostors need to act like the crew.

Becoming a good Imposter in Among Us requires players to be very careful, the ability to think and cunning that makes others trust completely. To begin your reign of terror as an Imposter, consult the tactics below.

Tips For Playing An Imposter Among Us

Tips 1. Fair Vote

Avoiding suspicion is just as important as destroying Among Us's Impostors. The easiest way to gain confidence is to vote fairly when there is no strong evidence. Being the only one who votes to get rid of someone or constantly motivating someone to vote will almost certainly get you kicked off the train during the next meeting.

When in doubt ask the crew members to vote for someone but always vote in groups if you are convinced. This could result in being forced to vote for an Imposter (co-worker) to sneak into the crew, reducing your odds of winning but at least you're still breathing.



Tips 2. Wisely Choosing Victims

It is usually advisable to kill crew without witnesses, be alone . However, as the game progresses, there may be players who are always on the move doing repair missions together, so you need to prove his innocence even though the Imposter cannot complete any task.

If you are suspected of being an Imposter, when on a mission do not kill your companion, you may receive appropriate accusations, only a few votes will fly your . Prey selection is not a simple thing.

Tips 3. Ventilation Holes

As an Imposter, you can use the vent to quickly navigate around any map in Among Us. These move-around locations can only be used by Impostors, but you can also get caught if you disappear instantly from a location, be careful. This move allows you to destroy an isolated target near a vent and then instantly destroy something that has caused someone else to arrive.

This strategy of playing the Imposter Among Us works well on the Polus map. You can kill someone doing the task of wiring in the Laboratory, destroy the lights, then jump into the Lab's vents to wait for another prey. However, make sure not to lurk in the vents for too long, otherwise other players will end up voting for you because they simply don't see you around.



Tips 4. Killing People In The Crowd

If you're having trouble finding a crew member alone, kill the crowd by gathering at least four crew members in an area. That can be done by sabotaging lights or connecting on any of the Among Us maps.

When everyone stands close together, pretend to be on a repair duty for a second or two and then stab someone in the back. The killing will be immediately alarmed and most of the time it is difficult to know who did it, do not overdo this tactic as it requires the player to be skillful.



Tips 5. Trying Vandalism, Separation of Players

In the end, if an Imposter with two crew members or three crew duels with two Impostors, you basically won the game. All you need to do is destroy once and destroy the rest with your teammates.

Activate an emergency, such as a reactor failure or O2 fault. Both of these sabotages require players to split up to stop them, which means someone will be alone and your chance to do so has arrived.
