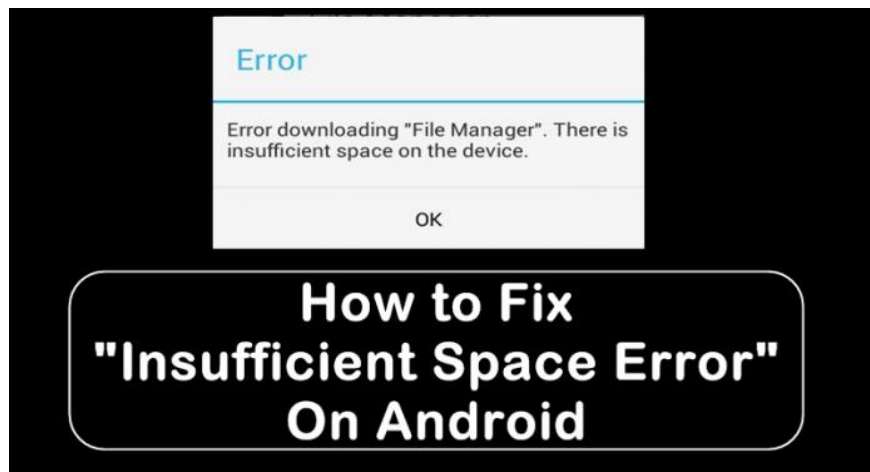


5 ways to fix 'Insufficient Space Downloading Error' on Android device

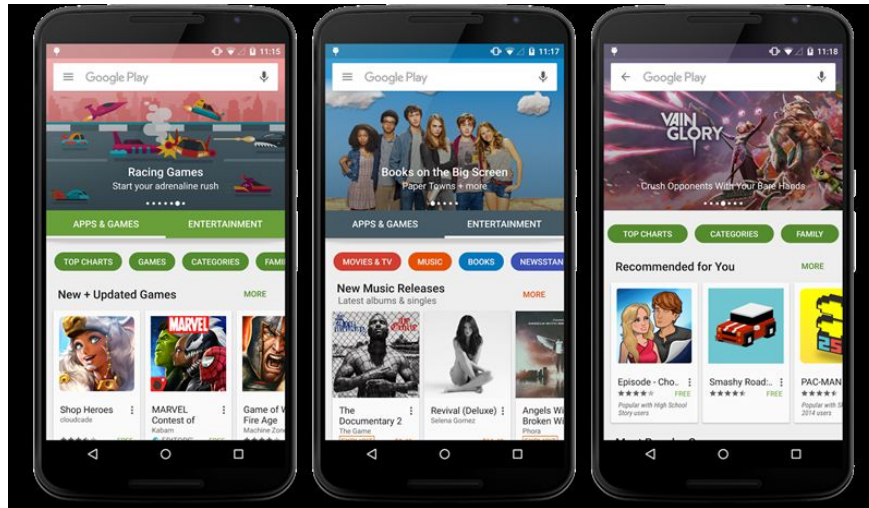
In some cases when you download any application or try to update an application on an Android device, on the device screen you receive the error message 'Insufficient Space Downloading Error'.

In some cases when you download any application or try to update an application on an Android device, on the device screen you receive the error message 'Insufficient Space Downloading Error'.

In this case, you can fix the error by updating the latest version of Google Play Store, clearing the cache, cleaning up the junk files, etc.



1. Update the latest version of Google Play Store



In some cases the latest version of Google Play Store update can help you fix the error Insufficient Space Downloading Error. In addition, when updating Google Play Services, it partly improves the level of security higher and safer.

Step 1:

Open the Google Play Store app on your Android device, then flick from left to right on the app screen.

Step 2:

Now on the device screen you will see a list of options, your task is to click **Settings** .

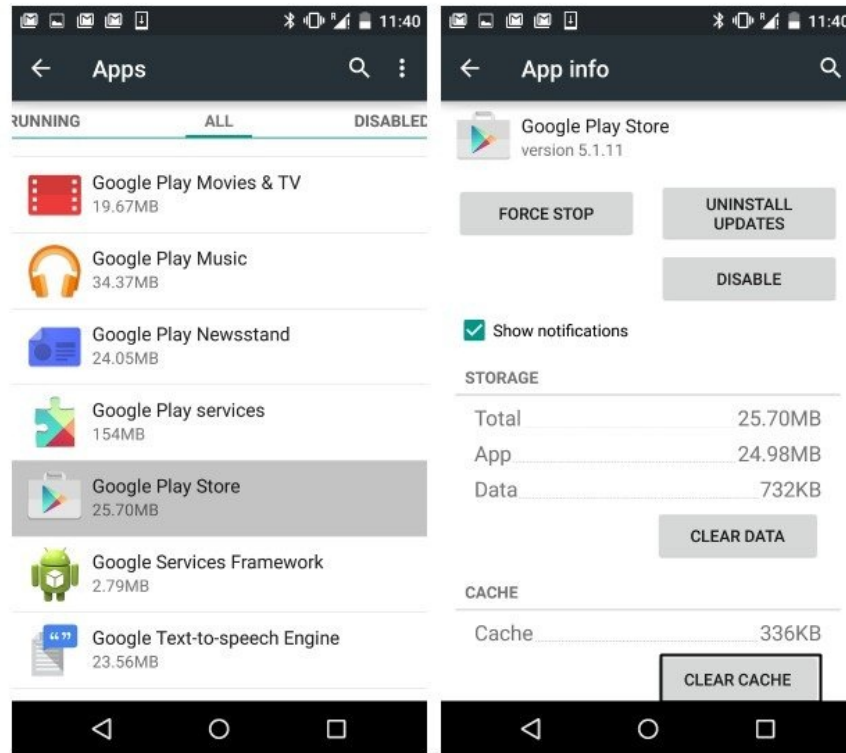
On the Settings window, scroll down to find and click the **Build Number** option.

Step 3:

A popup window appears. If the application on your device is allowed to update to the latest version, you will see the '**Google Play Store is up to date**' message on the screen.

Otherwise you will see a message showing the latest version to install.

2. Clear the cache



In most cases if an error occurs on the Google Play Store, the easiest way to fix the error is to delete all the cache.

Step 1:

Go to Settings => Apps.

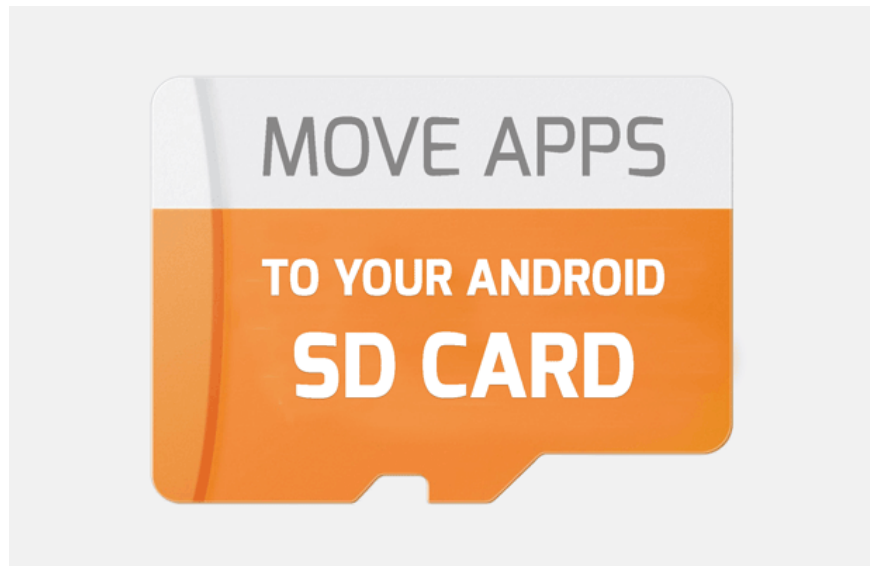
Step 2:

Click on **Google Play Store**.

Step 3:

Click **Clear Cache** then click **OK** .

3. Move the application on the device to an SD memory card



Step 1:

Go to Settings => Apps .

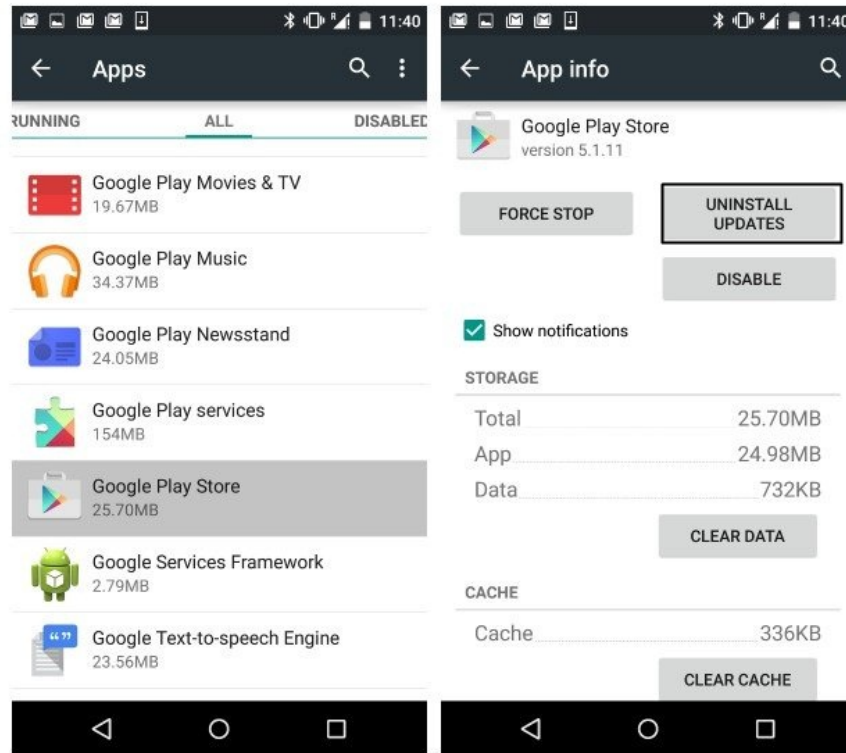
Step 2:

Click the application you want to move to SD memory card.

Step 3:

Select **Move to SD Card** .

4. Uninstall Google Play Services update



If you have applied the above methods and still cannot fix the error, you can apply a method to uninstall Google Play Services update on your Android device.

Step 1:

Go to Settings => Apps .

Step 2:

Find and click **Google Play Services** .

Step 3:

Click **Uninstall updates** to uninstall the Google Play Services update.

5. Clean up junk files (junk files)



Have you ever noticed and noticed that your device is getting slower and more likely to "freeze" temporarily for a while? If so, surely your device contains dozens or hundreds of junk files.

To resolve this situation as well as to free up memory space, it is best to use the junk file application to clean up this junk file.

One of the most effective garbage-cleaning applications you can use is Clean Master.

Download the Clean Master to your device and install it here.
