3. In **the west deck** , also known as the fluttering, the K-muscle (the old muscle) is the only K army with a beard without mustache.



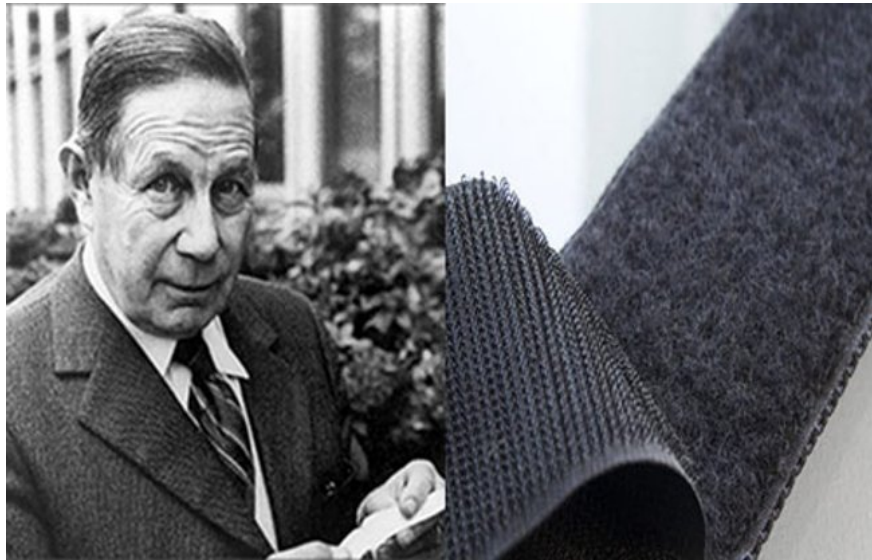
4. On average each person spends 2 weeks in his life to stop waiting at the traffic light.

8. First chocolate milk is sold as a medicine.

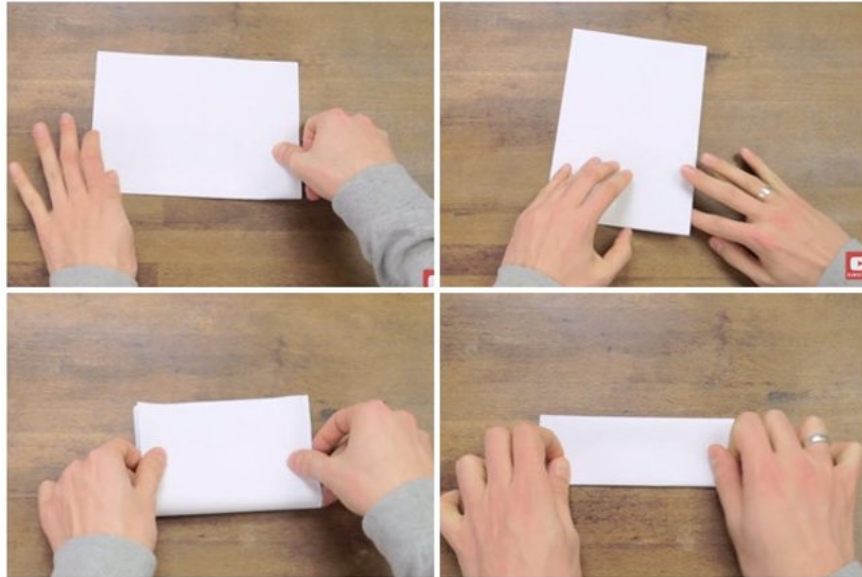


9. In fact, there are 177,000 tie styles, but usually we only know one way!
