

6 best applications to install on smart TV

While you can use it to play games on your console or watch movies or shows on your favorite streaming platform, TV channel, or cable subscription, did you know that it can do so much more? Are not?

Most new TVs are smart TVs. These are the apps every smart TV should install right away.

1. BrowseHere



Smart TV is considered a computer. While it's not as powerful as a phone, tablet, or laptop, it can still perform basic tasks like browsing the Internet. 3. Steam Link

VLC not only plays videos you load on your smart TV, but can also access video and music files you've stored elsewhere, like your local network or even via an FTP server. You can also use it to play local music files. So, if you have music and videos saved on a USB or external hard drive and want to watch them on your TV, you should install VLC for Android.

5. Google Meet

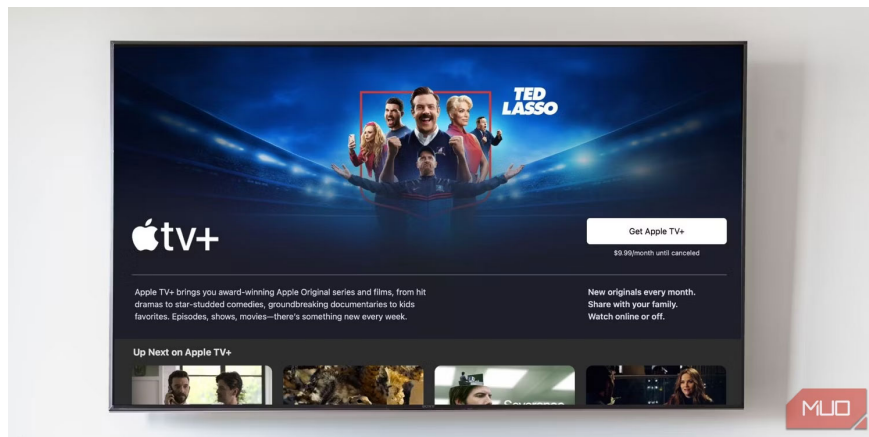
