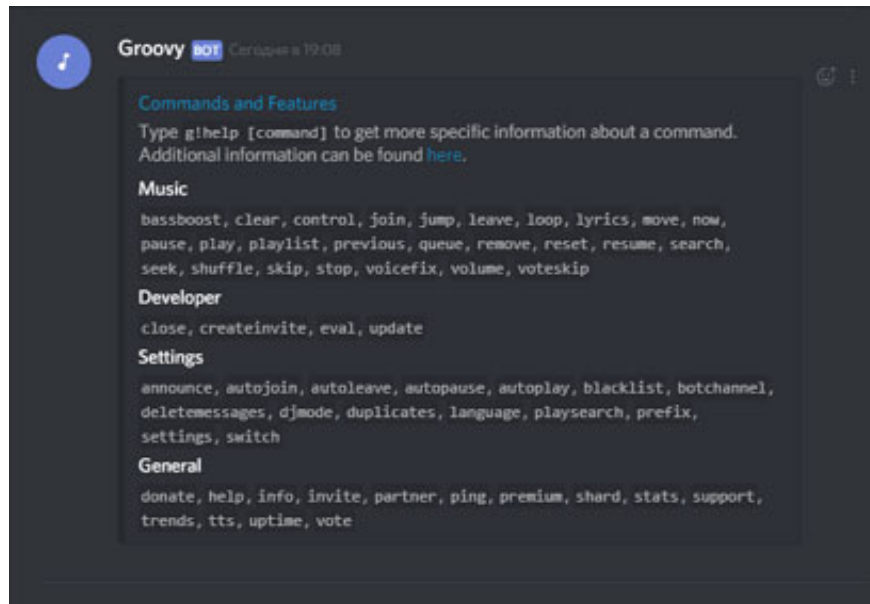
Here are 6 of the best Discord bots you should consider using.

1. Groovy

A new name joining the Discord bot group for music, Groovy, keeps things nice and simple, allowing Discord members to list playlists from many of the most popular music sources on the Internet into the queue.

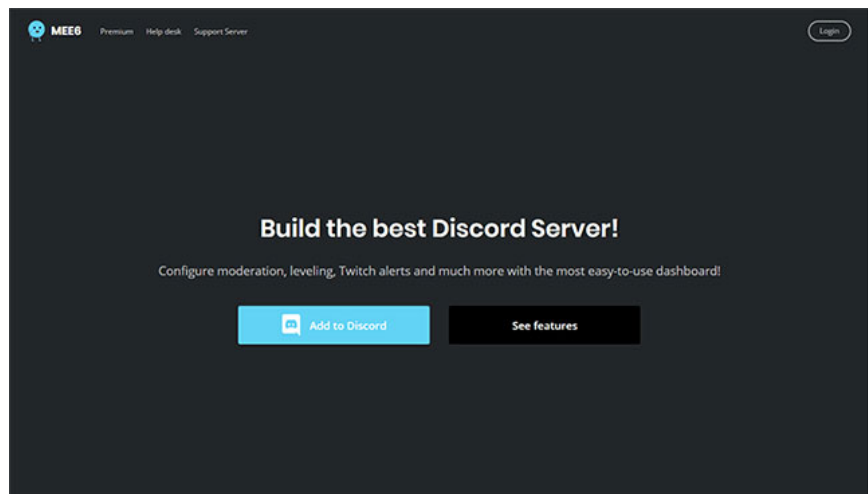


Groovy is stable, simple, and it comes with a bunch of great commands that allow you to order and skip songs, as well as more interesting functions like lyrics, equalizer testing (part responsible for audio processing).

Some features are unlocked in the Premium version of Groovy, but even the free version gives you everything you need to turn your Discord channel into a vibrant online music spot.

2. MEE6

There is a reason that MEE6 is one of the best Discord bots available. It comes with extensive features and support. You can also upgrade to a premium subscription plan for more features.



Many Discord bots are designed to censor servers and MEE6 will not let you down. You can set up automated mod rules to fix problems like server spam. MEE6 administrators can also configure a system to automate penalties, if users frequently break rules.

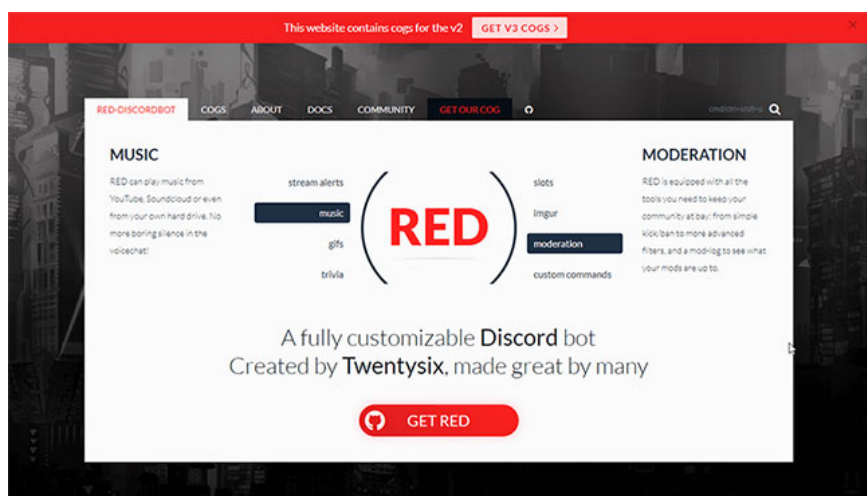
The bot is customizable, so you can create your own commands for users as well as personalized welcome messages. If you want users to set their own roles, you can set up commands specific to this.

There is a hierarchy for users. Regular users can upgrade to higher levels based on their server activity. You can set your own rewards, such as access to additional space or new roles.

If you know how to add a Discord bot to your server, you should have no trouble starting MEE6. Just invite the bot to your server to get started.

3. RED

If you want a bot that can be truly customized, consider RED. It is self-hosted, so you'll need your own server.



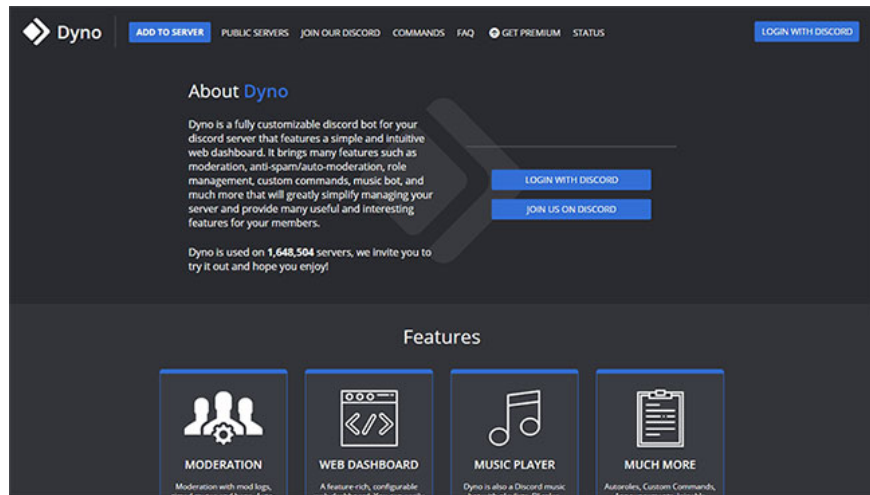
RED's modular approach means that no two servers will run the same RED, but there are some core features. Like MEE6, censorship is a central feature, with commands to click or ban, as well as filter messages.

There are also bots that play music, search GIFs, automated server messages, etc. Like MEE6, you can also customize bot commands. You can even customize the bot's name and avatar to match the server's personal style.

You can extend RED with plugins coded in Python (aka 'cog'). You can search for community-created plugins on the RED website.

4. Dyno

Another attractive Discord bot worth considering is Dyno, which is used on more than 1.6 million Discord servers. One of the biggest benefits of Dyno is its extensive web dashboard, which gives you complete control over customization.



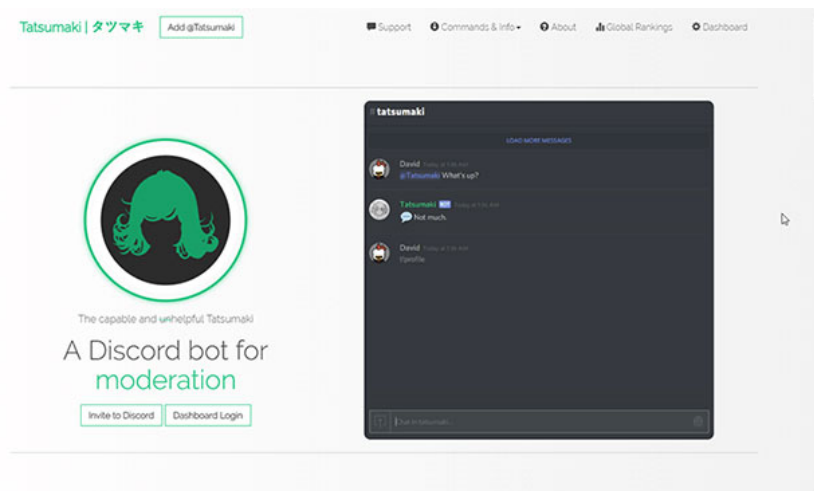
You don't need to host it yourself, because everything is hosted and controlled by Dyno via the web dashboard. Moderation tools are extended, with custom triggers for automatic moderation.

Dyno makes creating a role very easy, allowing server administrators to create new levels (linked to the server role). You can also perform server channel tuning stages with 'filter' commands, like deleting bulk messages based on user, server, or age.

Not just about censoring, you can set up a DJ bot with its own playlist, search for random events and even find random photos.

5. Tatsumaki

'Interesting' is the best word to talk about Tatsumaki bot. This bot is colorful, with many interesting features for server users to take advantage and enhance their activities.



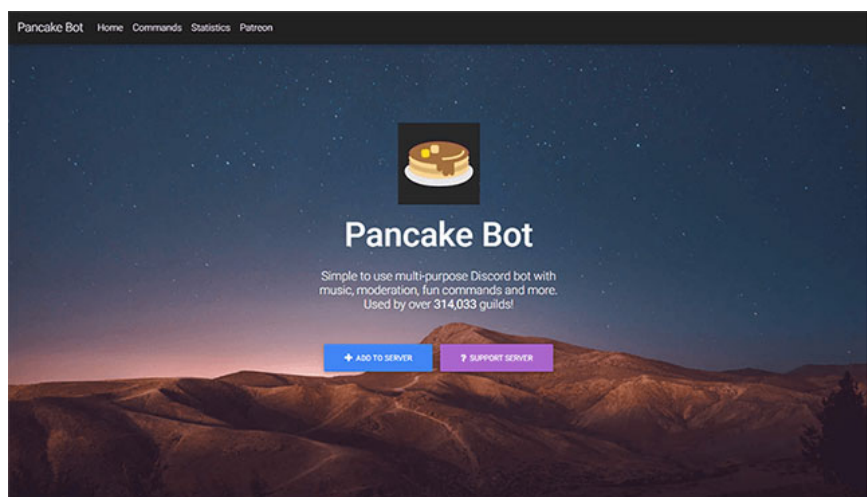
This is a bot covering all facilities, with features designed to improve censorship and increase server usage, as well as provide users with many interesting commands to test.

Tatsumaki's censorship features do not require configuration. They are ready to use, with commands to control users, truncate messages, configure welcome messages, etc.

You can also use YouTube to search for information and play some games, as well as conduct polls across the server. There is an extensive hierarchy with XP available to users based on their activity.

6. Pancake

More than 300,000 servers use Pancake on Discord. The reason for this is that using Pancake is very simple, with a good balance between interesting commands for users and generous moderation rights for administrators. Pancake is different from a 'invited to start' bot, so you don't need to worry about server hosting.



Customizable censorship system allows you to control everything, from voice chat to banning users, with a licensing system to set up censorship groups with various powers.

Has an easy-to-use music playback system with support from multiple sources, including SoundCloud and YouTube. Features, like image search, also help make the server a little more vibrant.

With hundreds of commands available, surely people will find a suitable option on the Pancake Discord server.

Discord is a great platform with low input (even free), suitable for both small and large communities. Bots like these help improve your server, add more features like music, games and additional censorship to improve the experience even further.
