If you need a tool that allows you to write in Markdown or give you the ability to convert a document into Markdown, here is a list of the best Markdown editors to perform both of these tasks.

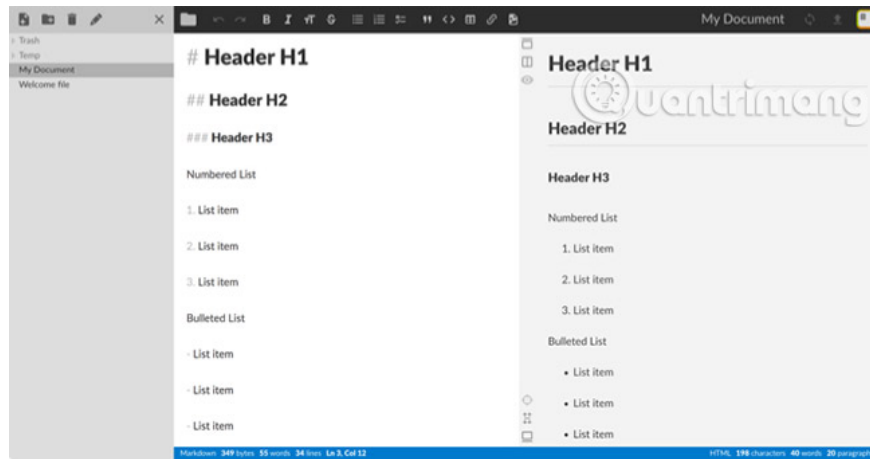

## The best free Markdown editor to write

These free online Markdown editors allow you to paste your text from another location or write directly in the editor.

### 1. StackEdit.io



What makes StackEdit a standout editor is because it's ideal for people who want to learn how to write in Markdown.

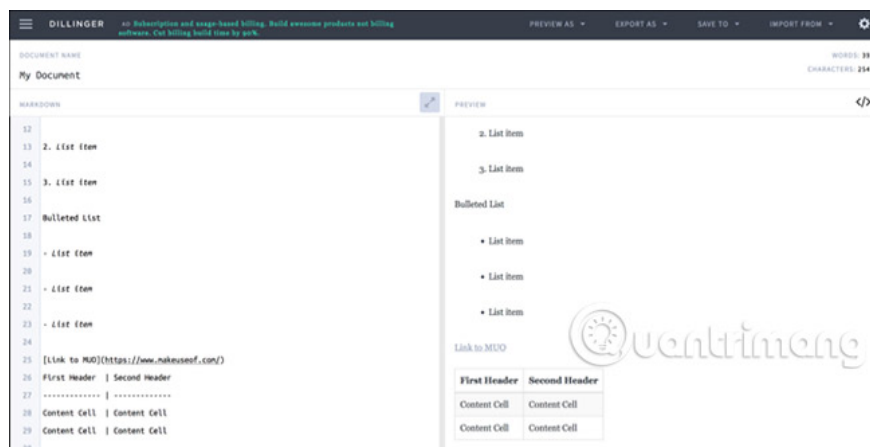
When you enter text on the left side of the editor, you can apply formatting using the toolbar similar to what you see in Microsoft Word. You can use simple buttons to format fonts, lists, blockquote (define long quotations) and links. The right side will automatically change it to the correct syntax.

Notable features of StackEdit include:

1. Directory organization, focusing on text and reading mode, along with the function of counting words, lines, bytes, characters and number of paragraphs.
2. Import Markdown and HTML files, as well as export to Markdown, HTML, PDF and Pandoc. Note that exporting certain types of files may incur small charges.
3. Synchronize with Google Drive, Dropbox and GitHub with links to WordPress, Blogger and Zendesk to publish.
4. Accessible file history and attributes, templates, and a handy Markdown cheat sheet.

If you're looking for a free online Markdown editor with a great set of features, why not try StackEdit?

## 2. Dillinger.io



Dillinger is another really interesting Markdown editing option. This tool is perfect for people who are familiar with editing in Markdown because it doesn't have a toolbar, but just a full editor.

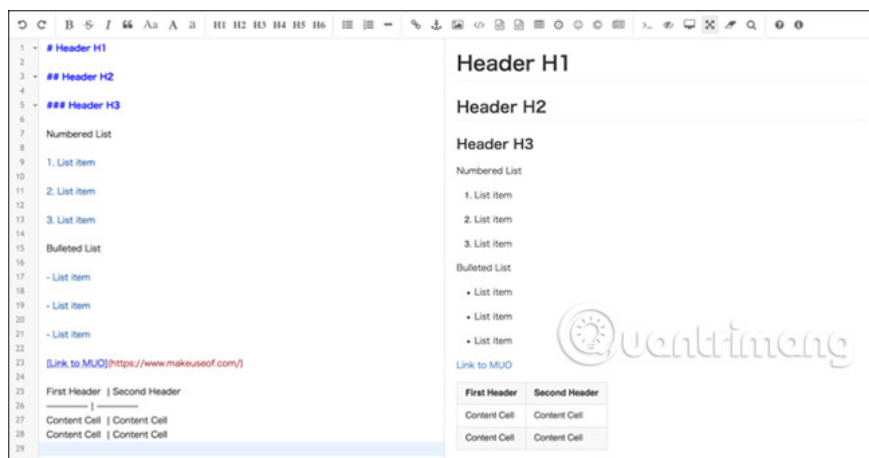
Enter the text on the left and you will see the text displayed in the rich text on the right. You can switch to HTML view instead of rich text with just one click. The editor also allows you to work in browser screen mode to avoid distraction.

Dillinger's remarkable features include:

1. Save documents and sessions.
2. Link, save and import documents from services like Dropbox, Bitbucket, GitHub, Google Drive, OneDrive and more.
3. Preview and export to HTML format, HTML style, Markdown and PDF.
4. Auto-save, count words and characters, scroll sync for the editor.

If you are familiar with Markdown and want a free, neat online editor, Dillinger will be the best choice.

### 3. Editor.md



Another Markdown editor, similar to StackEdit, is Editor.md. This open source tool also gives you an easy-to-use toolbar, with many more useful formatting options for beginners to get familiar with Markdown.

You can format everything from fonts, to titles to lists. You can also quickly insert links, images, code blocks, tables, emoticons and special characters. Use the online editor or download the application if you want. When using it online, simply copy and paste the rich text version you created into the desired location.

Editor.md's remarkable features include:

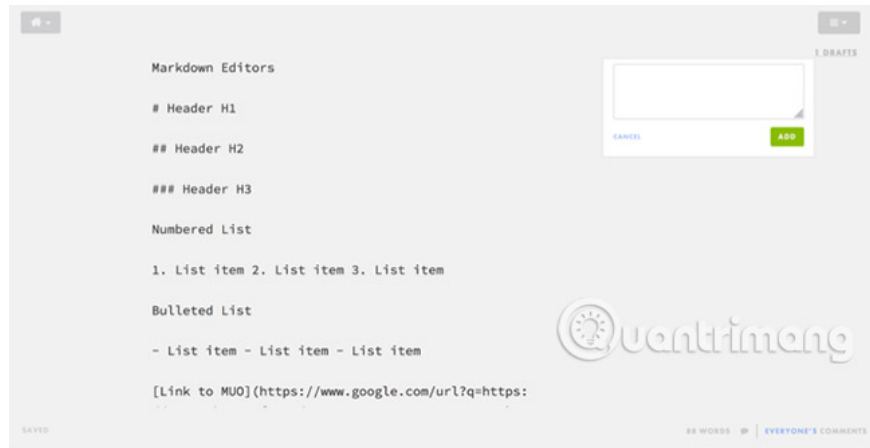
1. See the list of useful shortcuts by clicking **Help**.
2. Preview HTML with one click.
3. Full screen mode, help focus writing without distraction.

If you're looking for a simple Markdown editor but provide a powerful toolbar, don't skip the Editor.md option for free.

# The best free Markdown editor to convert

With these free Markdown tools, you can paste rich text or upload to your documents. After that, quickly transfer it to Markdown.

## 4. Draftin.com



With Draft, you can easily convert documents written in rich text to Markdown, including titles, lists, links and other items.

Import documents from locations like Dropbox, Google Drive, Evernote, Box or your computer. Drag and drop or browse to import the file you want. After that, just wait a few minutes and the converted Markdown document will display.

Notable Draft features include:

1. Share your document with a link that allows others to help you edit the document.
2. Create a folder to organize your documents.
3. Publish to websites like WordPress, Blogger, Tumblr, LinkedIn and other sites.
4. Adjust font, size and color settings with background color.

You can create a free Draft account and receive email notifications when your documents are converted and ready for use. For good Markdown tools with additional features, visit the website and try Draft.

## 5. Paste to Markdown



Paste to Markdown is one of the simplest websites to convert documents into Markdown. You will not find any great extra features or features with this tool. But it works very quickly and is easy to use.

Convert your document with Paste to Markdown as follows:

1. Copy text from your document or another website.
2. Paste text directly on the main page of Paste to Markdown.
3. You will see your documents converted to Markdown and then you can copy and paste the documents where you need them.

You don't have to click on any button, press any key or move your mouse. After you paste the text into the page, it will be converted for you to copy and transfer the results to another place. There is no simpler tool than Paste to Markdown.

## 6. Word to Markdown Converter



The ultimate online Markdown tool worth checking out is Word to Markdown Converter. As its name suggests, the site currently only works with Microsoft Word documents. However, it does all the work very well.

Convert your documents with Word to Markdown Converter as follows:

1. Use the **Browse** button to locate your document or drag and drop it to the bottom.
2. When the new tab opens, you will see both your original and new Markdown text.
3. Then, copy the Markdown text and paste it where you need it.

Word to Markdown Converter is as easy to use as Paste to Markdown. There are no additional features or actions you need to take, other than selecting your material. The only difference is that this free online tool only works with Word. So, if Word is the text editor of your choice, then this is the tool for you.

Whether you regularly use or just learn about Markdown, these free online tools will also be useful for you.
