

6 best USB speakers for laptops

Most laptop speakers emit low sound and are not loud enough. If this is the case with your laptop, equip your laptop with a USB speaker so that the overall sound output is better amplified.

Laptops in general do not have good enough sound for listening to music and watching movies. Most laptop speakers emit low sound and are not loud enough. If this is the case with your laptop, equip your laptop with a USB speaker so that the overall sound output is better amplified.

The USB connection eliminates the hassle of a dedicated power cord, at least on most speakers, making for a tidy setup and easier cable management. Additionally, additional Bluetooth support allows you to connect to your phone wirelessly.

So without further ado, let's explore some recommendations for the best USB speakers for laptops you can buy right now.

1. ABRRU Dual USB Speaker

1. Power: 5W



ABRRU speakers may not be from a reputable brand. However, you can expect it to deliver quality sound at an affordable price. It is a dual-driver speaker and comes with a USB-C extension. And this gives you the flexibility to connect to any laptop regardless of its port. This is a simple speaker and causes little installation hassle.

Note that this is one of the least expensive speakers on this list. And for this price, the sound is decent and balanced. But if you're looking for audiophile-level sound, this might not be the choice for you.

Unlike most computer speakers, it is a single unit and you will need a dedicated place on your desk to place the speaker. However, it's not too big and measures just about 9 x 1.57 x 2.52 inches. Interestingly, there is no dedicated power cable and USB power cable.

ABRRU USB speakers are popular with users, in which the speaker's bass and sound output are the two most loved features. There is no power button on the speaker but there is a **Mute button**.

2. Amazon Basics USB Speaker

1. Power: 2.4W



Another set of USB speakers for laptops is from Amazon Basics. This is a set of two small devices, and will fit into any setup. The highlight of this pair of speakers is the quality sound, with clear and crisp sound.

These Amazon Basics speakers have a compact design, making them easy to manage. Plus, the USB cord is long enough and gives you enough room to secure it to your preference. This speaker also does not have a power cord.

Unlike the option above, these speakers have LED indicators at the bottom. They light up whenever you connect the speaker to your laptop and will turn off when your laptop goes to sleep. However, if you prefer to work in the dark without distracting light, you may want to skip this option.

3. Creative Pebble V3

1. Power: 16W
2. Reference price: 740,000 VND



Creative Pebble V3 is superior to the above speakers in terms of price and sound quality. These USB laptop speakers provide loud, clear and crisp sound output. This makes it easy to listen to music, watch movies or podcasts. What's interesting about this sub-\$50 laptop speaker is its support for Bluetooth, USB-C, and 3.5mm audio Aux. The two speakers above do not support Bluetooth and Aux.

True to its name, the Creative Pebble V3 includes two small speakers that you can place on either side of your laptop. The main speaker also comes with a volume knob on the front and a button for Bluetooth pairing. While the USB-C cable eliminates the hassle of connecting a power cord, the devices in the speaker set have a non-detachable cable between them. This can be limiting if you want more flexibility in your setup.

As noted earlier, the Creative Pebble V3 has decent audio output. However, bass has its drawbacks. These are powerful speakers and have great volume for their size. If you like listening to songs at high volume while working, these USB speakers are a good choice.

4. Edifier G2000 gaming speaker

1. Capacity: 32W



The Edifier G2000 speaker is the right choice if you are looking for cheap but quality gaming speakers. These are neat hexagonal shaped speakers and have RGB light panels on the sides and back. When turned on, the lamp allows you to add sophistication to your desk. These gaming speakers provide balanced sound, although the bass isn't as strong as you'd like.

The good news is that the speaker still delivers loud and full sound. It also comes with physical switches on either side, including a mechanical volume button. On top of that, you can switch between three audio modes using a dedicated button. If you press and hold the button, you can cycle through the preset lighting settings. Although the lights do not provide a superior experience like dedicated RGB lights, they play a role in enhancing the aesthetics of your desk,

The Edifier G2000 speaker is clearly different from cheap USB speakers and high-end bookshelf speakers. The speaker supports Bluetooth and AUX connection. You can add a sub-woofer to the setup.

5. Klipsch R-41PM bookshelf speaker

1. Power: 70W



If budget is not a constraint and you want one of the best experiences, you can check out the Klipsch R-41PM. These bookshelf speakers are much larger than the others above. The biggest advantage is that they are very flexible and have many connectivity options, including Bluetooth, Aux, Optical, phone and USB for connecting to laptops. They operate powerfully, with a capacity of up to 70W.

The Klipsch R-41PM delivers impressive sound with powerful bass.

However, these are bookshelf speakers and there may not be as much flexibility in placing them next to the laptop as with the speakers above. However, this is a versatile speaker and the range of connection options means you're free to choose the input source you want, including a Blu-ray player. All you need is a smart speaker placement.

6. Audioengine A2+ wireless speaker

1. Power: 60W



The Audioengine A2+ has been on the market for quite some time and is still one of the premium bookshelf speakers you can buy. The highlight of this speaker is its beautiful appearance, which will definitely add aesthetics to your desk. More importantly, it delivers great sound with full and distortion-free sound.

Like any speaker in its range, it has several connectivity options, including RCA and Bluetooth. However, the speaker uses a micro-USB input and you will have to be careful with the cable as Micro-USB cables are difficult to come by. Like the options above, the cable connecting both speakers tends to limit placement.
