So far, this tree is still growing.

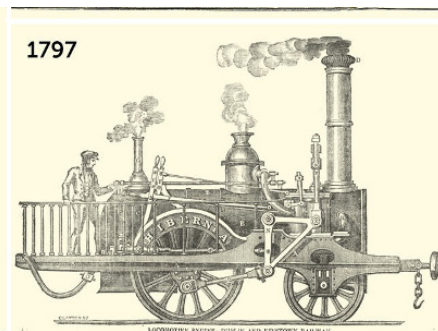
2. Nintendo and the Eiffel tower - which is first?

3. Bicycle appeared before the train?



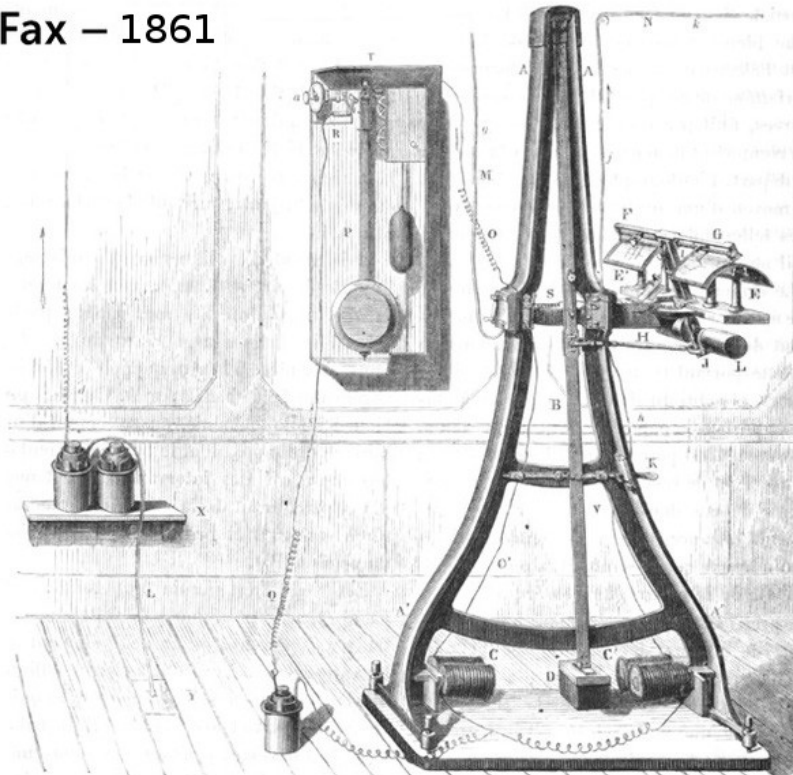
