In addition, you can hire canoes and kayaks to experience around the rivers connecting the lakes. Ending a long day, visitors can rent terrain and tents, camp overnight right on the shore of Blue Spring lake in state park.

3. Lake Deleon Springs

Often in the spring, there are more than 19 million gallons of clean water landing on the lake, abundant water, attracting many tourists to visit to experience the strange feeling of water sports forms such as canoeing, Kayak, fish, join eco boat tours, or camp day and night under the shade of old oak trees .

5. IchetuckKnee Springs Lake

6. Rock Springs Lake
