

# 6 most popular lies in resumes

### **3. "Raise" positions and responsibilities in the old company**

Improving yourself excessively by raising positions from staff to team leader, deputy manager, even head of department . is a very dangerous lie.

In addition to the risks that can be detected if employers call the old company, talking too much about past positions and responsibilities may put you in a situation of "bad jokes" if you are hired. and assign similar tasks, while you are not enough to perform those tasks.

### **4. "Overstated" about education, fake qualifications**

This lie is very easy to get you to the end of being fired in the case of being recruited. Not to mention that you are still capable of being charged with breaking the law.

### **5. Forging referrals**

Fake forged letters also have the same consequences as forging qualifications. In addition, this lie also entails the relationship between you and the person you mentioned in the fake fake mail.

### **6. Dishonest reference information**

There are two best options instead of lying in this section, that you can write " *the contact will be provided on request*" or give the correct information.
