

6 simple ways to clean the gas stove to knock away all stains and grease

With the following ways to clean the gas stove, the stains, grease, food will be removed to leave a clean look for the kitchen and bring freshness to your family's cooking space.

1. Vinegar

Use a soft cloth, soak a little vinegar and wipe on the kitchen surface or can spray the vinegar directly on the stain and wipe off with a dry towel. After cleaning with vinegar, your family's gas stove will become clean.

2. Use fresh lemon



Cut the lemon in half, rub on the surface of the gas stove and let stand for about 15 minutes. Then use a damp cloth to wipe clean. All stains will be removed and returned clean to your family's gas stove.

3. Salt

When the grease or food sticking on the gas stove is not dry enough, sprinkle salt directly on it. Then use a soft cloth to wipe, the stain on the gas stove will be beaten.

4. Cooking oil



Cooking oil is one of the ingredients to help clean the gas stove extremely effectively. Use a soft cloth or dishwasher to absorb a little oil on the stains, rust marks on the surface of the gas stove. Then wipe with a towel to wash dishes, gas stove will be as bright as new.

5. Rice water

When the rice cooker is boiling, use a large spoon to squeeze out some water. When the rice is still warm, use a soft cloth to soak the rice and rub it over the stains on the surface of the gas stove. After a few minutes, the grease will be absorbed. At this time, use a little towel to wash the dishes clean again.

6. Baking powder

Wet the kitchen with a clean towel or dishwasher. Sprinkle some baking powder on stain and grease. Using a strong scrub, the chemical composition of the baking powder will absorb all the oil and grease, and remove rust quickly.
