

6 speed tips for Google Chrome browser

Below tips are given and tips on how to increase the speed of Google Chrome.

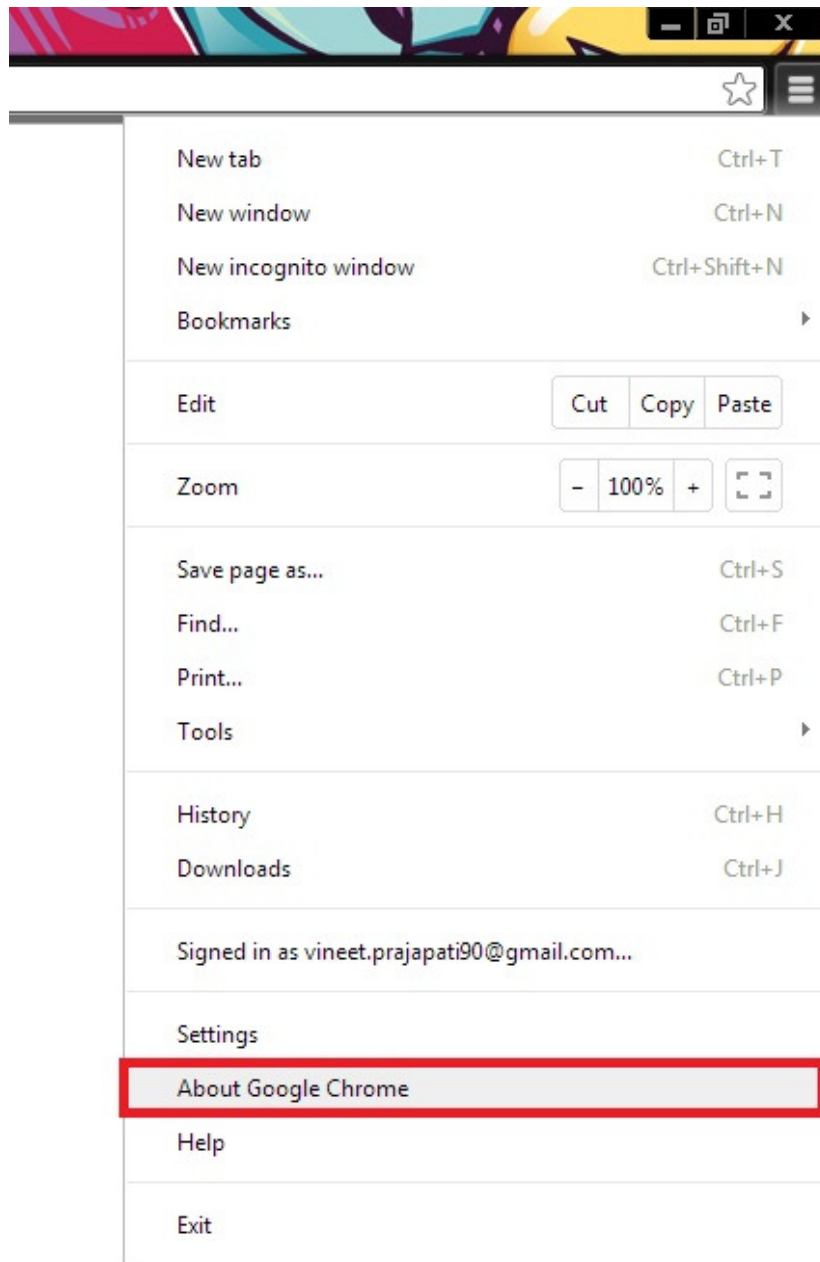
How to speed up Google Chrome

1. Update to the latest version of Google Chrome

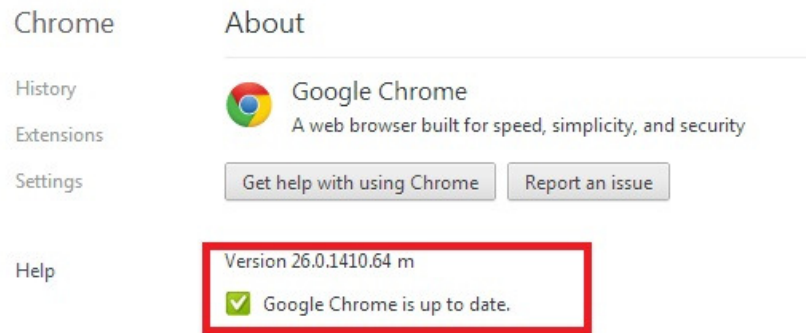
If you are using an older version of Google Chrome, please update to the latest version of your Google Chrome web browser because with all new updates you will get new features and improve performance with Latest support for additional features.

How to check for updates

1. Open your Google Chrome and click on the settings icon in the upper right corner and select '**About Google Chrome**' and there you can check for Google Chrome Update status as shown below in the photo.



1. You can see the current version of Google Chrome as shown below:



2. Disable unnecessary extensions

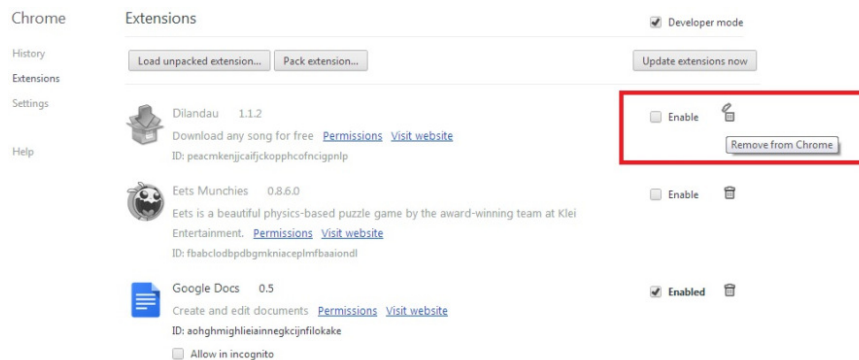
There are a large number of **extensions** installed in your Google Chrome that slow down your Internet browsing speed because whenever a new page is loaded it is waiting for these extensions to process.

So installing too many extensions or Addons leads to browser slowdown and download speed.

Try to **disable all unnecessary extensions** and make sure to use only a limited number of extensions means try to keep less than 5 extensions.

How to Disable Unnecessary Extensions

Open your Google Chrome and click on **the wrench icon** and select '**Settings**'. Now navigate to the **Extensions tab** and there you can easily remove unwanted Extensions by clicking on the trash icon as shown below in the image.



3. Enable 'Predict network actions to improve page load performance'

This is a proven method to speed up the browsing of Google Chrome. Turn on '**Predict network actions to improve page load performance**'. Your web browser will start loading your page before you actually click and open it.

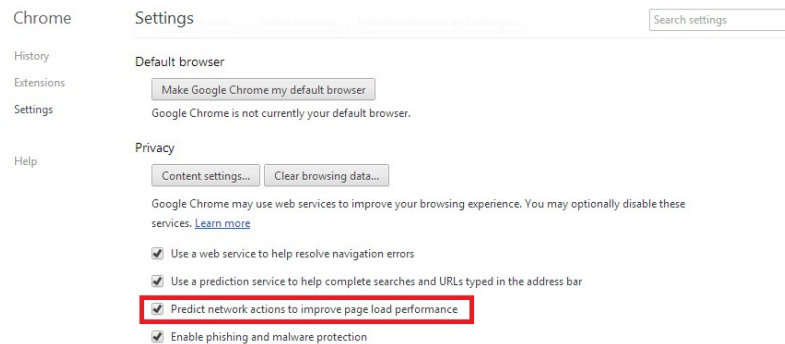
How to Enable

1. Go to Google Chrome and select '**Settings**'.

1. Scroll down and go to the bottom of the Settings page.

1. Yes Select ' **Advanced settings** '.

1. You will see the option to enable ' **Predict network actions to improve page load performance** ' as shown below in the image.

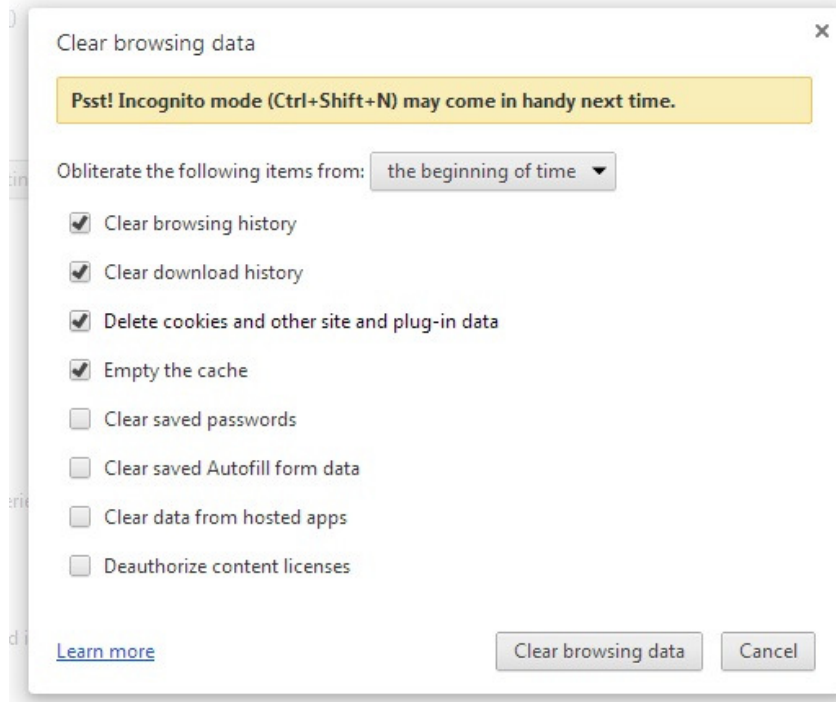


4. Clear the Cache and browsing history.

When you use Google Chrome for the first time after installation you will experience a fast pace then diminish after a few weeks or days and that's all because your old browsing data and history are saved. Storing in cache and cookies leads to a slow browser. Therefore, clean up your old cache and data browsing history regularly.

How to clear browsing data

Go to your Google Chrome and select the button with 3 dashes in the upper right corner and then move to **Tools** -> **Clear browsing data** as shown below in the image. There select all the above options as Clear Cache, Browsing History, Download History etc as shown below in the image.

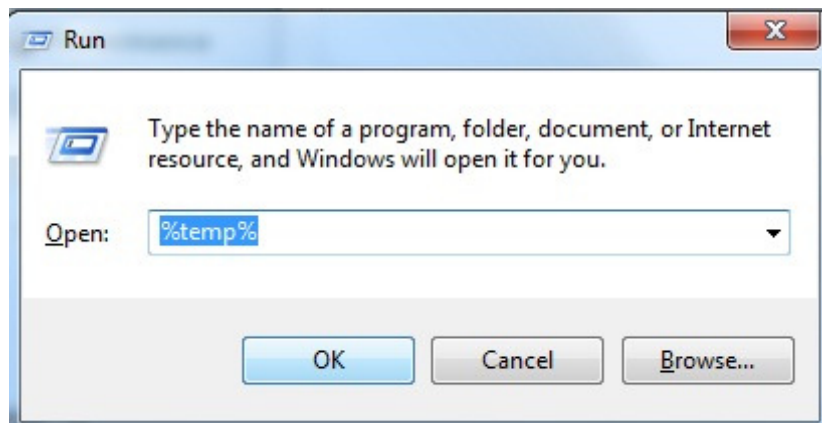


5. Delete temporary Internet files

Deleting temporary Internet files also helps in improving your Google Chrome browser and loading speed. Read the section below on how to delete temporary Internet files from your computer.

How to delete temporary Internet files

1. Go to Start Menu and open RUN.
1. Type **%temp%** as shown below in the image.



1. You should now see a Temp folder there.
1. **Delete all files permanently** from the Temp folder by selecting all files and then Press **Shift + Delete**

6. Use IDM to Increase Download Speed

IDM (Internet Download Manager) is a very fast download support tool, IDM's support feature on Chrome is also quite useful. You can video or music using the Download bar of IDM.

Thus, the browser does not need too many tricks to speed up as the operating system. With just the easy operation above, you can improve the speed of web browsing, page loading as well as downloading data to the computer faster.
