

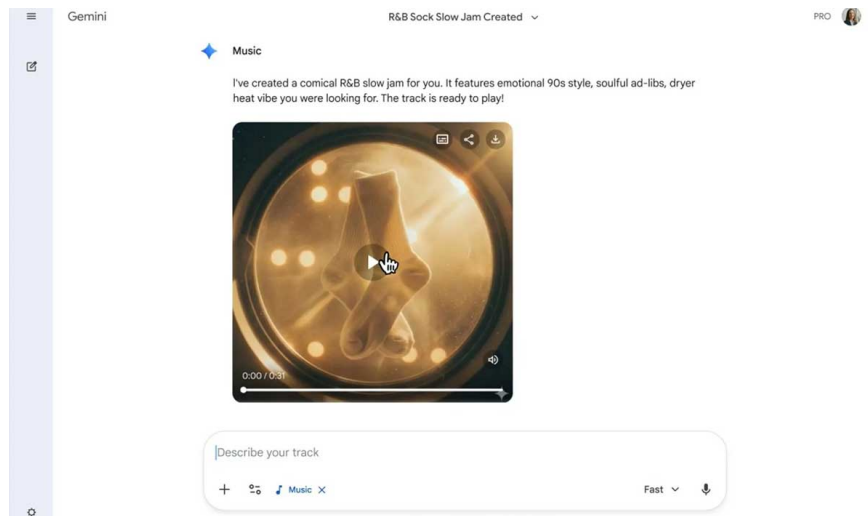
6 tips for writing prompts for Lyria 3 to create AI music in Gemini
