

6 ways to fold origami paper Christmas trees for decoration and as gifts

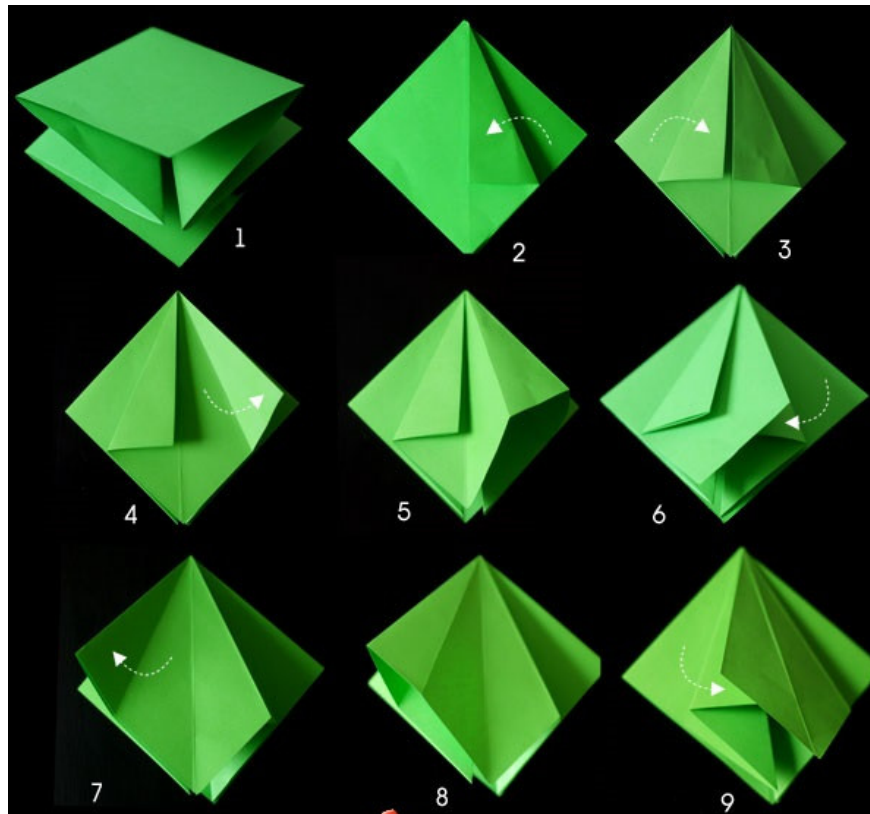

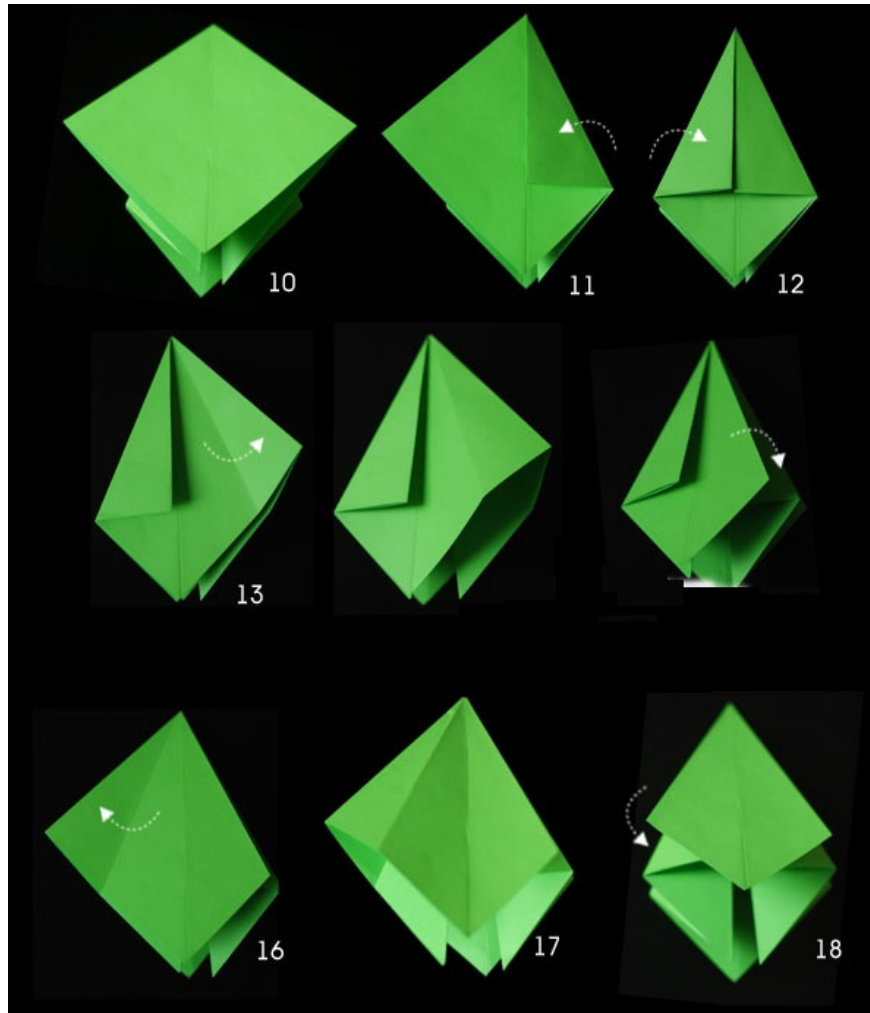
With the detailed instructions in this article, you will be able to fold the Christmas tree with beautiful origami style of Japan to decorate your home with Christmas or as a gift.

Raw materials needed to fold paper Christmas trees in origami style are simple and easy to find: paper.

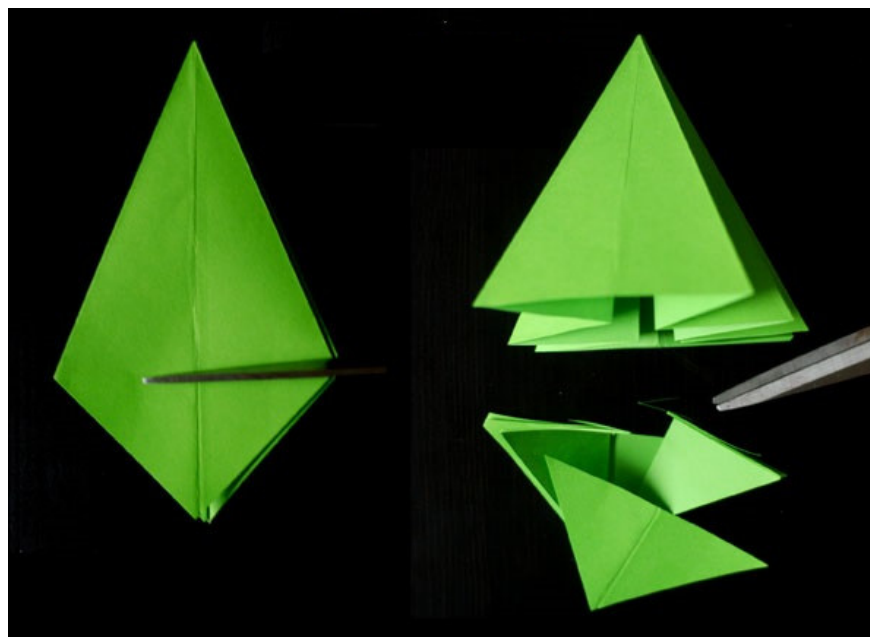
Folding super simple origami Christmas tree



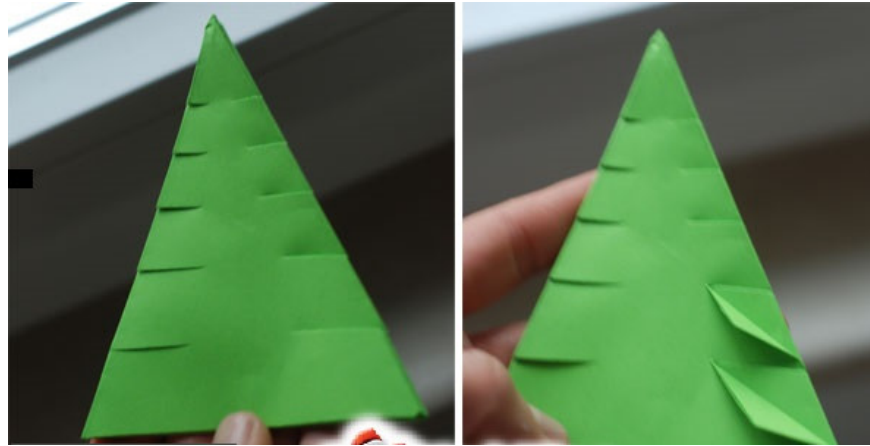
Use a square sheet of paper 2 times diagonally to get 4 triangles. Then, open the paper and fold the paper to divide the square into two rectangles. Then fold the steps as shown in the picture.



Place the face of the paper downwards and continue folding the remaining face as shown in the picture.

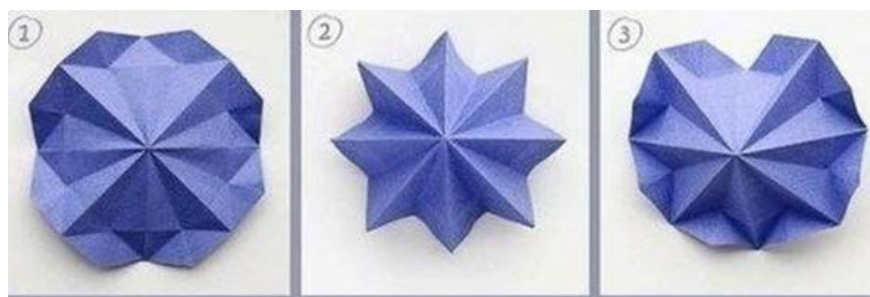


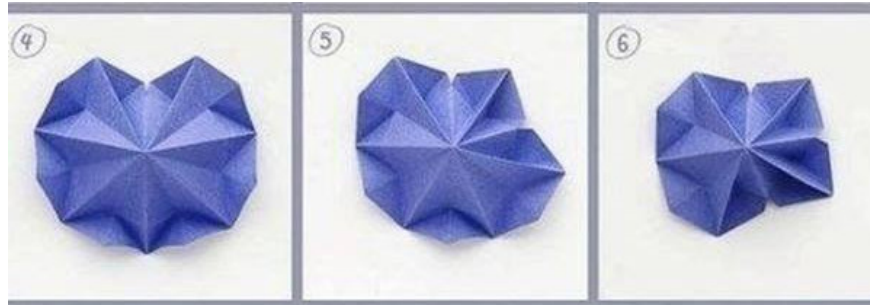
Use scissors to cut off the leftover part and make it into an isosceles triangle.



Use scissors to cut the sides of the triangle as shown in the image. Then fold the cut parts into consecutive small triangles. Proceed at all 6 sides of the triangle. Once completed, we have a lovely mini Christmas tree for Christmas decorations and for everyone.

How to fold Christmas tree with paperboard





From the square sheet of paper, fold it diagonally to create 4 weight triangle triangles. Then continue doubling to divide the square into 4 small squares. Fold diagonally so that the diagonal line and the center line overlap and then gently stroke it to form a fold.

Fold the 4 corners of the square up and cut the excess paper to make a regular octagon. Fold the sides of the octagon so that the diagonal lines overlap.



From the folds, gently divided into triangles and fold the paper under the up triangle to form 4 blocks in the 4 corners of the pine tree.

You continue to fold other blocks with smaller sizes and then lay them together to form an origami-style Christmas tree.
