

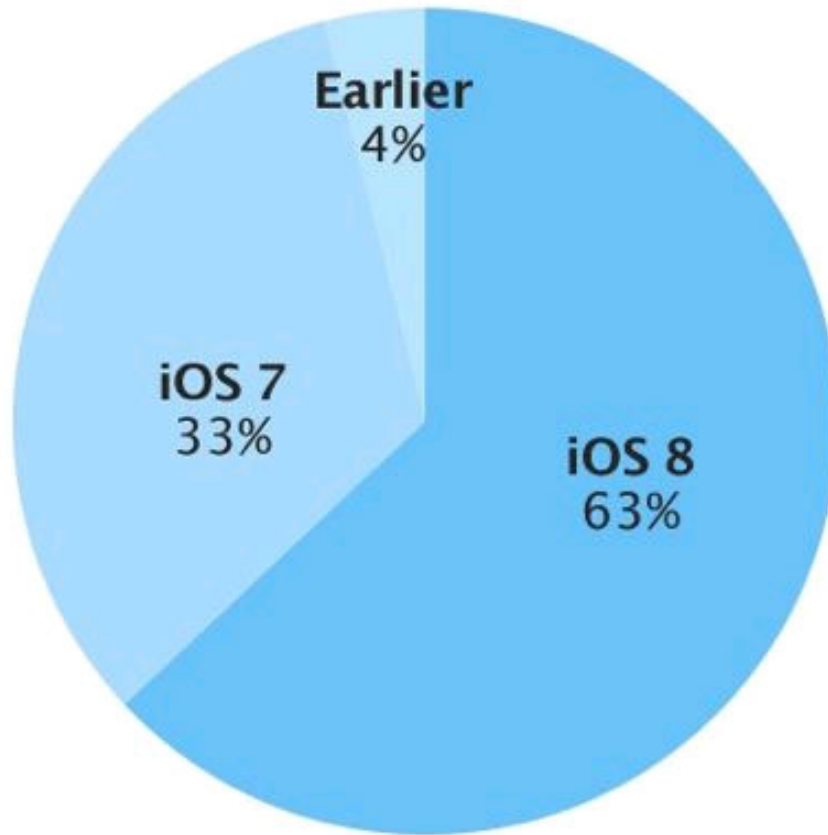
## 63% of users have updated to iOS 8 version

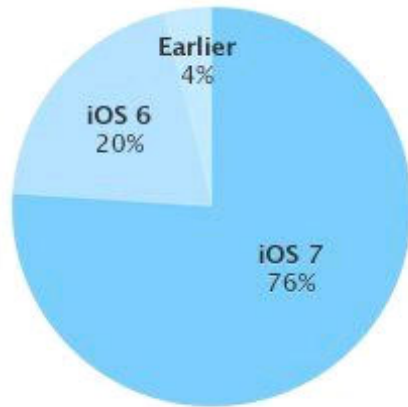

One of the main factors that made iOS 8 users soar was thanks to the positive sales of the iPhone 6 and 6 plus duo - according to the latest information, Apple sold 71.5 million units after the holiday season.

on December 8, 2014.

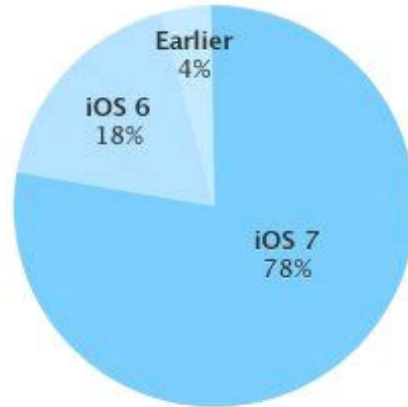

**78% of devices are using iOS 7.**

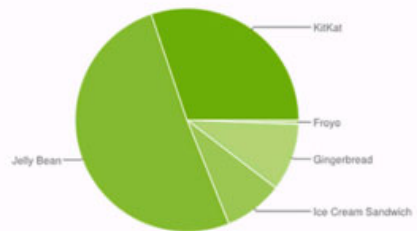


As measured by the App Store during a 7-day period ending December 30, 2013.

However, what iOS 8 has done is not possible compared to iOS 7 seniors at the time of launch last year. Around this time last year (*December*), iOS 7 was installed on about 76% of users for their device.

An interesting point is that even though iOS 8 is slower than iOS 7 senior in attracting users to update their device. But 63% was too happy compared to the fragmentation of the Android ecosystem. According to a recent report, less than 0.1% of Android users updated to the latest version of 5.0 Lollipop.
